OVERVIEW

The 2019 SES Yachts 23M is a beautifully realized semi custom flybridge motor yacht, conceived for unhurried passages and an effortless life aboard.

Propelled by twin CAT C12.9s, each rated at 1,000 hp and showing about 400 hours, she combines reliable speed with hushed refinement and composed handling.

Her accommodation is arranged for eight guests across four cabins: a full beam master positioned amidships, a forward VIP suite, and two further guest staterooms, each with its own en suite. Separate crew quarters sleep up to four, ensuring discreet, professional service on every cruise.

Inside, a light, intelligently organized interior unfolds to a generous salon, an intimate dining area, and a chef friendly galley complete with an island countertop, cooktop, refrigerator, freezer, and ample storage to support extended cruising.

On deck, the cockpit welcomes alfresco dining, while the expansive flybridge cruiser layout offers sunpads, deep lounging areas and a secondary helm. Bow and stern thrusters, twin generators and a hydraulic bathing platform enhance this luxury motor yacht's versatility, making her an ideal family cruiser for refined coastal exploration.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Flybridge

Forward, a generous sunbed invites unhurried lounging, while the commanding helm station places repeaters and responsive throttles at your fingertips for confident control. Entertain with ease around the huge U shaped seating that wraps elegantly around low coffee tables, with outside storage thoughtfully integrated to keep the deck clear. Overhead, a fixed roof with integrated speakers and ambient lights sets the mood from sunrise to after dusk, and a convenient wet bar with sink and hob completes this elevated open air haven.

Cockpit

A fixed dining table anchors the cockpit for long, lingering meals, complemented by welcoming bench seating that keeps family and friends gathered together. A sliding door glides open to reveal the saloon, while wide, secure stairs lead gracefully up to the flybridge, creating a seamless indoor outdoor flow.

Swim platform

A hydraulic swim platform transforms into a dependable tender storage solution at the touch of a button, expanding your capability at anchor. Stairs to port and starboard lead up into the cockpit for effortless circulation, while a dedicated entrance gives direct access to the crew accommodation. Practical access gates add peace of mind when boarding or swimming.

Side decks & bow area

Full teak side decks frame purposeful walkways to the bow on both port and starboard, making movement sure-footed and refined. Forward, built-in seating with a comfortable footrest turns the foredeck into a private retreat, with dedicated fender storage keeping gear tidy. A watertight door to the helm station ensures safe, swift passage for the crew, while twin anchors to port and starboard with an anchor windlass stand ready for secure holding.

Lower helm

At the lower helm, twin Raymarine HybridTouch chart plotters deliver crisp, intuitive navigation, complemented by precise thruster control for confident maneuvering. An engine control screen keeps vital data clearly in view, while a VHF ensures reliable communication whenever you venture offshore.

Saloon

The saloon welcomes you with a refined coffee table and a large L-shaped sofa that invites relaxed conversation, while discreet storage to starboard keeps the space uncluttered. A finely tuned speaker system enriches the ambiance, and the sweeping 360° view bathes every moment in natural light and sea-going drama.

Galley

Culinary ambitions are at home in the galley, where an island work surface maximizes prep space alongside a sleek hob and a stainless steel sink. A full-size fridge and freezer pair with generous stowage to make provisioning effortless for extended cruising.

Dinette

Opposite the galley, the dinette features a large fixed wooden table to starboard, its warm grain inviting convivial dining, while comfortable bench seating ensures everyone has a perfect place at the table.

Master cabin

Positioned midships for exceptional stability, the master cabin is a sanctuary with a large island berth, flanked by bedside tables and illuminated by a large mirror that enhances the sense of space. A walk-in wardrobe and a refined dressing table that doubles as a desk add practical luxury, with plentiful storage seamlessly integrated. The en-suite unfolds as a private spa, complete with a separate shower, sink, heads, and an additional mirror.

VIP guest cabin

The VIP guest cabin centers on a double island berth, complemented by a mirror and a full hanging wardrobe. Natural light pours through a hatch to the bow, while large mirrored panels with blinds offer both brightness and privacy. A refined en-suite with shower and sink ensures comfort worthy of your most discerning guests.

Guest cabin 1

Guest Cabin 1 presents an inviting offset double berth, with opening portholes drawing in fresh sea air. A bedside table, large mirror, and a hanging wardrobe provide thoughtful amenities, while the private en-suite adds a shower, sink, heads, and a further mirror for complete independence.

Crew cabin

Thoughtfully arranged crew spaces include two crew cabins with a total of 4 berths, each equipped with its own heads, ensuring privacy and efficiency that support professional service on every passage.

Engineering

Power comes from 2 × CAT C12.9 – 1000 HP, delivering confident performance across the range. Shipboard autonomy is supported by a CAT 27 kW generator complemented by a CAT 13 kW generator, while both bow thruster and stern thruster provide precise low speed control in tight marinas.


