OVERVIEW

ELEVATION, a 2016 Prestige 750, commands the eye with modern European profiles and interior volume more akin to a significantly larger vessel. She embodies a polished synthesis of pace, comfort, and everyday liveaboard practicality, marrying graceful lines to utilitarian refinement.

Below deck her layout accommodates four staterooms — including a private full-beam owner's suite — with separate aft crew quarters and sleeping arrangements for up to eight guests, creating a true home at sea. A sun-drenched salon and dining area, embraced by generous panoramic glass, form an open, congenial heart for social life aboard, while exterior spaces extend entertaining possibilities across the flybridge, foredeck, and aft deck. The flybridge is sheltered beneath a hardtop with an opening sunroof and is thoughtfully appointed with a wet bar, a dining set, and expansive sun loungers for relaxation or convivial gatherings. Forward, the foredeck offers a private sitting area and a large sunpad for serene repose, and the cockpit provides a shaded alfresco dining experience. A hydraulic swim platform simplifies sea access and makes launching tenders and water toys effortless. Powered by upgraded MAN V8-1200s, ELEVATION delivers efficient cruising and assured handling whether managed by an owner-operator or a full crew. Enhanced systems, a well-organized engine room, and proven Prestige engineering ensure she performs admirably on long passages or impromptu weekend escapes. A distinguished flybridge motor yacht, she reads equally as a luxury motor yacht, a versatile cruising yacht, and a refined performance motoryacht.





















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Notable features

Draped in a Champagne Metallic hull, this yacht pairs upgraded MAN V8 1200s with intuitive joystick controls and a rear docking station for effortless close-quarters handling, while Raymarine electronics keep you confidently informed both underway and at the dock. A Sea Keeper 16 gyro stabilizer steadies the ride at anchor and en route, and a thirteen-foot AB tender powered by a sixty hp Yamaha extends your reach from ship to shore with assured poise and reliability.

Salon

The salon flows with warm wooden floors throughout and tailored privacy via salon door curtains, creating an inviting, salon-level living area where a plush love seat to starboard balances a U-shaped sofa to port to form a convivial conversation pit. Entertainment is cinematic with a retractable forty-six-inch LED TV paired to BOSE Home Cinema V25, while an integrated Isotherm refrigerator keeps refreshments within easy reach for relaxed socializing.

Aft galley

The aft galley is a chef's stage, fully appointed with a Miele four-burner cooktop, Miele convection oven, Miele refrigerator, and Miele dishwasher, where an island counter and generous storage keep workflow effortless and twin stainless steel sinks make preparation and cleanup elegant; an adjacent dining table invites lingering over perfectly plated courses and convivial conversation.

Master cabin

The master cabin centers on a serene queen berth set against wooden floors and skylight windows that bathe the interior in natural daylight, creating a restful retreat. Indulgent amenities include a forty-inch TV with DVD and MP3 player paired to BOSE Home Cinema V25, a settee to port and a dedicated vanity and work station, while the ensuite pampers with a walk-in rainfall shower and vanity; a walk-in closet with a safe and abundant storage keeps personal effects impeccably organized.

VIP cabin

The VIP cabin welcomes guests with a queen berth and refined finishes that evoke a boutique-suite atmosphere, complemented by a thirty-two-inch TV with DVD and MP3 player and a flexible vanity and work station. A private ensuite with a walk-in rainfall shower and vanity, a walk-in closet, and smart storage throughout deliver a polished and comfortable guest experience at sea.

Starboard guest cabin

The starboard guest cabin features convertible twin side-by-side berths that adapt from singles to a double at a moment's notice, a twenty-two-inch TV with DVD and MP3 player, and ample wardrobe storage to keep travel cases and personal items neatly out of sight, making it ideal for flexible hosting.

Port guest cabin

To port, the guest cabin mirrors the flexible layout with convertible twin side-by-side berths, a twenty-two-inch TV with DVD and MP3 player, and

wardrobe storage, with convenient shared access to the day head for effortless hosting and guest comfort.

Crew quarters

Purpose-built crew quarters provide two single berths, abundant storage, and a practical wet head with a walk-in shower and sink to ensure the team is rested and ready, with added comforts including a nineteen-inch TV with DVD and MP3 player and a Miele washer and Miele dryer to keep wardrobe and linens shipshape on extended passages.

Flybridge area

The flybridge is an alfresco sanctuary where a helm station equipped with Raymarine electronics and joystick control places fingertip command at the helm. U-shaped seating gathers around a teak table opposite a portside prep station with sink and grill, while an Isotherm refrigerator and an ice maker keep service seamless. Entertainment flows through Fusion audio controls and Sony marine speakers, and comfort is assured beneath a hardtop with a retractable sunroof, a retractable awning, and teak decking, with a forward sun pad inviting unhurried lounging and panoramic views.

Foredeck

On the foredeck, a forward-facing bench and a large sunpad create an irresistible vantage for passages and anchorages alike, with Sony marine speakers setting the soundtrack, while robust ground tackle stands ready to secure your favorite coves with confidence.

Cockpit

The cockpit balances sociable design and seamanship with bench seating and chairs arrayed around a teak table set on elegant teak decking, creating a convivial outdoor dining and lounging space. A rear docking station simplifies close-quarters handling, an ice maker keeps refreshments flowing, and an underfoot hatch provides direct access to the engine room for practical maintenance.

Machinery

Machinery highlights include two MAN V8 1200s for assured performance, backed by two Kohler generators rated at twenty-three kW with hours of operation shown as 1700 and 1390 respectively for quiet, redundant power. Ride quality is tamed by a Sea Keeper 16 gyro stabilizer, while shipwide energy management is handled by a MASS 24/2500 inverter, one Mastervolt Chargemaster 24/100-3 for engine batteries, one Mastervolt Chargemaster 12/25-3 for generator batteries, and two Mastervolt Chargemaster 24/30-3 units for stern thruster and service batteries. Shore power is streamlined via two Glendinning Cable Master fifty amp systems; fuel polishing is managed through Racor fuel filters for the main engines and Racor fuel filters for the generators. Comfort is tropical-grade with 124,000 BTU upgraded air conditioning, while practical touches include an engine oil change system, bow and stern thrusters, underwater lights, a fire suppression system, and a hydraulic swim platform.

Navigation and communication

The helm is anchored by Raymarine electronics, including a dual-station multifunction Glass Bridge with multitouch sixteen-inch GS165 displays and a

P70R color autopilot, while long-range awareness comes via digital radar with a forty-eight nautical mile antenna and a high-definition open-array seventy-two nautical mile Raydome. Communications are crisp through Ray 260E VHF with handset and loudspeakers, and situational awareness is enhanced by an AIS650 Class B AIS transducer and a KHV satellite dome; both a reverse camera and an engine-room camera extend visibility for confident maneuvering and monitoring.

Deck equipment

Practical deckkeeping is simplified by a dedicated washdown control that makes quick work of salt and spray after spirited runs, ensuring the exterior remains pristine with minimal effort.
