DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Salon

Portside, an inviting L-shaped settee creates an intimate lounge for conversation and relaxation with generous seating, while opposite, sleek black granite countertops conceal abundant storage and frame a Samsung TV for effortless infotainment. Forward in the salon, adjacent to the galley, a spacious wet bar becomes the social heart of the main deck, where three bar stools tuck neatly beneath a polished slab of black granite. Within the bar, premium appliances elevate every gathering, including a U-Line ice maker, a Kohler sink with neatly organized storage for drinkware and napkins, and a U-Line refrigerator to keep refreshments perfectly chilled.

Salon/galley

Seamlessly integrated for elegant everyday living, the salon/galley is equipped to an exceptional standard: an electric head by Galley Maid DHE 24 runs on 24 VDC power for dependable service, while cold storage is anchored by a Sub Zero 700BF refrigerator on 120 VAC. Entertaining is effortless with a U Line BI 95B ice maker on 120/240 VAC and a compact U Line 15 wine cooler on 120 VAC. Culinary ambitions are served by a Thermador RES30QB oven on 120 VAC paired with a Sharp R1850 microwave, and clean up is swift with a Frigidaire MDR251RBR dishwasher. For extended cruising convenience, a Maytag LSE7806ACE washer/dryer and a Broan 1050 trash compactor complete this remarkably capable space.

Galley

The galley is crafted for serious cooking and effortless hosting, centered

around a Jenn Air Trisenor dual fold refrigerator with freezer and complemented by a Broan compactor and a GE dishwasher that keep the workspace pristine. A Thermador oven with convection pairs with an electric cooktop, while a Sharp Carousel microwave/convection adds speed and versatility. The black granite countertop sets a dramatic tone, anchored by a Kohler sink, and abundant overhead lockers wrap the space with exceptional storage. Starboard-side windows bathe the area in natural light, and an aft glassware showcase transforms everyday service into a touch of theater.

Owner's stateroom ensuite

The owner's haven blends technology and tranquility with integrated Garmin and Simrad repeaters discreetly positioned for at a glance awareness, while a queen berth anchors the suite. Port and starboard owner's closets offer generous hanging space, and midships to starboard a bank of drawers provides impressive additional stowage. The portside master head features twin sinks and a single Delta Marine head, complemented by a Grohe shower with a detachable spray. A refined makeup station framed by vertical light fixtures and surrounding mirrors elevates daily rituals, and port and starboard portholes invite fresh air and light for a soothing cross breeze. Entertainment is at hand with a 22" Samsung TV, and a spacious portside closet with dual fold doors sits just aft of a cabinet housing a stacked Maytag washer and dryer, model LSE7086ACE.

Vip stateroom ensuite

The VIP welcomes guests with a queen berth and comfortable walk around access on both port and starboard, framed by portholes that usher in sea air and natural light. A portside LG TV with an RCH DVD player faces forward, while port and starboard cabinets are paired with three sliding drawers

beneath each, augmented by under berth drawers to deliver exceptional storage. The private head includes a Delta Marine head, a Kohler sink, and a Grohe shower with a detachable shower head, with a portside porthole above and a beautifully illuminated set of mirrors forward to complete this refined retreat.

Midship guest stateroom

Amidships, flexible guest accommodations adapt to family and friends. To port, opposing single bunks are arranged for conversation and comfort, with a bedside table serving the lower berth and dedicated reading lights for both upper and lower bunks; forward storage keeps essentials neatly stowed. To starboard, a clever bunk cum office mirrors the port concept but runs the berths horizontally to the vessel, unlocking space aft for a proper desk and study area. Ample storage below the bunks and along the starboard bulkheads, together with a twin door closet, ensures every item has its place.

Pilothouse

Command with confidence from a comprehensively outfitted pilothouse featuring four Garmin screens, a Simrad Robertson AP20 autopilot, FLIR camera, and a Furuno GP 32, all working in concert with Wesmar electronic gyro stabilizers. A Maxwell windlass chain counter, Horizon and ICOM VHF radios, and precise MicroCommander controls pair with powerful bow and stern thrusters for effortless close quarters handling. Vigilance comes standard with CCTV by Elbex EXM94, a ship's alarm and check panel, a Headhunter WTS 1500 check panel, and a clearly marked Garmin AIS on/off switch. Safety and efficiency are further enhanced by a Fireboy fire suppression system switch, FloScan fuel monitoring, forward and aft hailers, and a dedicated engine room fan system. Twin Stidd helm chairs

complete this professional grade helm with enduring comfort.

Main level dining

The main level dining area invites lingering meals and easy conversation, with a welcoming U shaped settee set against lustrous black granite that ties the space to the adjoining galley. To starboard, a U Line wine cooler keeps vintages at the ready, while clever under table storage preserves the open, country style flow that makes this deck feel bright, casual, and beautifully connected.

Foredeck

Forward, the foredeck is a destination in its own right, anchored by a Maxwell 3500 windlass with deck mounted controls and supported by dedicated storage for fenders and lines to port and starboard. Washdowns are thoughtfully arranged with both seawater and freshwater at the portside deck hatch, while a foredeck sun pad and telescoping table transform the bow into a private alfresco lounge. Port and starboard wing lockers swallow shore cords and favorite water toys, with a portside windshield hose locker and a starboard 50 Amp shore cord reel for tidy, ready to go utility. Underfoot, non skid surfaces on the main deck ensure secure footing in all conditions.

Aft deck

The aft deck is tailored for entertaining and practical utility, with two large cabinets ready for storage bins and folding lockers to port and starboard that keep gear orderly and out of sight. An ice maker doubles as a bait tank when the mood shifts to fishing, while a propane TAC BBQ with a deep storage drawer beneath stands primed for sunset grilling. A Kohler sink with storage

below streamlines prep and cleanup, and a starboard stern station with bow and stern thrusters and Commander throttle controls makes docking a polished, one person affair.

Swim platform

At water's edge, the swim platform is expedition ready with a dedicated propane cabinet holding two 5 gallon tanks, a 50 Amp shore cord reel for seamless connections, and a freshwater shower with hot and cold mixing for a rinse after a swim. Water maker canisters and a freshwater flush system are neatly installed, underscoring the yacht's self sufficiency on extended passages.

Flybridge

The flybridge brings panoramic freedom with twin Garmin screens and a Simrad autopilot at your fingertips, plus Wesmar stabilizer controls and bow and stern thrusters for smooth, assured handling in any breeze. Sociable seating to port and starboard with their own tables encourages long, sunlit lunches, while the boat deck carries tender storage for both a 14' and a 10' tender, launched with ease by the davit. A starboard sink supports casual service, partial Bimini coverage tempers the midday sun, and twin helm chairs provide supportive comfort underway.

Electrical equipment

Designed for quiet autonomy, the electrical system features two Northern Lights gensets with approximately 2,300 hours and 1,500 hours respectively, backed by inverters and a robust shore cord capability. Charging is comprehensive with both a 24v battery charger and a 12v battery charger,

while visibility and security underway are enhanced by a pan tilt zoom video camera and a fully integrated telephone system. Hot water is abundant thanks to two water heaters, port and starboard, and long range independence is secured by an HRO water maker system.

Mechanical equipment

Mechanically confident and expedition ready, the yacht is equipped with a powerful davit, bow and stern thrusters for fingertip maneuvering, a robust windlass for reliable anchoring, precise steering gear, and stabilizers that keep passages composed and comfortable.

Tender

A 14' Rendova tender, registration WN2428NI, rides securely on the boat deck, ready to whisk guests ashore or explore secluded coves at a moment's notice.

Upgrades

Recent upgrades elevate performance and confidence, including a completely redone Garmin electronics suite paired with updated VHF communications, fully serviced MAN engines for turnkey reliability, and new zincs to protect running gear and underwater metals for seasons to come.


