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# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

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## Introduction

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\*WASABI\* is a lightly used family fishing and cruising yacht that has been meticulously maintained by only two owners since new. She is rigged to the maximum for extensive fishing excursions or comfortable cruising, featuring a two-hundred square foot teak cockpit with a comfortable mezzanine that includes a bait freezer, chill box, a tackle center, and abundant storage. The cockpit layout includes a Release Marine fighting chair, two in-deck fish boxes, and a transom fish box plumbed as a livewell, while beneath the cockpit a large watertight hatch covers the Seakeeper Gyro that was replaced in 2019. The seventy-six foot Viking presents an expansive salon with a large L-shaped lounge to starboard and a convenient day head aft to port, and the forward galley centers on a spacious centerline island with three stools aft and six undercounter Sub-Zero refrigerator/freezer drawer units, complemented by galley cabinets, a granite countertop and a full array of appliances. The dining settee with table is starboard forward and two walk-in lockers forward of the island provide additional cabinetry for appliances and rod storage. Forward of the salon is a full-beam master stateroom with a private en-suite head, along with four other staterooms — two with queen beds and two with over-and-under berths — and four heads in total, while a stacked washer/dryer is discreetly located in the companionway behind concealed cabinetry. On the main deck an interior staircase leads up to the enclosed flybridge with a raised platform L-shaped settee, cocktail table, refrigerator drawers, pop-up TV and a centerline helm flanked by port and starboard seating and a Stidd helm seat; an aft door opens to an exterior helm station to port and additional lounge seating, with centerline access to the Palm Beach Tower and an exterior ladder to the teak cockpit mezzanine deck. \*WASABI\*

just completed full bottom service in February 2025, including full bottom sanding and paint, all running gear fully serviced and balanced, and a complete hull detailing job, and she is immediately fish- or cruise-ready for her new owners.

## Salon

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The salon is a harmonious blend of luxury and functionality, introduced by a sliding electric door that opens to an entry landing finished in Amtico laminate crafted from American Ash with a Black Walnut border, setting an immediate tone of refinement. The entertainment package centers on a fifty-five inch Samsung LED/Plasma TV and a Bose LS 48 system with custom surround sound to deliver an immersive audio-visual experience, while the seating area offers a large L-shaped lounge with an armrest positioned by the cockpit door and a cocktail table with Mappa Burl inlay that raises to dining height for versatility. Underfoot a plush carpet sole and a full canvas carpet runner enhance comfort and protection, and custom lambrequins trimmed in fabric and teak borders are matched to décor pillows, complemented by Hunter Douglas Silhouette blinds for adjustable light and privacy; rod storage has been cleverly integrated beneath the settees to maximize usable space.

## Galley and dinette

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The galley and dinette are a masterclass in design and functionality, anchored by Gialitta granite countertops and custom Amtico flooring in American Ash with a Black Walnut border that tie the spaces together in refined style. The custom center island offers three-hundred sixty degree access and conceals refrigeration and freezer units beneath a granite top with three stools for casual dining, while the dinette settee provides additional concealed storage under the cushions and is paired with a Mappa Burl high-gloss table that

serves as a striking centerpiece. The galley is equipped with premium appliances including a garbage disposal, a Fisher Paykel dishwasher, a microwave convection oven, a Gaggenau four-burner glass electric stovetop with an electric pop-up evacuate vent and a Gaggenau thirty inch full oven, while large-capacity Sub-Zero refrigerator and freezer drawers under the counter, a Kenmore trash compactor and a Kenmore Elite drink icemaker meet refrigeration and convenience needs. Forward of the galley a pantry room with a four-drawer cabinet and racks stores chef equipment, and also houses a large two-door wine cooler and a central vacuum system, providing both culinary functionality and practical serviceability throughout this well-appointed area.

## Master stateroom

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The full-beam master stateroom is a sanctuary of comfort and elegance, appointed with a king-size walk-around bed offering convenient under-bed storage and enhanced by a System #3 king mattress upgrade for superior rest. Wall-mounted sconce lamps above bedside nightstands create a refined bedside ambiance, while a forty inch Samsung flat panel HDTV provides in-cabin entertainment. Natural light pours in through hullside windows on both port and starboard, and upholstered lounge seating offers a private place to relax, making the master a luxurious retreat that balances style, comfort and practicality.

## Guest staterooms forward and port aft

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The guest staterooms forward and port aft are designed to combine comfort and practicality, each featuring a queen-size walk-around bed with convenient under-bed storage and orthopedic mattresses that promise supportive rest. Entertainment is provided by a nineteen inch LCD flat screen TV in each

stateroom, and the thoughtful layouts create welcoming, comfortable retreats for guests throughout their time on board.

## **Guest stateroom port forward and crew stateroom starboard**

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The port forward guest stateroom and the starboard crew stateroom prioritize functionality and comfort with upper and lower berths outfitted with orthopedic mattresses and ample storage beneath, designed for efficient organization. Each cabin includes a nineteen inch LCD TV for personal entertainment, and integrated stereo speakers in the soffit tied into the salon stereo system provide selectable audio with individual volume control for a tailored listening experience.

## **Master, guest and crew heads**

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The master, guest and crew heads are finished with mirror ceilings to amplify the sense of space, Gialitta granite vanity tops and custom Amtico flooring in American Ash with a Black Walnut border for cohesive luxury. Each head features a one-piece frameless shower door leading to a stall shower for a sleek, functional bathing experience, and in 2023 all toilets throughout the vessel were replaced with new models to ensure the latest in comfort and efficiency, reflecting the yacht's ongoing program of updates and refinement.

## **Day head**

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The day head is an expression of refined design, appointed with a Gialitta granite vanity top and a custom decorator hammer copper sink basin that serves as a striking focal point. Custom fixtures and faucet enhance the overall aesthetic, while the floor is finished in custom Amtico of American Ash with a

Black Walnut border to harmonize with the yacht's interior palette, creating a compact but decidedly upscale space for guests.

## Companionway

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The companionway is both stylish and practical, detailed with vertical teak strips between wall panels and warm overhead LED lighting that creates an inviting circulation route. A well-concealed laundry center behind a teak door houses a stackable washer and dryer, providing onboard convenience while preserving the corridor's sleek appearance and efficient flow.

## Decor

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The decor throughout the salon, master stateroom and dinette reflects premier edition finishes and meticulous attention to detail, featuring ultra-leather seating upgraded in Milkweed color, sofa armrests by the door and toe kicks in Papyrus at all sofas, with storage incorporated under every seating area. The upgraded enclosed bridge complements the interior, and the custom headliner installed in 2024 is accentuated by teak decor strips between panels and wood contoured valance panels in the salon, collectively crafting a cohesive, warm and sophisticated onboard environment.

## Enclosed flybridge

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The enclosed flybridge is a showcase of modern systems and comfort, centered on the MTU "Bridge Controls" System and a Moritz Safety Octoplex Touch Screen boat systems monitor with audible and visible alarms installed in August 2019 for comprehensive systems oversight. Companion bench seats flank the Stidd helm chair, while climate control with reverse cycle heat, temperature control and dehumidification ensures comfort in all conditions; a

teak cocktail table with inlay and fixed pedestal complements the raised L-shaped lounge that includes storage underneath and Sub-Zero refrigerator drawers for convenient provisioning. Entertainment is provided by a thirty-two inch Samsung LCD on a pop-up lift and a twelve volt stereo with speakers serving both the pilothouse and bridge afterdeck, and inside sun shades for the pilothouse windows add privacy. The aft docking station is a pod-style design with surface-mounted controls, a compass and engine start/stop switches, molded-in quartz lights illuminate the overhang, and the aft flybridge settee matches the lower mezzanine with storage beneath; a single radar mast and a six-rod rocket launcher on the aft bridge rail support both navigation and fishing, and a plush carpet sole installed in 2024 completes this exceptional command and entertainment space.

## Electronics and navigation

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The electronics and navigation suite is comprehensive and professionally integrated, featuring three nineteen inch KEP displays and two NavNet 3D control panels with a Black Box depth sounder and radar for precise situational awareness. A Furuno BBWX2 Live Satellite Weather System provides real-time weather updates, while Furuno MFD8 NavNet 3D displays at the tower and aft helm deliver critical data; the Simrad AP28 Autopilot Control Head with a second station in the tower added in 2019 provides reliable autopilot capability, supplemented by a Furuno RD30 digital depth and temperature display. Safety and monitoring include a cockpit aft-facing camera and an engine room camera, while communication is handled by two ICOM 604 VHF radios with remote microphones, a Newmar hailer horn and a Comrod AV51B1 four foot VHF antenna, with a Richie Powerdamp magnetic compass installed at all helm stations. Additional communication and monitoring features include an Icom HM162B VHF second station remote with intercom tower, an Icom OPC1541 six meter extension cable command mic

connected to the bridge radio tower, and the Furuno RD30 remote data display in the tower. Entertainment and connectivity are extended with a KVH TracVision Sat TV dome on the tower hardtop and a KVH Fleet One Tracphone System providing Inmarsat Fleet Broadband for data, with a recently installed AME mounted satellite phone and a Magellan Paradox Alarm Security System rounding out the suite to ensure every voyage is safe, connected and enjoyable.

## Cockpit

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The cockpit is a thoughtfully appointed blend of fishing functionality and leisure, finished throughout with teak decking on the deck, mezzanine and stairs and featuring an observation mezzanine with starboard aft-facing lounge seating that includes a hinged seat with storage beneath. Fishing amenities include a transom-mounted fish box plumbed as a livewell with a drain, a walk-through transom door with a lift gate and a transom coaming gate, six Rupp rod holders in the gunwales and a rod holder/leaning post combo added to the mezzanine in 2024. Refrigeration is handled by a recessed refrigerated chill box under the mezzanine step and individual digital thermostats for all mezzanine boxes, while transom swim steps provide easy water access. Practical systems include both fresh and seawater washdowns controlled by a Y-valve, indirect rope lighting under the coaming, a two-piece gyro hatch cover providing access to rudder mechanicals and a Seakeeper replaced in 2019 for stability and comfort underway, making the cockpit an efficient and elegant working and entertaining space.

## Tuna tower and fishing equipment

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The tuna tower and fishing equipment are built for serious angling, starting with a Palm Beach Towers center ladder seven-step gap tuna tower with

brushed pipe and a molded standing platform that includes a coupler box, washdown spigot and multiple molded quartz lights for visibility. The tower helm features recessed electronics pods, a centerline compass, round digital tachometers, trim tab switches, a thruster joystick and a hydraulics remote panel, all complemented by a custom stainless helm wheel and safety grab railing; a molded sunshade with a SAT TV dome, a full-width bench seat with backrest and belly band cushion, running lights and recessed tricolor lights round out the tower's creature comforts, and the tower is bonded for durability. Fishing tackle and spreader gear include forty-three foot Big Rig Rupp outriggers with triple spreaders and heavy aft bars, a Rupp center rigger, a teak Release Trillion Tuna Chair with a five-rod rocket launcher backrest/tray/backpad and a gooseneck offset with custom upholstery and cover, under-deck insulated two-door fishbox with crushed ice outlet, and under-gunwale electric reel plug outlets twelve volt, ensuring the yacht is outfitted for productive, comfortable and efficient sportfishing.

## Deck equipment

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Deck equipment is arranged for dependable operation and ease of use, centered on a Muir Atlantic 4000 hydraulic windlass with both gypsy and drum for reliable anchor handling, paired with a Fortress anchor on chain rode and a chain stopper for secure anchoring. The yacht features a bow pulpit and anodized aluminum bow rail for safety, a cockpit cover for protection, and a fiberglass step box with teak tops for practical deck storage. Fender storage is housed in the forward anchor locker to keep lines tidy, recessed covers on the transom protect trim tab pistons, and a water delivery kit with a tool set is included for maintenance needs, creating a deck outfitted for both convenience and longevity.

## Electrical systems

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The electrical systems are robustly engineered, anchored by two thirty-two kW Onan QD generators each showing 2,350 hours, shore power provided by two fifty amp cords on Glendinning Cablemaster winders plus an additional fifty amp inlet plug with cord, and power conditioning supplied by two Charles Industries IsoBoost isolation/boosting transformers alongside a Charles PM100 AC Power Management System. Charging is handled by a Mastervolt twenty-four volt, sixty amp engine battery charger and radial battery disconnect switches for safety and control, while overhead recessed LED lighting provides efficient illumination throughout. The vessel experienced a lightning strike in 2019, and a comprehensive marine electrical survey followed; any affected electrical systems and electronics were repaired or replaced as required to restore full operational integrity.

## Mechanical and engine room

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The mechanical and engine room reflects meticulous engineering and maintenance, offering six feet six inches of vertical headroom and housing two MTU 16V2000CR M93 engines each rated at two thousand four hundred horsepower with 3,250 hours, paired to ZF transmissions with electric trolling valves that were replaced in 2019. Fuel management includes twenty-four volt priming pumps and Racor fuel/water separator filters for both mains and the generator, while the chilled water A/C system comprises two four-ton chillers with reverse cycle heat and an inline backup chill water pump. Fresh water production is handled by an Aquamatic Sea Recovery watermaker rated at eighteen hundred gallons per day with auto-flush and a Spot Zero Reverse Osmosis Freshwater System conditioning two thousand gallons per day, and a Dometic Eskimo ice machine produces six hundred pounds of crushed ice per day with remote control panels at the helm and engine room entrance.

Steering is via the VIPER Viking Independent Proportional Electro Hydraulic Rudder Steering System with a flybridge readout panel, ventilation by Delta T Engine Room Ventilation System and demisters, and the room includes a hydraulic thruster and davit powerback, built-in white Craftsman tool boxes, three trim tabs, dripless shaft logs, underwater gas/water separators for the mufflers, and a Seakeeper Gyro Stabilizer replaced at the Viking Service Center in 2019; hydraulic emergency crash pump inlets are provided in four compartments. All toilets in the heads were replaced in 2022, and the combined systems deliver dependable performance and peace of mind for extended passages and demanding operations.

## Exclusions

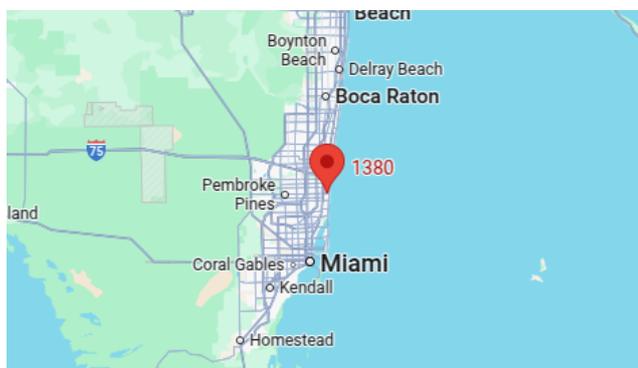
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
