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OVERVIEW

At 75 feet, SIMON redefines the art of indoor-outdoor yachting, pairing Italian refinement with spirited performance and adaptable long-range capability. An uncommon four-stateroom layout for a yacht of this size provides exceptionally comfortable and versatile accommodation for extended cruising. Designed as an open luxury motor yacht and sport yacht, she is prepared for effortless day use and long passages alike, specified with a 23 kW generator and a 2,500 W inverter, distinctive black waterlines and standard Silververtex Ice sunpads. A fully electric, waterproof opening roof with integrated ceiling lights transforms the cockpit into a convertible alfresco salon, while LED lighting bathes the decks and the natural-teak bathing platform—finished with black caulking—in a sophisticated glow after sunset. Six opening hull portlights draw fresh sea air into the saloon, where a finely appointed sofa flows into an inviting open-plan galley. The helm is outfitted with a comprehensive electronics package, including three 16 inch displays on the main dashboard, a Volvo trip computer and Volvo autopilot, a high-performance entertainment audio system with a dedicated installation for the owner's cabin, and intuitive home automation controls governing A/C and lighting.

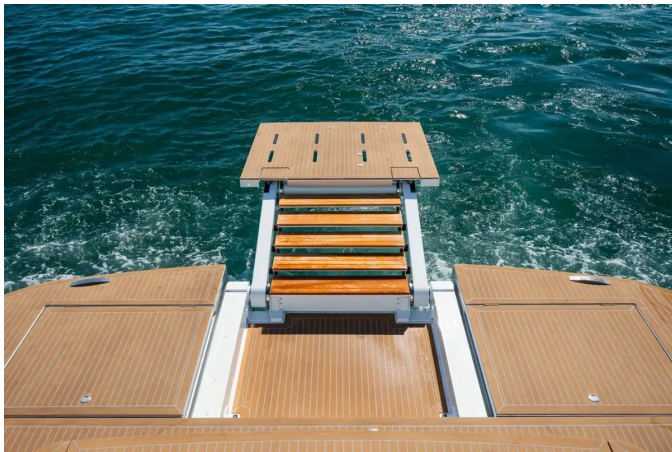

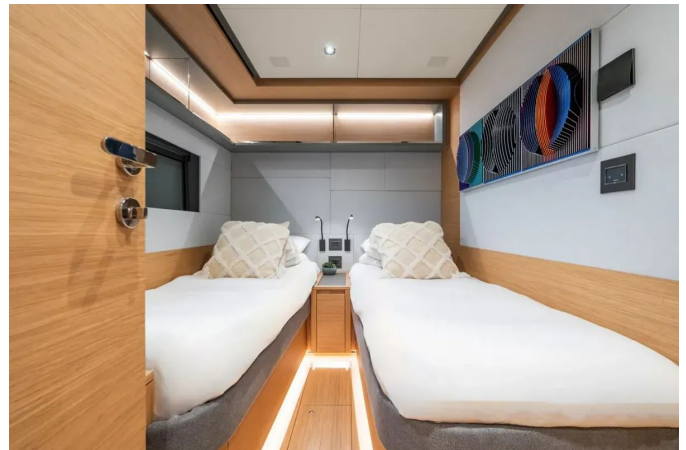














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Pardo 75

Spanning seventy-five feet, SIMON redefines the dialogue between interior and exterior living, marrying Italian refinement with dynamic performance and exceptional versatility. Her uncommon four-cabin layout—a rarity in this class—provides generous comfort and adaptable accommodation for extended cruising. Practical systems underline her autonomy: a 23 kW generator paired with a 2500 W inverter support life aboard, while sleek black waterlines and standard Silvertex Ice sunbeds refine her modern profile. An electric, waterproof roof with integrated ceiling lights allows the main deck to open to the sky at the touch of a button, and LED illumination artfully highlights the deck and bathing platform, the latter finished in natural teak with contrasting black caulking. Six openable hull portholes bring fresh sea air into the interior, where a welcoming saloon sofa flows into the open-space galley. The helm is equipped with the standard electronics package featuring three 16-inch displays across the main dashboard together with a Volvo trip computer and Volvo autopilot, and the onboard audio experience is elevated by a high-performance entertainment sound system package, complemented by a dedicated entertainment system for the owner's cabin and a home-automation interface that manages air conditioning and lighting.

Hull and deck

From an expansive swim platform equipped with the Transformer system, you command the water—this multi-function arrangement converts into a gangway, a bathing ladder and a tender-launch mechanism with graceful efficiency. Up to two mooring winches are provided forward to simplify docking operations, while up to two stern mooring winches aft are fitted with

hi-lo systems for refined handling. Shore power is managed by a Glendinning 220 V electric cable winder, and two retractable cleats on the bathing platform offer secure stowage for a dinghy or jet ski. Practicality is paired with polish in a deck fresh-water washdown system complete with a city connection, alongside two refrigerators integrated into the aft seat bench and two further refrigerators beneath the bow lounge seating. Exterior upholstery in Eden is supplied with selectable colors, shade is available via a forward sun awning with included poles and an electric bimini over the stern cockpit, and expansive electric-hydraulic side terraces extend at the touch of a button to open the deck to the sea.

Interior

A dedicated wine cellar within the salon maintains vintages at their ideal serving temperature, while everyday living is elevated by a dishwasher, a washer-dryer and an ice maker for added convenience. The galley has been upgraded from the standard fit to a four-burner (220V) induction stove, accompanied by a microwave to enable swift and versatile meal preparation.

Engine

Driven by a trio of Volvo 1350 IPS engines, the yacht marries assured power with finely tuned responsiveness, while Racor pre-filters with integrated water alarms provide vigilant protection for the propulsion system. A gyroscopic stabilizer preserves an exceptionally level ride both underway and at anchor, and the Volvo Dynamic Positioning System affords precise station-keeping for effortless close-quarters handling and docking.

Electric system

At the core of the yacht's electrical installation sits a Kohler night generator, providing discreet, dependable power across every onboard system. Fresh water autonomy is assured by a watermaker rated at 140 litres per hour, engineered to run from either 230V or 110V supplies so you can replenish aboard regardless of port or anchorage. For assured nocturnal navigation and operations, an electric searchlight is installed atop the vessel's superstructure, while a tropical air-conditioning system, equipped with both cooling and heating modes, maintains an indulgent interior climate in any latitude.

Electronics and entertainment

Crowning the mast is a Garmin GMR Fantom 24" 48 Random 40W radar antenna, complete with mast support and finished in an elegant black hue. Clear communication and comprehensive situational awareness are provided by the Garmin VHF 3151 alongside the Garmin AIS-800 Rx/Tx. The onboard cinema experience is centered on a 50" LED smart TV with an electric lifting system in the upper deck saloon, accompanied by a 50" LED smart TV in the owner's cabin and a 28" smart TV in the third cabin paired with a FUSION MS-SRX-400. The Entertainment Ultra-High Performance package is built around the FUSION APOLLO RA770 with four zones and is bolstered by two JL-AUDIO M800/8v2-12V speakers delivering eight channels x 100W. Zone 2, the cockpit aft, is fitted with two 8,8" JL_AUDDIO M6-880X-C SERIE speakers; Zone 3, the stern sunbed, mirrors this arrangement with two 8,8" JL_AUDDIO M6-880X-C SERIE speakers; and Zone 4, the master cabin, features two speakers supported by a 2 x 20W amplifier with NRX-300 remote control.

Other accessories

A discrete LED blacklight that illuminates the boat's name enhances its nighttime presence with a refined, understated glow, while a dedicated chain counter provides precise, reliable control when anchoring. A carefully tailored suite of protective canvases—including covers for the cockpit table, the cockpit sunbeds, the bow sunbed and the salon windows—safeguards interior finishes and helps maintain a pristine, like-new appearance.

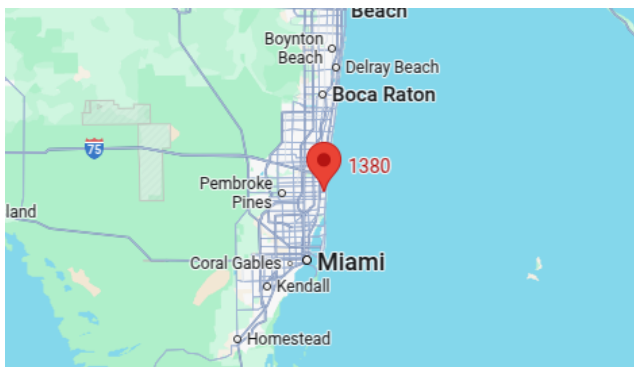
