OVERVIEW

The striking Sunseeker 76 Yacht embodies everything expected of a luxury flybridge motor yacht, presenting superb seakeeping thanks to its advanced deep-V hull and a class-leading sense of volume across exquisitely finished decks, all wrapped in unmistakable superyacht style.

Dominant on the skyline, the 76 beckons with sweeping glazing that floods the interior with sunlight. The airy main deck offers an almost 360-degree panorama ideal for effortless entertaining, while alfresco living is raised to an art by expansive, configurable spaces shaped to your tastes. This performance flybridge yacht marries bluewater capability with the poise and refinement of a premium luxury vessel.

The aft cockpit can be specified with extra lounge seating or a stylish cocktail bar, and at the stern a versatile mini beach club awaits, fitted with a barbecue and fold-out seating for convivial moments with family and friends. An extended hydraulic bathing platform carries a Williams 445 tender, SeaBobs and additional water toys. Forward, the intelligently arranged foredeck provides generous twin sunpads, forward and aft seating and refrigeration, optimizing comfort and sociability on every cruise.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Factory installed options

Specified with an extensive suite of factory-installed enhancements, this yacht combines performance, poise and polish in equal measure. Power is delivered by twin MAN V12 1550 engines (two x 1550 PS), complemented by Auto Troll for the transmissions to ensure eloquent slow-speed maneuvering, while an aft electric awning shades the cockpit at the touch of a button and a Bootstripe in Jet Black underscores the White hull for a crisp, modern profile. The flybridge hard-top sides, undersides and rear canopy are sprayed Jet Black, with the radar scanner finished in LSA Jet Black and the radar chair equipment, including VHF whip aerials, also finished in Jet Black (no warranty offered). A panoramic sliding sunroof in the flybridge brow floods the main deck with light and ventilation, and a retractable centre canopy adds adaptable shelter as conditions demand.

The Beach Club Package transforms the waterline into a private resort by integrating a marine electric grill into a drop-down workstation, a fold-down platform seat and an overhead shower mounted to a gull-wing door on the platform. Fresh-water deck wash outlets are fitted on the bathing platform, flybridge and foredeck, and the foredeck itself is appointed for luxurious relaxation with a sail canopy supported by 6 carbon-fibre poles, a teak foredeck table with a fixed top on a polished stainless-steel leg and a forward seating group whose folding backrest converts to a sunbed via a fold-out in-fill board and cushion, the board supported by a teak coffee table on a telescopic leg. Teak forward side decks extend to include the anchor deck and the seating group deck, and boarding is simplified by a Side Mount Stairway with hull fittings to port and starboard.

On deck and at the bar, an additional 110 V AC double socket is fitted in the

flybridge wet bar, the wetbar gains a raised shelf bar top with LED lights, and the cockpit is serviced by an Isotherm IceDrink Clear icemaker. Refrigeration is further elevated by a stainless-steel, dual-voltage Vitrifrigo arrangement with a refrigerator above and a lower freezer/refrigerator compartment below, plus dedicated mini-bar refrigeration. Power resilience arrives via an Entertainment Inverter with seamless transfer to run the entertainment system from the boat's DC batteries, and a separate Refrigeration Inverter to power refrigeration from the DC supply.

Navigation and visibility are bolstered by a CCTV suite with three cameras, including stern docking and engine monitoring views and an Iris S460 Marine High Definition stainless-steel dome 3 MP IP wide-angle docking camera; built-in infrared LEDs operate automatically via a day/night filter, illuminating up to 10 meters at night and in low-light conditions. Four underwater lights add drama at anchor, while dark-tinted film to the side windows and sliding doors enhances privacy. A taller radar chair is specified to accommodate sat domes, and a main console specification completes the helm architecture with confidence.

The specification is exceptionally complete and practical: a Lewmar 50 kg Delta galvanized anchor is paired with 90 metres of 12 mm galvanized chain, and anchoring comfort is matched by a large grey-water storage tank with 800 litres of capacity. Interior movement and service are elevated by preparation for a spa tub installation on the flybridge, including hot and cold water feeds, drain pipework and electrical supply, all terminated above the cockpit ceiling panels; a second hot-water calorifier is included for boats with a spa tub. A water maker crowns the autonomy package in the form of the Spot Zero Seaxchange Compact, a fully automatic fresh-watermaker RO system with a local 7" colour touchscreen producing up to 4,542 litres (1,200 U.S. gal) per 24 hrs, paired with a water purifier serving the icemaker. Practicality continues with a Splendide washer/dryer in the lobby outside the master cabin and an engine-room access door from the crew cabin, noting this access is not

possible with voltage regulator or shore-power converter options.

Comfort is curated with sprung mattresses for the beds in the master cabin, the forward cabin, the starboard mid cabin and the port mid cabin, the port mid cabin further gaining two single beds on an electrically operated slider that can form an occasional double. The saloon is refined with wood flooring through the saloon, dining and helm areas, and its aft patio door curtains are upgraded to JH-JAVA 31646/02 MUTED SILVER. Upholstery details include central panels above the master headboard in FABRICUT ABOA SNOW, an upgraded crew sofa in WHISTLER-MINERVE IVORY Leather, the saloon port sofa upholstered in Z and R - LUNA 10684 982 - 768947 fabric, and the saloon starboard sofa and ottoman in WS 13 OCTANS. Interior wood is specified to Band Two with a choice of either Flamed Dark Walnut Nero Legna or Smoked eucalyptus figured in a satin-finish lacquer, allowing an elegant, contemporary ambiance.

Exterior lounging is seamlessly thought-through with a corner seating group positioned on the forward port side of the cockpit and a folding backrest enhancing the flybridge forward seating group, while a comprehensive Covers Package protects key areas including aft cockpit seating and table, foredeck seating, foredeck sunpad and table, plus flybridge seating, sunpad, table and helm seat covers, with optional aft cockpit seating group covers supplied for the corner seat, separate seat base and ottoman. Aft, a refined bootstripe in Jet Black aligns with the yacht's overall monochrome aesthetic.

Technology and connectivity come together with the Performance AV Package, an upgraded network system and the USA Platinum Package to harmonize entertainment and user experience across regions, while décor details are elevated with an upgraded shower cubicle bulkhead stone in P - Minoli Statuario Fantastico - Polished. Finally, the specification confirms a foredeck sail canopy, a retractable centre canopy, a panoramic sliding sunroof and dark-tint side glazing, making this a singularly complete and beautifully

resolved build; in keeping with the bespoke brief, the yacht is delivered without the standard bed covers, pillow shams or loose cushions, allowing owners to finish these soft goods to their exact taste.
