OVERVIEW

2007 Arno Leopard 23 HT

The 2007 Arno Leopard 23 HT captures the irresistible magnetism of Italian sport-yacht artistry—sleek in silhouette, purposeful in attitude, and unapologetically glamorous. Measuring 75 feet overall with a commanding 17-foot beam, this hardtop express cuts a refined profile that makes every arrival an event. Located in the United States, she brings Mediterranean temperament to local cruising grounds, promising brisk weekends and refined coastal passages.

Under her sculpted exterior the engineering is as compelling as the styling. A deep V fiberglass hull provides composed, precise handling through a variety of sea states, and twin inboard MAN diesel engines supply the thrust to reach speeds of up to 32 knots. The ride balances suppleness with stability, delivering nimble responsiveness at the helm and a quiet assurance for all aboard. Substantial fuel capacity—approximately 1,321 gallons—extends your range, while 317 gallons of fresh water support prolonged comfort during extended stays on the water.

The fixed hardtop defines the onboard experience, sheltering a generous open-air cockpit conceived for sunlit leisure and intimate evening entertaining. Expansive lounging areas encourage conversation and repose, and dining under the shaded hardtop unfolds effortlessly in the coastal breeze. Easy access to the sea makes spontaneous swims and languid afternoons at anchor natural extensions of the day.

Interior spaces are bright and welcoming, arranged for gracious living underway. Contemporary finishes and generous headroom combine with a convivial layout to create a salon that suits quiet mornings with coffee as readily as celebratory evenings with friends. A well-equipped galley is ready for extended cruising, and three elegantly completed heads offer privacy and

convenience for guests and owners alike. Thoughtful storage, clean-lined surfaces, and subtle luxury define the Leopard aesthetic throughout.

Designed for those who demand pace without compromise, this Leopard 23 HT is equally suited to slicing across open water or easing into a chic marina berth. With its performance pedigree, diesel efficiency, deep V seakeeping, and the enduring craftsmanship of Arno Leopard, she presents a compelling synthesis of speed, style, and sumptuous comfort—ideal for enthusiasts of sport yachts, express cruisers, hardtop performance motor yachts, or Mediterranean-style open cruisers.

















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Main description

The 2007 Arno Leopard 75 Express motor yacht, aptly named "Happy One," blends sculpted Italian elegance with exhilarating performance; measuring 75.4 feet overall, its sleek fiberglass planing hull delivers poise, stability, and a wonderfully smooth ride at speed. Twin MAN D2842LE406 diesel engines, each producing 1,183 horsepower, propel the yacht to a maximum hull speed of 32 knots, while the V-Drive configuration enhances maneuverability for effortless close-quarters handling. Designed for luxurious cruising, the interior provides three cabins and three heads, offering generous space for relaxation and privacy; a robust windlass and advanced battery systems complete a well-considered specification, ensuring confident, seamless days on the water and unhurried evenings at anchor.

Accommodations

Thoughtfully appointed to welcome family and guests, the yacht provides three guest staterooms, each with its own private en-suite head, for a total of seven berths: two on the queen-size master berth, two on the queen-size VIP stateroom, and three in the guest stateroom. Complementing this generous layout, the vessel also offers comfortable crew quarters for two with a private head, ensuring professional service and discreet separation between guest and crew areas.

Master stateroom

Positioned forward for optimal volume and privacy, the master stateroom is richly finished with leather flooring and features a separate private head and a

dedicated shower, creating a serene retreat at the heart of the yacht.

Galley

The galley is equipped to gourmet standards with top-of-the-line appliances, including a Miele dishwasher and a Miele oven, complemented by a full upright refrigerator and a separate deep freezer, ensuring effortless provisioning for extended cruises.

Electronics and helm

At the helm, intuitive command meets robust redundancy with twin Furuno NavNet VX2 radar/chartplotter screens, a Furuno NavPilot autopilot system, a Furuno marine VHF radio, a Furuno GP-32 GPS WAAS navigator, and a Furuno RD-30 that displays depth, temperature, and multi-data. Systems oversight is strengthened by a Diginav tank-level control and monitoring system and an ELBEX CCTV control system, while two handheld marine VHF radios add flexible communication throughout the vessel.


