This 2019 Ferretti 780 Flybridge is a refined motor yacht that marries contemporary Italian styling with generous interior volume and an emphasis on alfresco living. The yacht's provenance is particularly distinguished: she was previously owned by Tom Hanks, a pedigree that sets her apart from other Ferretti 780s on the market. Her aft layout showcases an innovative convertible stern featuring a hydraulically operated swim platform system; once the tender or water toys are launched, the aft terrace seamlessly converts into an inviting beach club, creating an intimate connection with the sea and providing effortless swimmer access. Accommodating professional staff, she includes self-contained crew quarters for two with dedicated sleeping accommodation, laundry facilities, appliances and preparation areas so the crew can operate independently while preserving privacy for owners and guests. A striking and immaculately realized example of the Ferretti 780, she delivers an elegant fusion of pedigree, lifestyle and practical versatility.

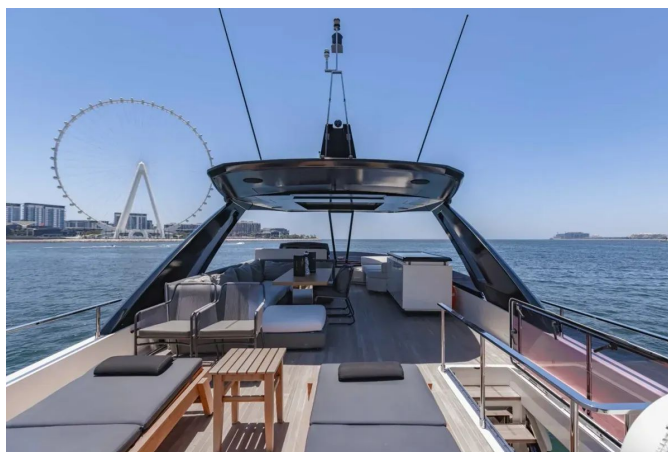
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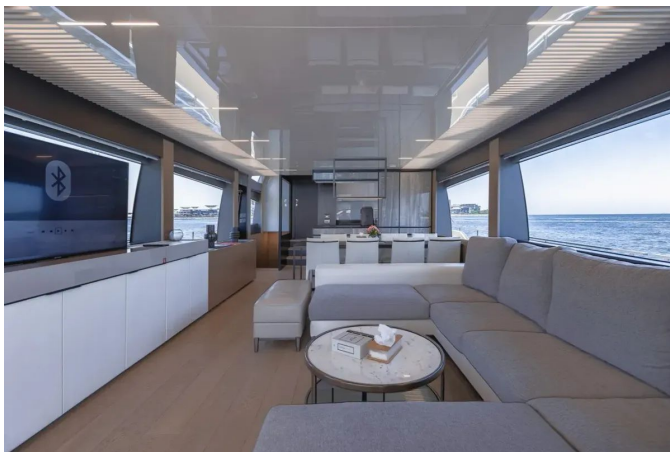
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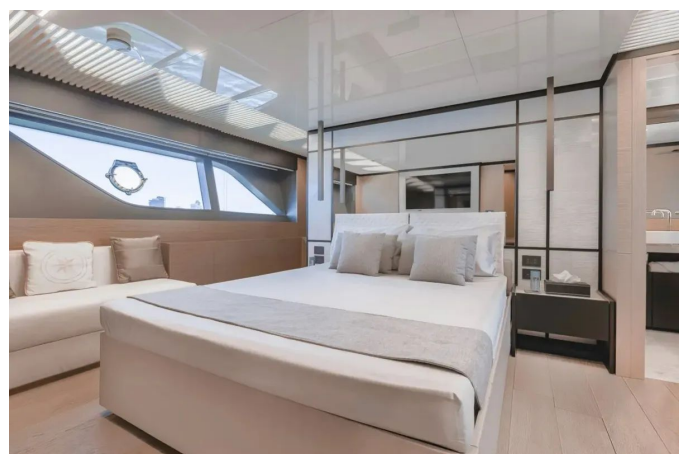
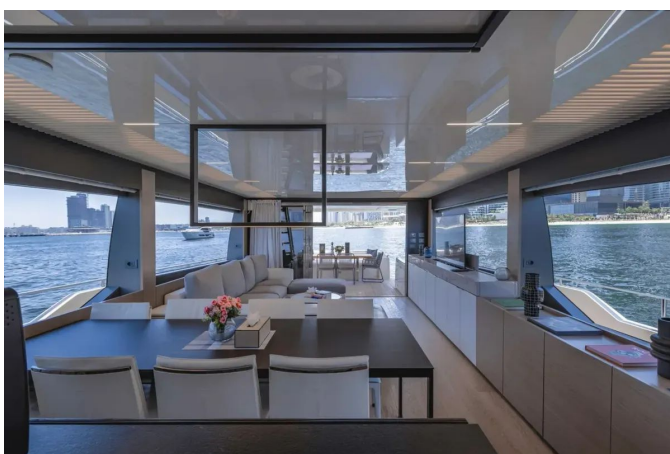
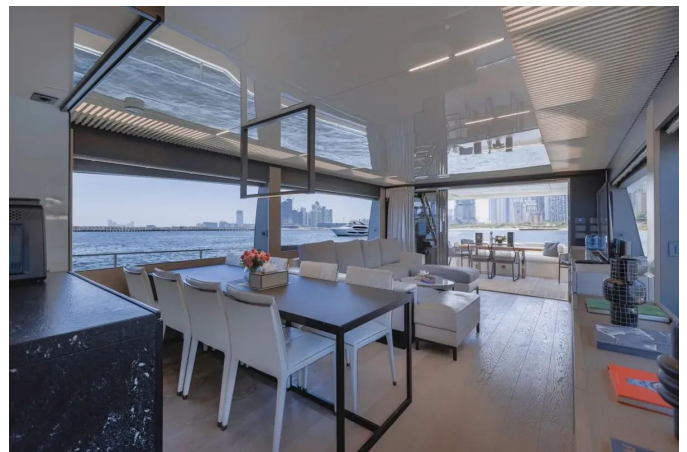
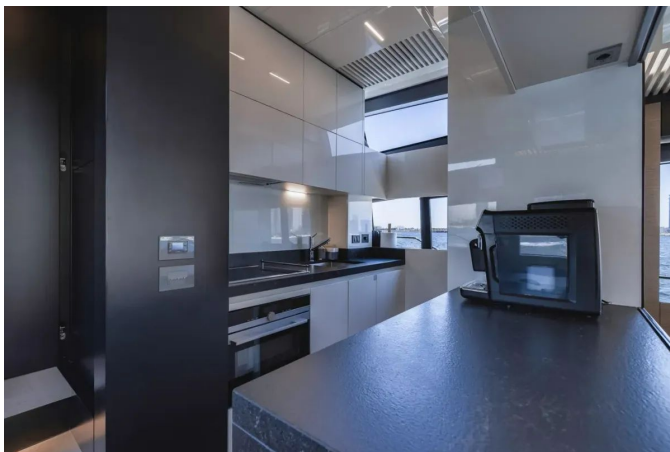


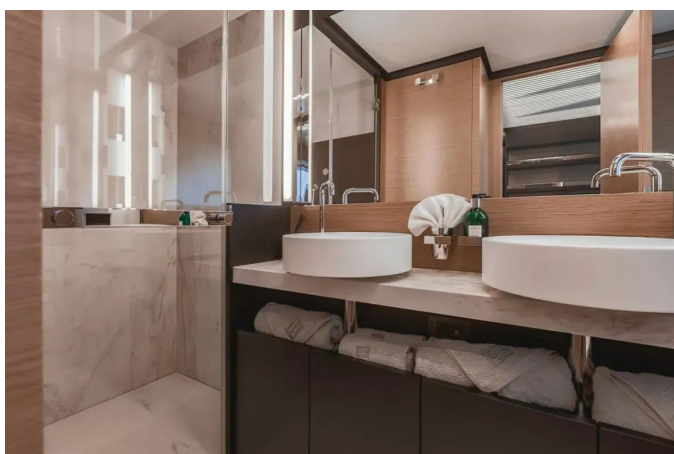
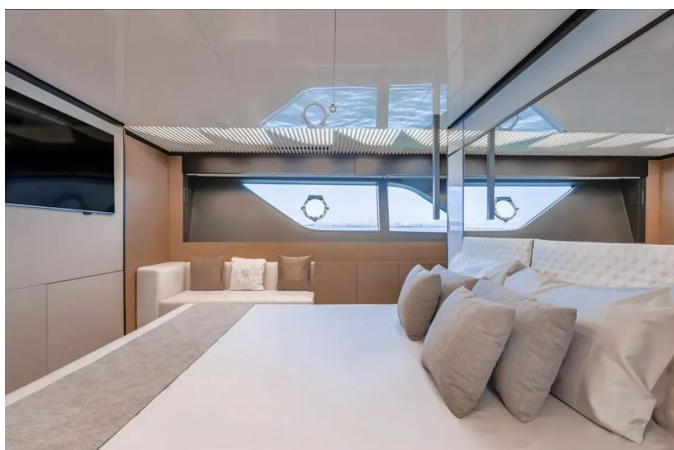


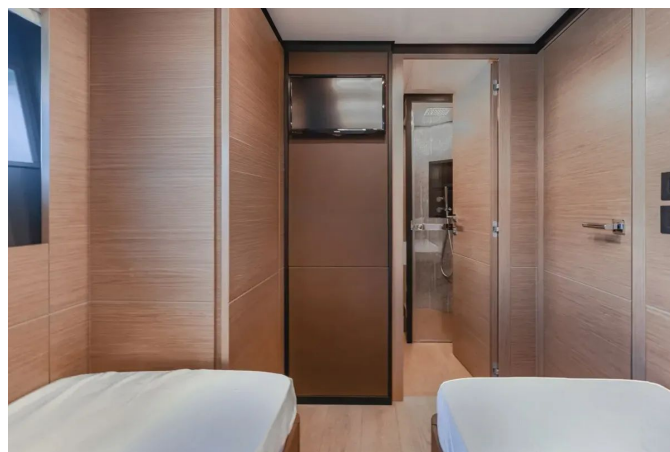
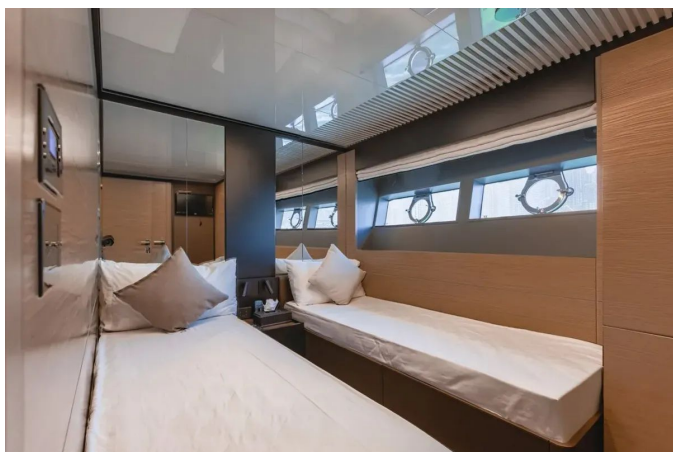
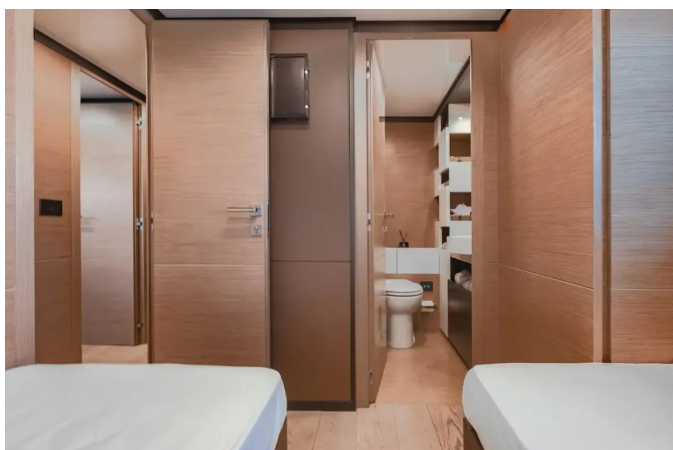












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Boat highlights

A 2019 Ferretti 780, this unique example of the celebrated 78 foot motor yacht merges modern Italian design language with expansive interior volume and thoughtfully arranged exterior living areas. Measuring approximately 78 ft / 24 m, the yacht is presented in a three cabin guest layout that artfully balances refined comfort, practical functionality and inviting al fresco spaces. Beyond Ferretti's well-known pedigree, this particular hull carries an unusual provenance—previously owned by Tom Hanks—which adds a distinctive story and enhanced appeal on the brokerage market.

One of the yacht's most striking lifestyle innovations is the transforming stern and beach zone. While underway the aft section functions as secure storage for the tender and water toys; when deployed, the same area converts into an intimate waterside lounge with immediate access to the sea. The hydraulic swim platform can be set at or close to water level, simplifying guest entry and exit, easing tender and toy launching and recovery, and creating an additional social hub at anchor. This capacity to shift from a pragmatic aft garage into a true waterfront living space is a signature feature of the Ferretti 780.

Equally notable are the genuine crew quarters designed for two. More than merely sleeping berths, the crew area is self contained with dedicated cabins, laundry and washing facilities, and a compact galley equipped for independent meal preparation, ensuring professional operation without frequent intrusion into owner and guest spaces. The separation between crew and guest domains preserves privacy and supports discreet service for owners who wish to run the yacht with a professional team.

Taken together, this 2019 Ferretti 780 pairs the refinement and seaworthy performance expected from Ferretti with attributes that make this particular

boat especially compelling on the market. Its famous provenance, efficient three cabin arrangement, remarkable transforming stern and beach area, and truly functional accommodation for two crew reflect a considered approach to life aboard, where the hydraulic aft platform provides an unparalleled connection to the water and separated crew facilities allow guests to relax with enhanced comfort and privacy.

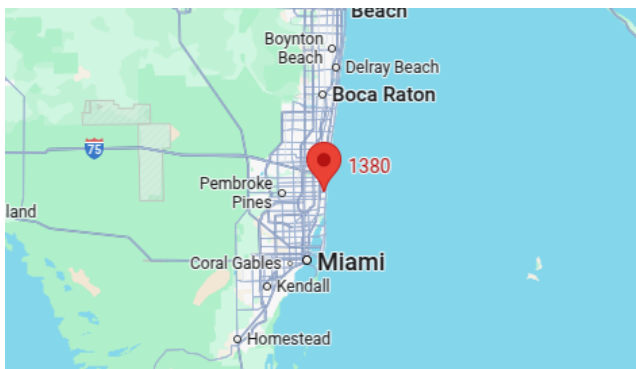
