Step aboard this exquisite 74-foot Viking enclosed bridge sportfisher, a bluewater convertible that fuses tournament-ready performance with understated luxury. Designed for fast passages, extended range, and effortless entertaining, she offers the uncommon comfort of a five-stateroom layout and an enlarged fuel capacity—perfect for long-range cruising, serious offshore endeavors, or gracious hospitality afloat. Purchased by the current owner in 2016, she has received meticulous attention with all engine and system services kept current, presenting a turnkey platform for your next voyage.

Power comes from twin 2,400 HP MTU engines that have been carefully maintained, accompanied by a crated set of spare propellers for reassurance on distant runs. The SeaKeeper 34 stabilizer delivers a composed, confident ride while a bow thruster simplifies close-quarters handling. The enclosed bridge provides a quiet, climate-controlled helm with a full tower above for supreme sightlines when chasing pelagics. Comfort and convenience are further enhanced by new A/C chillers installed in 2024, Sub-Zero refrigeration, a day head forward of the galley, and Starlink connectivity to keep you online far from shore.

Fishability is exemplary: teak cockpit decking and new teak cover boards create a warm, timeless cockpit around a professional-grade fighting chair and full set of outriggers, outfitting her for tournament competition or relaxed canyon excursions. A hydraulic bow davit and the included 2017 Walker Bay 14' RIB with a 70 HP Yamaha 4-stroke make tender operations effortless for beach runs and reef forays. Onboard entertainment is thoughtfully integrated with a Savant AV platform paired with a Fusion sound system, all presented in Viking's hallmark fit and finish that defines the modern luxury sportfish motor yacht.

Recent enhancements — the bow davit and tender, the SeaKeeper 34, new cockpit teak, and renewed cover boards — complement an already formidable specification. Whether referenced as a convertible sportfish, an enclosed bridge flybridge, or an offshore battlewagon, this Viking 74 is a handsome, powerful, and comprehensively equipped yacht built to roam far and arrive in style. 

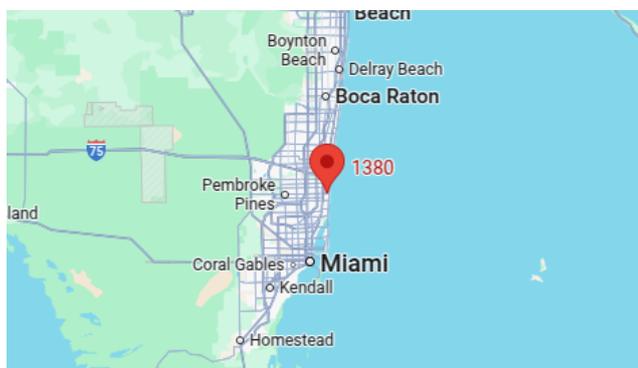
