OVERVIEW

The 2008 Princess 75, marketed in the United States as the Viking Princess 75, is a graceful flybridge motor yacht that pairs sleek presence with athletic performance and sumptuous comfort. Measuring 75 feet (22.86 meters) overall with a sweeping 19-foot (5.79-meter) beam, her planing hull is designed for lively, confident passages under the thrust of twin Caterpillar C-32s, settling into an effortless 27-knot cruise. Bow and stern thrusters give intuitive control in tight marinas, reinforcing her dual character as a performance motor yacht and a bluewater cruising yacht.

Aboard, four elegantly finished staterooms—each appointed with its own en-suite—accommodate up to eight guests, while separate crew quarters with a dedicated head provide discreet, professional service. Warm natural cherry joinery suffuses the interior with a timeless, inviting ambiance, offset by Giallo Veneziano granite in the galley and Mojave Sand Avonite in the owner's bath for a refined, contemporary palette. Generous lounges, expansive glazing and thoughtful storage create an airy, practical living environment. Practical seafaring features such as a hydraulic swim platform, onboard water maker, underwater lighting and a comprehensive navigation suite complete the package, making the Princess 75 equally suited to leisurely family cruises, spirited coastal runs, or longer passages—an enduringly elegant flybridge cruiser that harmonizes style, substance and sea-kindly performance.

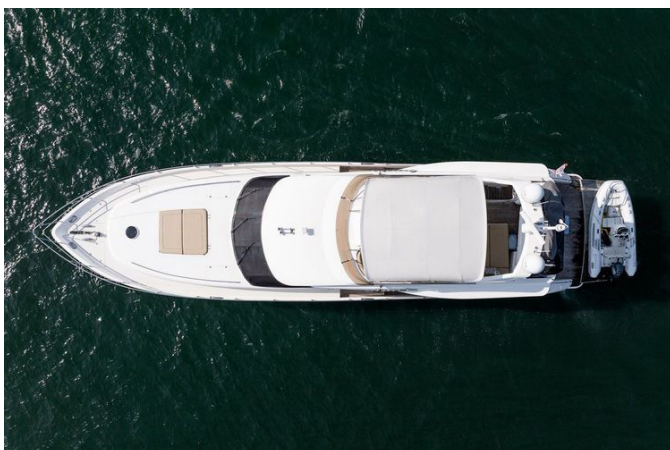

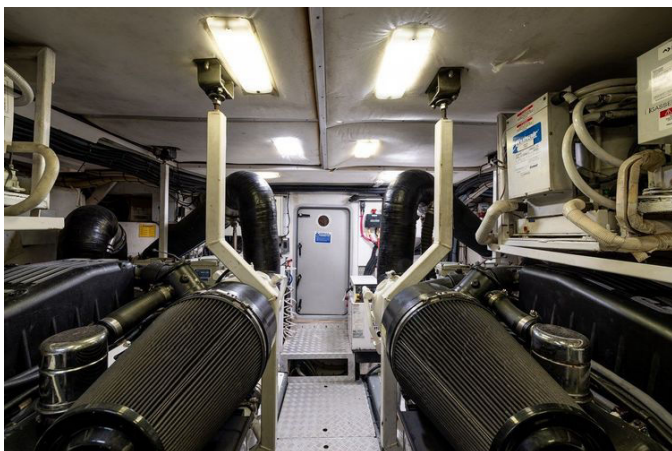

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

An accomplished, meticulously kept yacht offered turnkey, she arrives with a 2011 fourteen-foot Nautica RIB tender powered by a 60 HP Yamaha outboard that has just received complete service, and she rides on robust C-32 Caterpillars with all services up to date and new intercoolers installed in 2024. The specification delivers four cabins and four heads plus crew quarters with a full bath, supported by six new air-conditioning units added in 2024 to ensure serene climate control throughout. Her bottom was recently renewed with a complete job including PropSpeed, a new cutlass bearing and full prop service, while both bow and stern thrusters make close-quarters handling effortless. The exterior is buffed and waxed annually and enhanced by side boarding gates, four underwater lights, a new hydraulic platform fitted in 2022, an aft docking station, a new windlass, and a davit mounted on the flying bridge. The interior woodwork in Natural Cherry was beautifully refinished in 2023, the galley gleams with Giallo Veneziano granite, and the master head is finished in refined Mojave Sand Avonite. A complete Garmin system was installed in 2022 featuring two GPS units, radar, plotter, charts and autopilot, complemented by a forward-facing FLIR and a Garmin camera system with five cameras; the yacht benefits from a complete Garmin electronics suite installed in 2022 and exceptional storage has been engineered throughout the boat.

The salon invites with a generous U-shaped sofa opposite two barrel chairs and a coffee table, framed by a drop-down aft window that merges interior and aft deck at the touch of a button. Entertainment is anchored by a pop-up 42-inch Smart TV paired to a new KVH HD satellite antenna, a Bose Lifestyle surround sound stereo and a JVC DVD player, while everyday ease comes via central vac, a new headliner, new LED lighting and new window coverings. An

Beautifully appointed, the galley presents granite countertops in Giallo Veneziano, a Subzero upright refrigerator and two Subzero freezer drawers with ice maker, a four-burner cooktop with extractor fan, a stainless backsplash, a Miele dishwasher and a Broan trash compactor. Double stainless sinks with garbage disposal, a privacy door and window, a side door entrance, and extra-large drawer and cabinet storage complete a chef-friendly workspace. Adjacent, the booth-style U-shaped dinette with two additional chairs and overhead lighting makes family breakfasts and passage planning equally comfortable.

At the lower helm, twin leather helm seats front a modern suite: bow and stern thruster controls, Lenco trim tabs and a new Garmin system installed in 2022 providing radar, plotter, charts, AIS, speed and depth. Redundancy and communication are assured by Caterpillar control with emergency backups, an ICOM IC M602 VHF, an ACR spotlight control and a KVH TracPhone SAT phone, with a convenient side door for quick deck access.

The full-beam master stateroom centers on a walk-around king-size bed, a walk-in closet with safe, a vanity with chair, a new 32-inch Smart HDTV and abundant drawer storage. Its ensuite master head features a large shower with tub, Avonite countertops in Mojave Sand, a new Dometic head with bidet and multiple storage cabinets. The starboard guest stateroom offers distinctive criss-cross bunks, a hanging locker with shelves, a Samsung HDTV, a JVC stereo and a private entrance to the day head. That starboard/day head provides a booth shower, Sealand head, Avonite countertops and ensuite access back into the stateroom.

A dedicated laundry center is thoughtfully located in the companionway and fitted with a full-size Whirlpool washer and dryer in a stacked configuration. The port stateroom, with side-by-side bunks, drawer storage beneath, a hanging locker, a new Samsung HDTV and a JVC stereo, enjoys its own ensuite

head. The port head itself is spacious, with a large shower, Avonite countertops and a Sealand head. Forward, the VIP stateroom boasts a walk-around queen-size bed, a vanity with seat, a JVC receiver, a Samsung HDTV, a hanging locker and generous drawers, while its VIP head provides a stall shower, a new Dometic head with bidet, Avonite countertops, a medicine cabinet and storage beneath the sinks.

On the flybridge, captains will appreciate a new Garmin system, bow and stern thruster control, an ACR spotlight control, a Fusion stereo, an ICOM command mic and a tilt steering wheel under a new 2018 Bimini top. Two KVH domes pair with a new HD7 TV system installed in 01/2021 for reliable reception. Entertaining is effortless with an electric grill, prep sink, liquor storage, and a U-shaped settee with new upholstery, accompanied by two helm chairs with new upholstery and a sunbed also newly upholstered. For safety and deployment, there is an ACR EPIRB, a telescoping Marquipt davit with 925 lb. capacity, a Switlik ten-man life raft and a 2019 Sea Doo three-up jetski.

The aft deck extends the living space with a slide-down salon window, a teak table and chairs, and port and starboard warping windlasses. Practical touches include a cockpit shower, a crew-quarters entrance on the transom side, a bosun locker, fuel shutoffs and manual bilge pumps, plus a repeat aft docking station and four underwater lights. Below, the crew quarters offer side-by-side beds, a Sharp Aquos TV, a stall shower with sink and head, a hanging locker and a washer/dryer combo unit—ideal for extended cruising autonomy.

In the engine room, mechanicals inspire confidence: Caterpillar C32 engines rated at 1675 hp show approximately 1750 hours, supported by an Onan 27.5 kW generator, two Glendinning Cablemasters and a PM3 shore support system. A work bench and an oil change system streamline maintenance, while a 900 GPD Sea Recovery water maker underpins self-sufficiency. Rounding out the specification, the vessel's Garmin camera system with five cameras, the forward-facing FLIR and the complete Garmin electronics system installed in

2022 ensure commanding visibility and control for every passage.

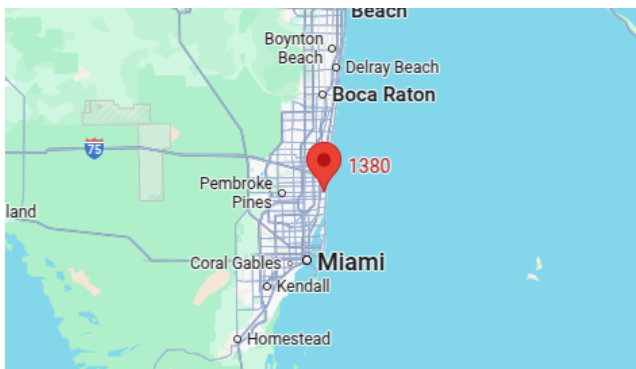
