Propelled by robust Caterpillar engines and an advanced hydrofoil system, she charges through the ocean to a heart racing 54 knots while delivering exceptional seakeeping, extended range, and notable fuel economy. Constructed in military grade composite and equipped with self righting capability, THUNDER CHILD II is a record setting, genuinely unsinkable performance yacht, built for severe offshore arenas and peak athleticism, equally at home as an explorer yacht or a superyacht chase boat.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

M/Y THUNDER CHILD II, the XSV20 developed by Safehaven Marine, is a remarkable high-speed offshore patrol, search-and-rescue interceptor and cruiser launched in early 2019 and engineered for exceptional performance and unwavering seakeeping in demanding conditions. At twenty-three meters (seventy-five-foot) overall, she unites a patented hybrid hull concept with military-grade composite construction to deliver both operational resilience and refined seakeeping for long-range, high-speed missions. The XSV20's patented hybrid geometry marries a twin-stepped asymmetrical catamaran form with a wave-piercing deep-V monohull, producing the transverse stability and rough-weather capability of a catamaran together with the superior head-sea performance of a monohull; these hydrodynamic characteristics were refined through extensive R&D including tank testing of twelve scale model variants. Built on a military-spec composite platform, THUNDER CHILD II uses carbon fiber, Kevlar and vinylester resin to achieve high strength, stiffness and impact resilience, while the forward glazing incorporates twenty-five millimeter ballistic glass engineered to absorb significant wave impacts. Propulsion is provided by four Caterpillar C8.7 654 hp engines driving four France Helices surface drives in a redundant layout that preserves planing performance even with one engine offline; she tops out at fifty-four knots and cruises comfortably at thirty-five to forty knots. A fuel capacity of 11,000 liters delivers approximately seven hundred fifty to eight hundred nautical miles at cruising speed, and a distinctive fuel transfer architecture including a 2,000-liter forward ballast tank allows precise longitudinal center-of-gravity adjustment to optimize trim as sea states change. Performance is further elevated by an integral hydrofoil system designed by Hycraft, nestled

between the asymmetrical catamaran sponsons, which lifts the hull by four hundred millimeters above thirty knots, markedly reducing wetted area to improve efficiency and fuel economy at higher speeds while damping pitching and overall motions for superior seakeeping. Internally purposeful and operationally focused, THUNDER CHILD II is arranged for a crew of five with additional berths for passengers, and a fully digital glass-helm features four Simrad nineteen-inch monitors, radar, GPS chart plotting, VHF communications, forward-looking sonar and a FLIR thermal night-vision camera, complemented by a dedicated engineer's station for engine monitoring and CCTV. Survivability underpins every detail: multiple watertight compartments, commercial-standard safety and engineering throughout, and a self-righting capability that permits recovery from capsize in extreme conditions. These qualities are proven in service, with nine verified records to her name, including an offshore world-speed passage from Ireland to Iceland in under thirty-two hours over approximately 1,500 km and a new world powerboat record in the over fifty-foot class on the Cork–Fastnet Rock–Cork course.
