## OVERVIEW

---

The 2015 Viking 76' Enclosed Bridge artfully combines the refinement of a premier motor yacht with the uncompromising capability of a professional sportfisherman, delivering an elegant platform that is equally at home on long coastal passages and in competitive tournaments. Stretching to an LOA of 76 feet with a commanding 20-foot beam, this hull is built on sturdy fiberglass and conveys a secure, sea-kindly demeanor. Twin inboard MTU diesels provide spirited propulsion, settling into an efficient 33-knot cruise and capable of pushing to approximately 39 knots when speed is required. The climate-controlled enclosed bridge offers an elevated, panoramic helm environment that unites ergonomic controls, quiet comfort, and lounge-like accommodations for both captain and guests. With roughly 2,945 gallons of fuel and 425 gallons of fresh water aboard, this yacht supports extended passages and ambitious itineraries along the U.S. coastline and beyond. Inside, Viking's meticulous joinery and sumptuous materials create an atmosphere of restrained luxury, where the main salon flows seamlessly to a well-appointed galley and dining area designed for effortless entertaining underway or at anchor. Private staterooms are complemented by five thoughtfully configured heads to ensure guest comfort and privacy. A capacious, purpose-built cockpit reinforces the vessel's fighting-boat heritage, providing expansive working room for anglers, cleverly integrated storage for tackle and provisions, and comfortable mezzanine seating that keeps the crew engaged with the action. Whether configured for family cruising or tournament duty, this Viking 76 Enclosed Bridge represents the intersection of sophisticated yachting and hard-core fishing performance.

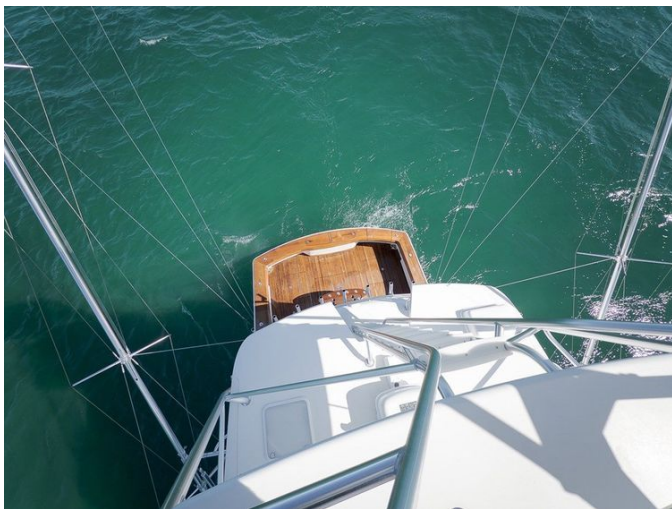

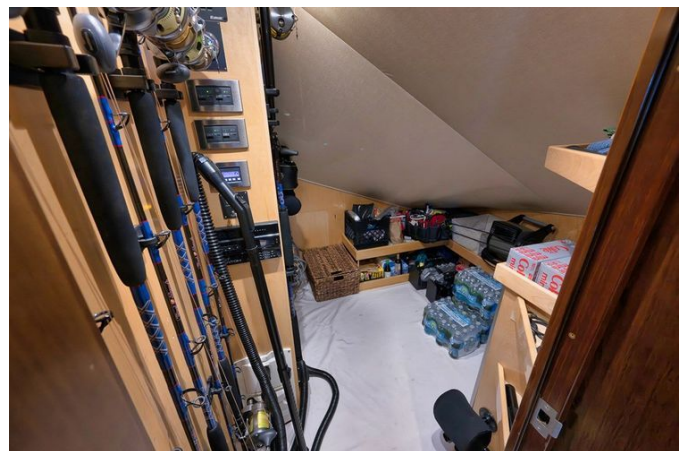






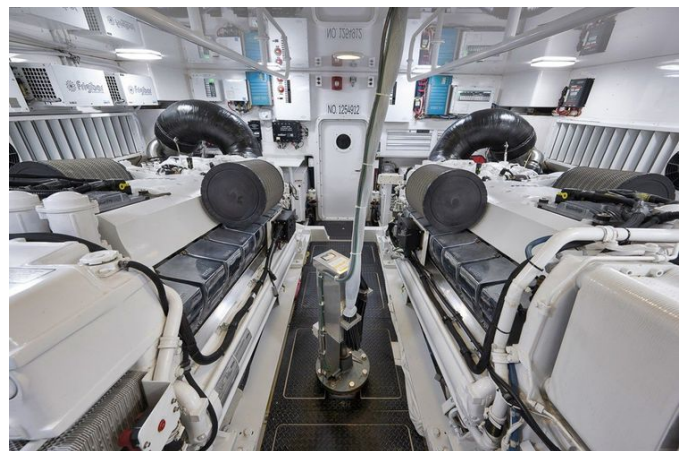

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Main description

---

Step aboard this outstanding 2015 Viking 76 Enclosed Bridge, currently berthed in the esteemed Ocean Reef Club, and discover a vessel that merges Viking's storied build quality, exhilarating performance, and refined accommodations. Crafted to satisfy both the owner-operator and the dedicated sportfisher, this 76 EB combines tournament-capable systems with the comfort and appointments of a motoryacht. Twin upgraded MTU 16V2000 M94 engines producing 2,600 HP apiece propel her to comfortable cruise speeds in the 30-knot range and allow her to reach near-40-knot top-end runs while delivering a composed, sea-kindly ride. The enclosed bridge provides a climate-controlled helm with exceptional sightlines, making extended passages and offshore runs especially comfortable and confidence-inspiring. Impeccably maintained and enhanced over time, she benefits from a Seakeeper gyro stabilizer for smoother underway comfort, a hydraulic bow thruster for precise handling, an onboard watermaker, and increased fuel capacity to support longer voyages and serious fishing campaigns. The interior balances elegance and utility: a generous salon bathed in natural light features premium finishes and custom cabinetry, while below decks a five-stateroom, four-head arrangement including a full-beam master offers accommodations on par with much larger motoryachts. Aft, the expansive cockpit is laid out for serious offshore fishing with teak decking, mezzanine seating, a livewell, refrigerated storage and abundant tackle stowage, reflecting Viking's well-earned reputation for fishability. Between the enclosed bridge and the aft flybridge there are multiple commanding stations and social gathering areas, all supported by high-end electronics and comfortable seating. Whether targeting billfish in the Gulf Stream or enjoying a leisurely cruise through the Keys, this

2015 Viking 76 Enclosed Bridge represents an exceptional chance to own a proven, performance-oriented luxury sportfisher.

## Notable features

---

The yacht's equipment list has been thoughtfully enhanced to a high standard, highlighted by a Seakeeper 35 gyro installed in December 2024 and remaining under warranty, complemented by a Furuno Omni Sonar 8 and Starlink high speed connectivity. Guests will appreciate the FCI Spot Free system and ElectroSea treatment, while onboard entertainment is elevated with Apple TV in both the salon and the master. Practical and serviceable upgrades include new LED lighting in the engine room, newly fitted underwater lights, and fresh Frigibar refrigeration — a cockpit freezer and a stepbox refrigerator — all chosen to deliver reliability and comfort.

## Galley

---

The galley is appointed for chef-caliber performance, marrying commercial-quality appliances with refined finishes: a KitchenAid oven, a Miele four-burner electric cooktop, an LG microwave and a Kenmore trash compactor, all centered by an under-mount stainless-steel sink backed by a mirror backsplash and set upon durable Amtico flooring. Expansive granite countertops and a granite-topped island provide ample prep surfaces and informal gathering space, while abundant cabinetry and elegant crown molding throughout the galley and dinette enhance both storage and style. Cold storage is exceptional, comprising two Sub-Zero freezers alongside four Sub-Zero refrigeration units, and provisioning is further extended by a walk-in pantry complete with a wine cooler. Practicality is woven into the layout with a dog house that accommodates the AN system while offering additional stowage, and the social area is finished with an L-shaped couch with

under-seat storage reupholstered in August 2025 and three bar stools reupholstered in January 2020.

## Dinette

---

At the center of the dinette rests a rich teak table, embraced by U-shaped seating that conceals discreet storage beneath the cushions. A built-in bar with an ice maker keeps chilled refreshments conveniently at hand, while a fitted carpet topped with a protective runner lends an air of refinement and shields the busiest pathways.

## Master stateroom

---

Occupying the yacht's full beam, the master stateroom is a tranquil sanctuary centered on a king-size bed with ample storage beneath, accompanied by two nightstands and enhanced by two hanging closets and two chests each formed by four stacked drawers for immaculate organization. Port and starboard hull windows bathe the space in natural light, highlighting a bespoke seating area to starboard and a dedicated work desk to port, all laid over plush carpeting finished with an elegant runner. A 41-inch flat-screen Samsung TV provides entertainment, while climate settings are managed via the A/C controller and daily upkeep is simplified by the central vacuum system.

## Master head

---

A polished sink nestled into a granite countertop provides the centerpiece of the master head, its surface complemented by the warmth of a custom Amtico floor underfoot. The roomy walk-in shower is appointed with satin nickel fixtures, while a Dometic toilet offers reliable comfort. Walls clad in refined wallpaper and a mirror housing an integrated medicine cabinet introduce

subtle luxury, and towel bars and rings in brushed nickel complete the scheme with a coordinated, low-key luster.

## Forward VIP stateroom

---

The Forward VIP stateroom welcomes guests with a queen mattress set over generous under-bed storage, placed on plush carpet safeguarded by a protective runner for whisper-quiet luxury underfoot. Entertainment is delivered through a 41-inch flat-screen TV, while a hanging closet and cabinet storage provide orderly space for personal effects. A window escape hatch bathes the cabin in natural light and adds an extra layer of reassurance, and discreet floor storage grants bilge access and serviceability to the bow thruster. Climate is easily tailored with A/C control, ensuring a perfectly tempered, refined retreat.

## Forward VIP stateroom head

---

Luxuriously appointed for both comfort and functionality, the forward VIP stateroom head showcases a polished basin recessed into a granite countertop, complemented by a mirrored medicine cabinet above and cabinet storage beneath the sink to keep necessities neatly stowed. A generous walk-in shower is fitted with satin nickel fixtures that lend a refined note, while a dependable Dometic toilet provides everyday convenience. The sole is finished in custom Amtico flooring, with coordinating Amtico details throughout for a cohesive, durable, and designer look.

## Starboard stateroom

---

Elegantly positioned on the starboard side, this stateroom utilizes an efficient layout with upper and lower bunks that prioritize both comfort and space.

Storage is generous, with two hanging closets and two pull-out drawers, while a 26-inch flat-screen TV provides onboard entertainment. Practical features such as a central vacuum system and NC control add everyday convenience, and plush carpet with a runner underfoot completes the sophisticated, seafaring atmosphere.

## Starboard head

---

Meticulously styled, the starboard head presents a sink recessed into a granite countertop beneath a mirror that houses an integrated medicine cabinet, with practical storage tucked beneath the unit. A dependable Dometic toilet complements a spacious walk-in shower, each finished over elegant, hard-wearing Amtico flooring.

## Port stateroom

---

Situated to port and styled as a tranquil sanctuary, this stateroom centers on a queen berth with abundant storage located beneath the mattress, flanked by left and right nightstands and served by a hanging closet ideal for extended-cruise wardrobes. Comfort is refined with individual A/C control and sumptuous carpeting with an accompanying runner underfoot, while thoughtful conveniences such as a central vacuum system and two pull-out drawers maintain an uncluttered environment. A 26-inch flat-screen TV provides in-cabin entertainment, rounding out a serene yet highly practical private suite.

## Port Jack & Jill head

---

Sumptuously appointed, the port Jack & Jill head presents twin basins recessed into a granite countertop with practical storage tucked beneath, accompanied

by a Dometic toilet, a mirror concealing a medicine cabinet, resilient Amtico flooring and an expansive walk-in shower that enhances both comfort and style.

## Companionway

---

Underfoot, sumptuous carpeting and a tailored protective runner welcome guests into the space while a dedicated linen closet keeps essentials impeccably organized. Practical systems are discreetly integrated into the layout: concealed bilge storage preserves clean lines and the fresh water tank is readily accessible for quick inspection and routine service. A carefully arranged laundry area pairs an Ariston dryer with an Asko washer to simplify onboard living, and a central vacuum system maintains every surface in pristine condition.

## Enclosed bridge

---

From this elegantly appointed enclosed bridge you take the helm with assurance: the helm sits forward with a plush captain's chair, surrounded by generous port and starboard lounge seating. An inviting L-shaped sofa with storage underneath—reupholstered 8/25—melds with a refined coffee table to form a welcoming social center. A window hatch above the captain's chair brings in natural light and fresh air, while integrated cabinet storage is thoughtfully placed throughout. Entertainment is provided by a 34" Samsung TV and two JL Audio speakers, and daily convenience is enhanced by two Sub Zero refrigerators, a central vac system, and an A/C controller. The deck is finished in carpet with a tailored runner, completing the bridge's quietly sophisticated atmosphere.

## Aft bridge station

---

The aft bridge station is meticulously appointed for precise command, anchored by a Garmin 8212 display and a Garmin Autopilot GHC20 control, with hydraulic outrigger controls and a dedicated bow thruster control to ensure effortless maneuvering in tight quarters. A Fusion head unit fills the space with sound via two JL Audio speakers while a high-intensity spotlight stands ready for night operations. Engine ignition, an intuitive helm and smooth, responsive throttles are all laid out for immediate use, complemented by a dependable compass for traditional bearings. Anglers will find ten rod holders and Miya Epoch US9HD teaser reels at the ready, and convivial comfort is provided by mezzanine seating to starboard.

## Cockpit

---

The cockpit is an invitation to both comfort and function, where a teak-clad environment—teak cockpit, teak covering boards and a teak mezzanine—frames generous mezzanine seating. That mezzanine conceals an array of purpose-built systems: a refrigerated step box, two freezers, two storage boxes, a tackle drawer, an Eskimo ice chipper that deposits into the port box and a crushed-ice machine that feeds the port mezzanine box, all crowned by a Release table. Three rod holders in each haunch (six total) keep tackle at the ready while dedicated fishing features include a starboard in-floor livewell with fish box, an additional port fish box and transom tuna tubes. Systems and conveniences are equally robust—a Seakeeper 35, twin 100 amp Glendennings, two 12V and two 24V electric reel outlets, a cockpit oil pump-out, freshwater and raw-water flush capabilities and port and starboard gaff storage tucked beneath the covering boards. Entertainment is discreetly integrated with a JL Audio setup of four speakers and two subwoofers, and practical engine-room access completes this exquisitely appointed,

purpose-built cockpit.

## Bow

---

The foredeck marries confident handling with refined presence, beginning with a heavy-duty windlass that, together with the anchor pulpit, makes setting and weighing anchor effortless. A seamless bow rail provides security and comfort while underway, and the faux teak toe rail introduces a sophisticated, traditional yachting touch. A powerful 1,800 lb davit is on hand to launch and recover tenders or equipment with ease, while the distinctive black mask gives the profile a sleek, contemporary edge. Beneathfoot, resilient nonskid ensures sure footing in all conditions, rounding out a bow crafted for both elegant style and uncompromising performance.

## Engine room

---

Immaculately arranged and built for dependable performance, the engine room is powered by twin M94 16V2000 2600 HP MTU engines and backed by two 32KW generators, with the port unit at 2847 hours and the starboard at 2722 hours. Fuel quality is protected by a comprehensive polishing system, while freshwater needs are met by a 1600 GPD watermaker employing reverse osmosis alongside an FCI Spot Free unit that guarantees pristine water throughout. Navigation and subsurface awareness are enhanced by the Furuno Omni 8 sonar, and long-term hull and propulsion protection is provided by the Electrosea Clearline system. Climate control is handled by two 48K BTU chillers and three Dometic condensers driven by a pair of A/C pumps, and routine service is simplified with an onboard oil change system and two conveniently located toolboxes. Hydraulic power supplies the bow thruster, steering gear and davit, and serious anglers will appreciate the dedicated tuna tubes pump system. Safety is addressed with a Halon fire suppression system.

Fine detailing includes Awlgrip-finished brass thru-hulls with integral sea strainers, Awlgrip-coated forward bilges, clear acrylic shaft log access covers, and a 110V outlet on the aft bulkhead at the entranceway, all supported by two Isoboosters for resilient shore power management.

## Tower

---

Perched above the main deck, the tower has been meticulously outfitted to inspire confident command and constant connectivity, boasting Starlink alongside a Garmin 8212 at the helm. The station brings VHF, full engine controls, bow thruster control and autopilot together for exacting handling from this elevated vantage, while visibility is improved by spreader lights—two forward and one forward. A KHV HD6 enhances situational awareness and plush, comfortable seating completes this refined piloting enclave.

## Helm station & electronics

---

At the helm, command is both intuitive and impeccably refined, centered around four 22-inch KEP screens that integrate engine room cameras, onboard television, a FLIR M625 thermal camera, Nobeltec navigation, Furuno NavNet and radar into a single, elegant vista. Navigation and autopilot duties are entrusted to a dedicated Garmin 8624 display alongside a Garmin GHC20 autopilot, while clear, reliable communications are provided by a pair of VHF IC M604 units. An RD-33 presents essential data at a glance, and onboard ambiance and media are controlled through a Fusion MS-RA670 head unit, with spotlight operation conveniently at hand for immediate visibility. The helm also houses Seakeeper control, emergency control and the robust Octoplex system for integrated vessel management, complemented by a Viking rudder/trim indicator and two engine displays that keep performance metrics prominent. Precision handling is aided by bow thruster control, and the fishing

layout is enhanced by a Dometic ice chipper whose discharge feeds directly into the port-side mezzanine.

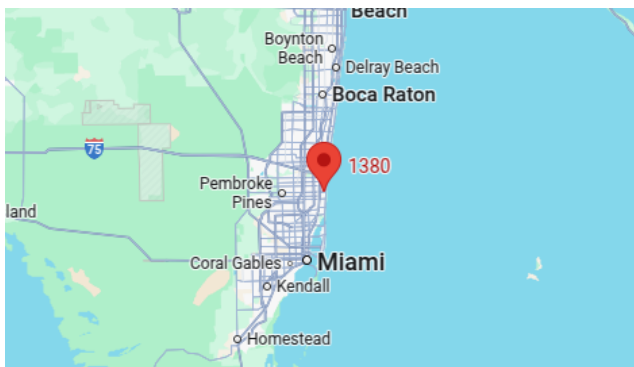
