OVERVIEW

The 78'7" (23.95m) FRADI, built by Dominator, is a family friendly 780S flybridge motor yacht that pairs sporty lines with luxurious comfort. Delivered with a ZAR ZF 3 tender and a spacious flybridge, she is capable of exhilarating top speeds of 30 knots while retaining the refinement expected by a discerning owner in search of a versatile sports cruiser.

Designed to welcome eight guests across four ensuite cabins, including a full beam master suite, and to accommodate two crew in separate quarters, FRADI is a lightweight, high performance flybridge yacht crafted for relaxed days aboard and extended weekend escapes. As a true planing hull motor yacht, she rewards her helmsman with engaging handling and assured pace. For passages between anchorages she cruises comfortably at 22 knots, and her generous deck arrangement invites leisure: forward sunpads for lounging, an aft cockpit arranged for alfresco dining, and a well appointed flybridge offering extra seating, sunbathing and dining areas plus a secondary helm. Inside, a contemporary palette and expansive glazing create a bright, airy interior, while a commodious main salon provides an elegant setting for entertaining or unwinding with family after a lively day at sea.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Specifications

With accommodation for eight guests in four cabins, this yacht marries inviting comfort with a robust, performance focused specification, offering generous range, modern systems and meticulous service history that together deliver confidence at sea. Propulsion is provided by twin MAN V12 diesel engines rated at 1550 hp each, with approximately 1200 hours recorded, driving a maximum speed of 30 knots and a relaxed cruising speed of twenty two to twenty four knots at about 380 litres per hour, transmitted through two ZF 2150 V gearboxes to a pair of five blade Rolla propellers for efficient thrust and sea keeping. Steering confidence is engineered with a BCS hydraulic pilot backed by manual controls, augmented by a hydraulic autopilot system and comprehensive manual overrides. Electrical self sufficiency is achieved with two main generators — a 17.5 kW Onan and a 16 kW Vetus — showing 483 hours on the port unit and 2100 hours on the starboard unit, while a Vetus UPS frequency converter smooths power quality and two 220 V single phase shore cables provide shore connectivity. Charging and house power management rely on three Mastervolt Mass 24/75 chargers feeding a bank of twelve service batteries, with additional new batteries dedicated to the engines, thrusters and generators to ensure reliable starts and redundancy. The control and handling suite comprises twin rudders and an electric two speed 2 kW bow thruster refitted in 2023, and freshwater independence is assured by a high pressure watermaker with three membranes producing 180 litres per hour supported by a 50 litre water boiler. Climate and ventilation were comprehensively refreshed in 2023 with Connaria SN 7664 air conditioning fitted with two compressors, two engine room blowers replaced and a Bosch galley extractor, while fuel hygiene is maintained by two

fuel separators per engine and two double Racor filters per engine. Tankage is generous with 6100 litres of fuel, 1500 litres of fresh water, 580 litres of grey water and 300 litres of black water, underpinning extended cruising autonomy. Safety and security are exhaustive, including a fire alarm intercom system, safes in the master stateroom and saloon, CCTV coverage of the engine room and flybridge with 360° awareness and a complete fire fighting fit with smoke detectors, pumps and extinguishers plus dedicated alarms throughout. Communications and navigation are fully modern: Raymarine Ray 90 Blackbox VHF with wireless station and a wireless waterproof handheld VHF, cabin telephony and ship wide intercom stations on the flybridge, wheelhouse, engine room and anchor station, onboard Wi-Fi and LAN, and a complete Raymarine navigation suite installed new in 2023 — Magnum radar, echosounder, GPS, wind instruments, Raymarine Axiom XL nineteen inch plotters (two in the wheelhouse and one on the flybridge), Evolution Solenoid EV 300 autopilot and Raymarine magnetic compass, all controllable from the interior wheelhouse and flying bridge stations. Deck equipment is turnkey and recently refreshed, including a Besenzoni hydraulic passerelle refitted in 2023, a swimming platform refitted in 2023, forward electric control searchlight and comprehensive sun protection with a hydraulic flybridge bimini, front sundeck bimini and cockpit covers renewed in 2022, while boarding flexibility comes from an adjustable inox-teak side ladder with railing and a matching ladder extension for the passerelle. Entertainment and domestic systems are specified for easy living and guest pleasure, with saloon TV, satellite reception, Bose surround and Apple TV, Fusion radio on the sundeck and flybridge integrated with Raymarine (installed 2023), a galley appointed with a Bosch electric range and a Miele H 6860 stainless steel oven (seventy six litres, 3700 W), comprehensive refrigeration including 24 V/220 V twin compressors, a dedicated wine fridge, a 24 V/220 V refrigerator with freezer and two portable Dometic freezers (12 V/24 V/220 V), flybridge electric range with grill and icemaker, and a Whirlpool washing machine from 2022. Practical extras

include a well appointed office with a PC in the master stateroom plus printer and fax, underwater lights for evening ambiance, a ZAR ZF 3 tender from 2020 with only fifty six hours, a Sportsstuff Big Mable float and a complete diving set with compressed air. A clear refit history underlines meticulous care: a full flybridge refit in 2019, and in 2023 propellers balanced with shaft bearings and seals renewed, thrusters refitted, all new service, engine and thruster batteries installed, the passerelle and hydraulic platform refitted, the entire navigation suite renewed and a new generator installed, ensuring the yacht is both turnkey and thoroughly maintained.

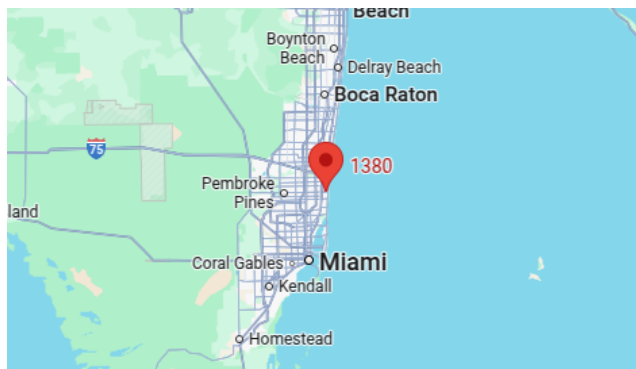
