OVERVIEW

A study in contemporary Italian refinement, this 2020 Azimut 78 Flybridge marries sculptural exterior lines with assured seafaring ability to create an indulgent marine sanctuary. Pierluigi Ausonio's hull styling and Achille Salvagni's interior vision combine crisp architectural geometry with softer, organic detailing and a carefully selected array of tactile finishes that read as both modern and enduring. Broad sheets of glass illuminate the salon with daylight, accentuating an open, sociable plan that moves naturally from an inviting lounge to an elegant dining area and a well-equipped galley—an ideal arrangement for entertaining or savoring quiet sunsets.

Measuring 78 feet overall with an 18-foot beam, her presence is immediately generous, yet the onboard atmosphere retains a boutique, residential poise. Accommodation for eight guests is arranged in four tranquil staterooms, anchored by a full-beam owner's suite that speaks to understated luxury, plus three further guest cabins and four tasteful heads. Spaces are arranged to afford privacy when desired, while dedicated crew quarters—configured as three cabins for up to four crew—ensure discreet, professional service on every cruise.

The yacht's outdoor areas are the essence of leisure. A capacious flybridge invites long, leisurely days al fresco with ample lounging, open-air dining and unobstructed sightlines to the horizon. The aft cockpit thoughtfully extends the main deck's living space, and the foredeck provides an intimate spot for sunning or an evening aperitif beneath the sky. From morning swims to twilight celebrations, each exterior setting is composed to make time aboard feel effortlessly exceptional.

Beneath her lines, a semi-displacement hull provides a composed and confident ride. Propulsion comes from triple Volvo Penta inboard diesels, delivering a comfortable 22-knot cruise and a 28-knot top speed that blend

lively performance with refined handling. Fuel capacity of 1,150 gallons and 316 gallons of fresh water give flexibility for weekend escapes or extended coastal passages, offering range, dependability and attention to detail.

Built in GRP/fiberglass to Azimut's exacting standards and finished with meticulous craftsmanship, this Flybridge is as arresting at the dock as she is underway. Located in the United States and ready to impress, she invites elegant travel, effortless entertaining and the simple pleasure of savoring every mile.































DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Main

“Transcendence” is a magnificent 2020 Azimut FLY 78 that has known the care of a single discerning owner who maintained an open check policy and kept a full time professional crew, ensuring she remains fully current on all maintenance and services. With very low hours, this luxurious, high performance yacht delivers an exceptional cruising experience, blending timeless Italian beauty with innovative design from the pioneers at Azimut. Stretching seventy eight feet, her flybridge layout feels open and airy, with a spacious salon, a fully equipped galley, and four lavish staterooms, highlighted by a stunning full beam master suite. Triple Volvo IPS 1350 engines provide impressive speed, efficiency, and unparalleled maneuverability, enabling swift, smooth passages with excellent fuel economy, while the latest navigation and stabilization technologies ensure a remarkably comfortable, steady ride even when seas are up. The flybridge is purpose built for outdoor living, complete with a wet bar, generous seating and sun loungers, while the aft swim platform offers effortless access to the water for endless watersports enjoyment. With impeccable Italian craftsmanship, elegant interiors, and cutting edge features, the Azimut FLY 78 stands as the very embodiment of luxury and exclusivity on the water. All yearly maintenance was completed in the second week of December 2025.

General upgrades

Every detail of “Transcendence” has been thoughtfully elevated with purposeful enhancements that marry practicality with refinement. Utility and infrastructure improvements include an integrated black water tank washing system and a grey water tank washing system, additional conduits throughout

the vessel, a watertight hand control for the anchor winch, a cockpit docking station, a bow thruster rated at 11.4 kW, maneuvering lights on the bow, a flybridge hatch, a flagpole, a painted boot stripe, painted flybridge furniture, a flybridge hard top, and a telescopic gangway. Performance and seakeeping are bolstered by the Seakeeper Stabilizer 26 and the powerful propulsion package of three Volvo IPS 1350 engines delivering 1000 HP each, further protected by a Premier Extended transferable warranty dated 2026. Comfort on deck flourishes with a cockpit awning, an electric awning for the aft flybridge, dimmer controlled lights on the fly, spreader lights on the aft fly, luxury exterior lighting, a bow sunshade with removable carbon fiber poles covering both sun and seating areas, a bow table with a Corian frame and a synthetic marble insert, and lounge furniture on the aft fly featuring two love seats in butylene fabric complemented by two coffee tables. The flybridge itself has teak decking, a bar finished with a synthetic marble insert on the lower section of the bar furniture top, two exterior teak stools at the flybridge bar, an integrated BBQ within the flybridge furniture, an ice maker on the fly, upgraded standard exterior cushions in butylene fabric and upgraded standard exterior teak tables with Corian frames and synthetic tops. Entertaining and A/V are elevated by a comprehensive Audio/Video Package, flybridge furniture housing a forty three inch TV on a lift with decoders and antenna, Garmin video cameras, a Garmin AIS 800, a Raymarine FLIR M364 C thermal camera, and the Volvo Glass Platinum Package. Galley and hospitality are refined with Miele appliances, a wine cooler in the galley, a dishwasher, a refrigerator and ice maker for the cockpit furniture, an additional ice maker on the fly, and a watermaker suite that includes a general watermaker plus a Legend 1500 GPD system operating at 230Vac, one phase, 60 Hz, with a 4.3" remote control. Underwater lights have been added under the sponsons two by two and three beneath the transom, while an electric searchlight has been upgraded to ACR. Storage and serviceability are increased with an additional storage cabinet in the VIP cabin designed by Achille Salvagni, a dividing wall

with a door in the crew cabin, and washer and dryer units in the crew cabin. Safety and convenience extend with mosquito nets for the portholes and safes located in both the master cabin and the crew cabin. Interior ambiance and finish are curated with a decor upgrade, a domotic lighting system in the salon, scenic interior lights, lacquered bronze color inserts on the forward salon bulkhead, a wooden floor on the main deck, a Gentash cement floor for the galley and main helm, heads floors in Gentash cement 26, a master head shower wall in marble, a Carpet Besana Royal 43 on the lower deck, and forward salon lounge seating. Privacy and shading are perfected with electric Roman blinds with an integrated blackout system in the salon, Roman blinds in the master cabin, Roman blinds with integrated blackout in the VIP and guest cabins, and a dedicated blackout system for the master cabin curtains. Layout refinements include a dresser in the master cabin paired with a settee complementing the standard port side sofa, a co-pilot seat at the main helm, a co-pilot seat on the fly, a flybridge hatch for ventilation and access, and a cockpit chair model Oskar. Finally, linens and comfort packages complete the offering with a full set of linens for the cabins, a set of linens for the crew cabin, a set of linens for the third bed in the crew cabin, the third bed in the crew cabin itself, and a Set PF Towels, while the Yacht Pro Essential Yp 100 upgraded dive compressor system empowers you to fill your dive tanks onboard for truly endless underwater adventures.

A comprehensive round of care has just been completed to keep "Transcendence" turnkey and cruising ready, including fresh bottom paint, a full engine service, generator service, air conditioning service, watermaker maintenance, stabilizer service, fire system recertification, life raft re inspection, and a complete battery refresh that replaced house, generator, and thruster batteries, along with new engine batteries, all executed with precision and attention to detail.

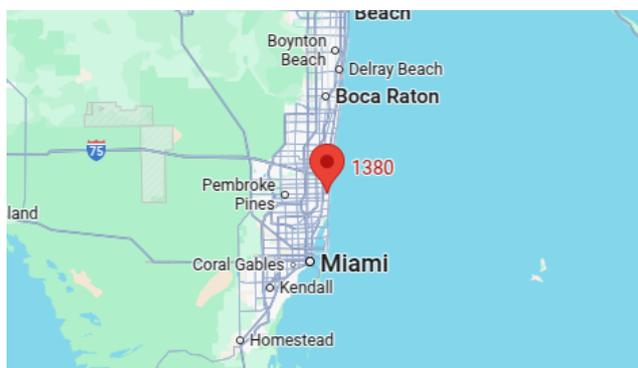
