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OVERVIEW

Crafted by the renowned French yard JFA Yachts and penned by Marc Lombard, 4 EVER is a 23.7m Long Island 78 power catamaran conceived for luxurious, long-distance cruising. She combines the expansive volume and calm motion of a multihull with efficient performance and genuine transatlantic range, answering the needs of owners who wish to pursue extended passages without sacrificing comfort, refinement or seakeeping. Her structure uses aluminium hulls paired with composite decks and superstructure, a lightweight yet robust combination that delivers exceptional strength, steadiness and offshore manners. Propelled by twin 500 hp Cummins diesel engines, 4 EVER settles into a tranquil 10-knot cruise and can reach a maximum of 18 knots. The economical hull form, generous fuel capacity and thoughtfully appointed systems aboard provide a capable platform for voyaging to remote destinations and undertaking long crossings. The main deck is arranged to favour sociable, light-filled living with a spacious saloon, an elegant dining area, a fully equipped galley and a dedicated navigation station. Franck Darnet's interior palette of pale oak tempered by deeper finishes creates a warm, contemporary ambience; large windows bathe the interior in natural light while the yacht's broad beam yields living volumes uncommon in a vessel of this length.

Accommodation is arranged for eight guests across four well-proportioned cabins, including a full-beam owner's suite and three additional guest staterooms designed for restful privacy. Outdoor life is equally generous, with a wide aft cockpit ideal for alfresco dining, an expansive flybridge complete with an enclosed wheelhouse and a forward lounge that is crowned by a seawater jacuzzi. A lifting platform handles a tender up to 4.6 metres and doubles as a convenient launch and swim platform.

Built to rigorous standards of safety, finish and operational reliability, 4 EVER

stands as a French-built luxury motor catamaran offering remarkable interior volume and true bluewater capability, presenting an exceptional proposition for those seeking adventurous, long-range ownership.

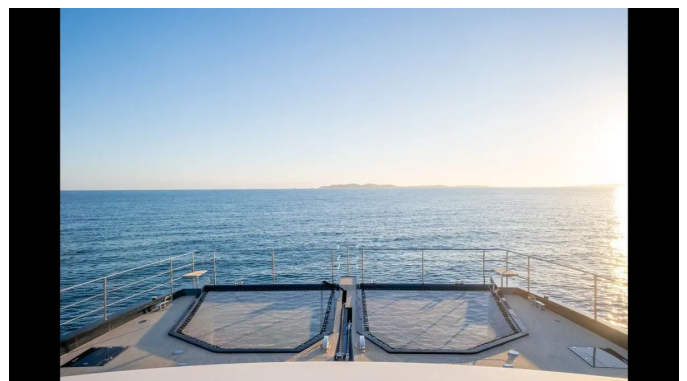
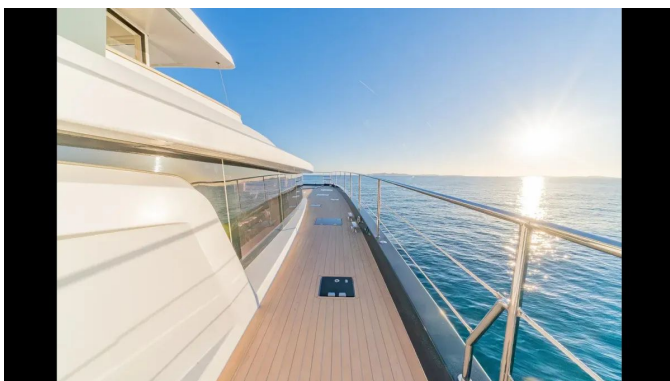
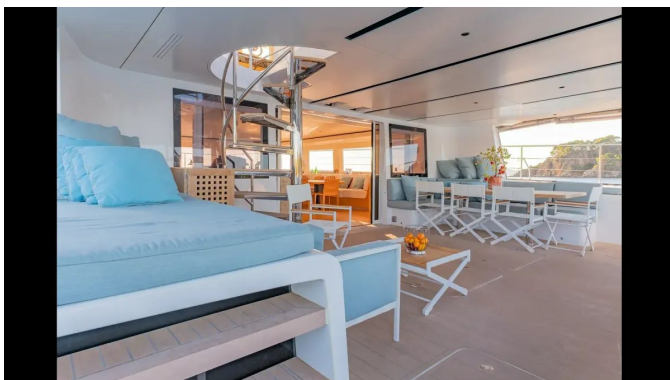




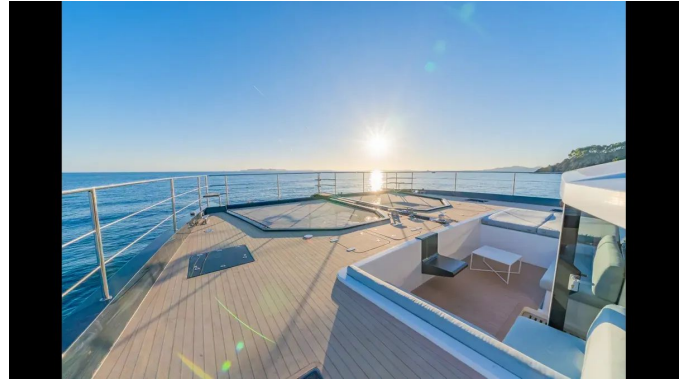


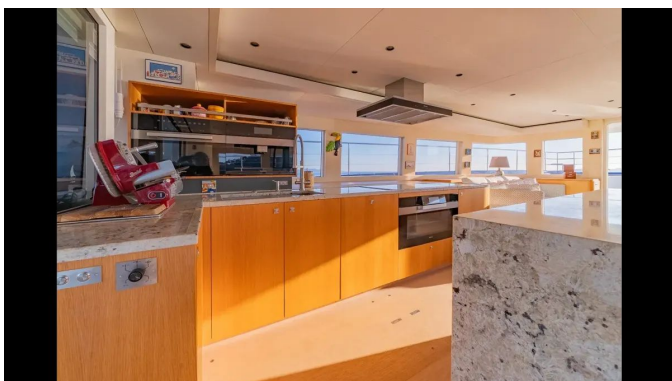


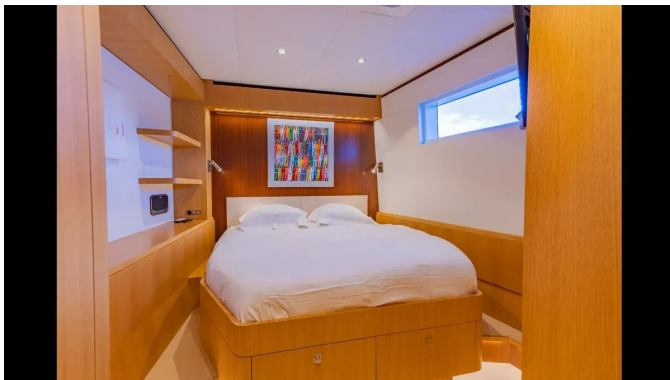
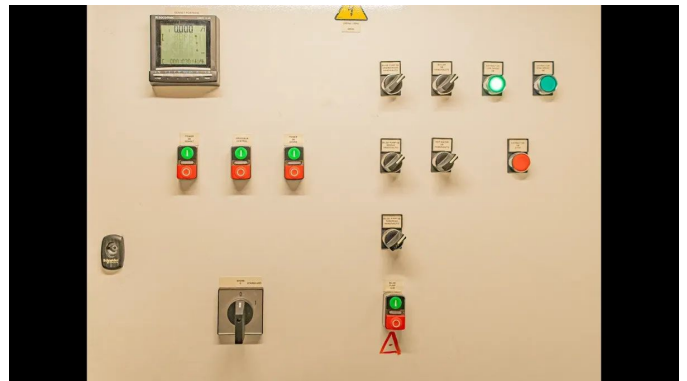


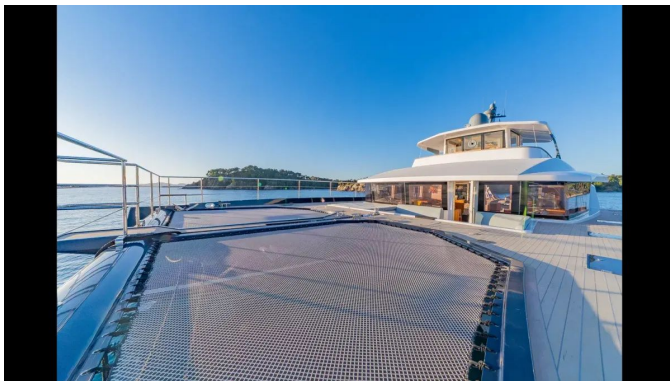


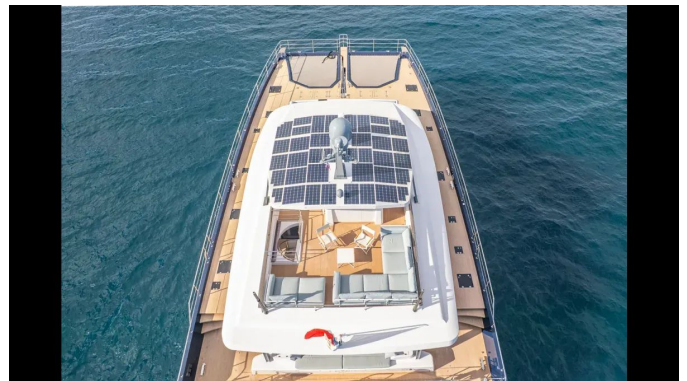
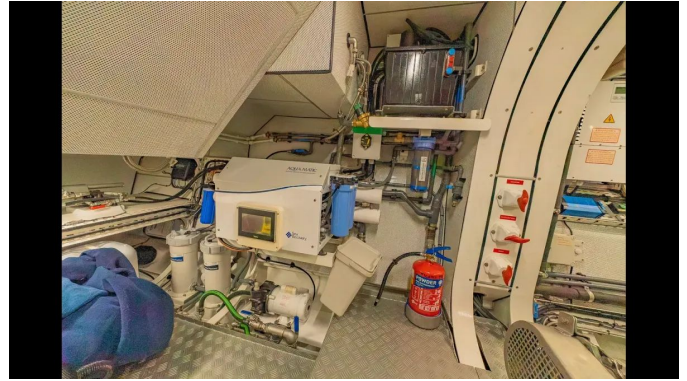








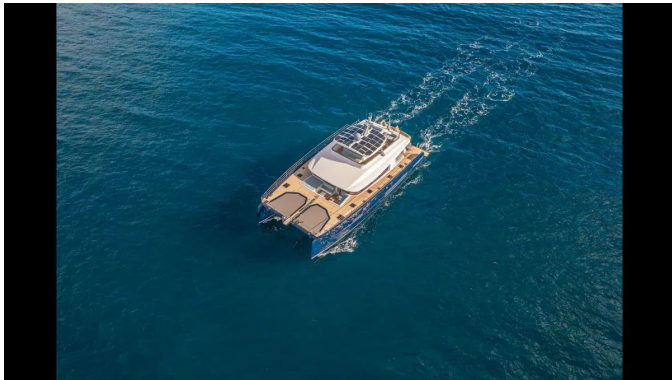












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Equipment

Outfitted to instill confidence on offshore passages, this yacht boasts a comprehensive B&G electronics suite anchored by AIS and GPS, featuring radar with radar detector, an advanced plotter and navigation center driven by an onboard computer, a log speedometer, depthsounder and wind sensors for both speed and direction, with repeaters strategically positioned so essential data is available throughout the vessel. Command is effortless thanks to an intuitive autopilot, a responsive bow thruster and dependable VHF communications, while global connectivity is assured through VSAT and Iridium systems alongside onboard Wi-Fi. Entertainment is thoughtfully integrated: radio, CD player, DVD player and VCR feed the cockpit speakers and interior audio, with a central TV complemented by flat screen televisions in every cabin. Long range comfort is enhanced by a 285 L/h watermaker, and the traditional compass remains at the helm as a timeless navigational reference.

Inside equipment

Every onboard system has been selected to make cruising effortless and luxurious: climate control is comprehensive, with air conditioning, continuous hot water and Aire Pulsée (GO) forced-air heating, while an onboard air compressor, a bow thruster and a dependable battery charger provide enhanced maneuverability and peace of mind. The galley is fully appointed for refined living at sea, equipped with a microwave oven, an oven, a refrigerator, a deep freezer and a dishwasher, and is complemented by a dedicated wine cellar to preserve vintages under optimal conditions. Fresh-water autonomy is secured by two water makers rated at 280 L/h with 230 h, and safety and

reliability are reinforced by both electric and manual bilge pumps alongside a sea water pump. Everyday convenience is assured with an electric head and a washing machine, and a thoughtfully arranged office space allows work to continue in comfort while underway.

Outside equipment

On deck, sumptuous cockpit cushions encircle a versatile table while a convenient cockpit shower is ready for rinses after a swim. A hydraulic bathing platform, paired with a hydraulic swim step, enlarges the sea-level leisure area and boarding is made effortless by the hydraulic gangway. Launching and handling are assisted by a hydraulic winch, a swimming ladder encourages spontaneous dips, and a liferaft provides essential safety cover. The cockpit and sidedecks are finished in flexiteak, offering warmth and secure footing underfoot, with protective covers including a bimini top for shaded comfort. A dedicated surf system enhances watersports enjoyment and power independence is supported by a 3700-watt solar array. Outboard engine brackets are fitted and the tender is a five meter SEMIRIGISE equipped with a 100 HP Yamaha, while a Jacuzzi completes the exterior amenities for serene relaxation after an active day on the water.

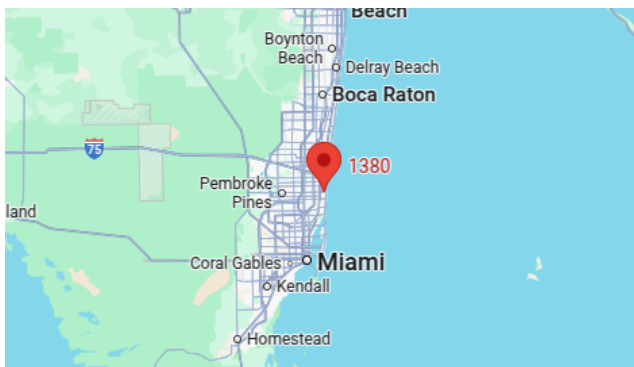
