

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Key features

Presented in amazing condition and measuring under 24 m, this yacht blends Eco Speed efficiency with effortless ownership, thoughtfully specified for easy maintenance while remaining deeply comfortable both at sea and at anchor; she delivers a refined, quiet ride, economical cruising and the reassuring poise of a vessel that has been cared for impeccably, making her an ideal choice for owners who value low operating costs without sacrificing onboard luxury.

Mechanical equipment

A ZF gear box drives a high performance steering configuration with surface propellers and Arneson Drive, delivering assured handling and speed while practicality is built in with a PTO, fuel filters and a reliable Idromar water maker with two membranes to keep you self sufficient offshore; climate control is entrusted to Frigit air conditioning, and bow and stern thrusters, trim tabs and a boiler are all fitted to make close quarters manoeuvres, trim control and onboard comfort effortless.

Electrical systems

Designed for dependable, simple operation, the yacht runs on 220 V shore power with a 220 V electricity output on board, and a converter is installed for seamless power management, supported by dedicated main engine starting batteries and generator starting batteries to ensure confident starts in all conditions and reliable onboard electrical performance.

Navigation & communication

The helm is comprehensively outfitted with professional grade electronics, including VHF FURUNO HS 2721, autopilot FURUNO Navpilot 500, GPS FURUNO GP 32 and a Zenith 0474 05 magnetic compass for traditional bearing checks, while awareness and routing are enhanced by FURUNO C Map NT radar, FURUNO Navionic depth sounder and chart plotter and FURUNO RD 30 wind instruments; night operations benefit from a Sanshin / HR 1012 searchlight and SATCOM connectivity is fitted for offshore communication, offering a complete suite for confident passage making.

Audio visual equipment

Onboard entertainment is anchored by Denon RC 1198 audio equipment paired with a Samsung TV for crisp, immersive viewing and sound, and complementing the saloon setup, cabin equipment ensures discreet, convenient enjoyment throughout the accommodations so that both social spaces and private cabins deliver a refined multimedia experience.

Galley & laundry equipment

The galley is fully appointed for extended cruising with an Electrolux induction cooking surface and a Sauter oven supported by an extractor fan, and daily life onboard is effortless thanks to a Sharp dishwasher, refrigerator, freezer and an ice maker, while a Thomson washing machine and Thomson dryer take care of laundry with shore side ease so the yacht is ready for extended voyages with full domestic convenience.

Deck equipment

Deck operations are smooth and secure with a single Lofrans anchor windlass and two Lofrans aft warping capstans, the ground tackle is complete with anchors and anchor chains and a Besenzoni passerelle provides elegant boarding, while a swimming platform is fitted and, for simplicity, it is non hydraulic, combining practicality with refined aesthetics for effortless access to the water and shore.

Tenders & toys

The yacht carries a Novamarine Hydrojet 170ch tender for swift, dry transfers and playful coastal exploration, complemented by snorkeling dive gear for effortless immersion in clear waters so guests can enjoy both fast, comfortable shore access and active water experiences.

Safety & fire protection

Safety is comprehensively addressed with security equipment and CCTV systems supported by cameras and Electromare monitors, full life saving gear including life jackets, life rafts, flares and medical equipment, and communications redundancy with an emergency VHF; smoke sensors, a fire control system, fire extinguishers and fire alarms provide robust fire protection throughout the vessel to ensure peace of mind in every situation.

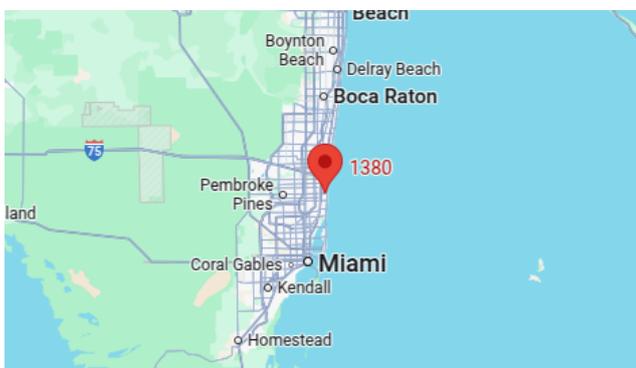
