OVERVIEW

Built in 2010 and currently lying in Turkey, this 79-foot luxury motor yacht combines graceful lines with the practical resilience of GRP construction. With an 18-foot beam and an approximately 5.6-foot draft, she slips confidently from polished marinas into hidden Mediterranean coves, offering access where deeper-keeled vessels cannot. Her fiberglass/GRP hull and decks are crafted to marry structural integrity with low-maintenance refinement, presenting sleek, maritime profiles while feeling solid beneath your steps. Step aboard and the mood is luminous, refined, and immediately hospitable. Expansive glazing and a flowing, open plan forge a quiet relationship with sea and sky, while a thoughtfully arranged layout makes entertaining effortless—from shaded morning coffee on the aft deck to golden-hour aperitifs beneath the stars. Social areas shift easily between lively gatherings and secluded retreats, with tasteful finishes and a calm, timeless palette that elevate ordinary moments. Practical stowage and intelligent ergonomics underpin extended cruising, ensuring life on board is as convenient as it is elegant.

Power comes from twin CAT inboard diesels that deliver smooth, dependable performance suited to discerning owners. A substantial 5,680-gallon fuel capacity enables ambitious, long-range itineraries, and a generous 1,386-gallon freshwater reserve allows prolonged periods off-grid—ideal for relaxed island-hopping or week-long coastal passages. Underway she balances efficiency with composure; at anchor her broad beam increases living space and onboard comfort, making days and nights aboard effortlessly enjoyable. From the first step on deck to the last sunset, this yacht is a contemporary expression of seafaring luxury—sleek, quiet, and unmistakably capable. An exemplary private cruiser for the Mediterranean lifestyle, she offers a rare combination of autonomy, elegance, and ease that seasoned owners value.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Specifications

With an overall length including the pulpit of 24.10 m—or 23.83 m excluding it—this yacht balances a 5.76 m beam with a 1.70 m draft to deliver poised, blue water capability. She displaces 58,550 kgs and carries 5,680 l of fuel alongside 1,386 l of fresh water including calorifier capacity, while propulsion is entrusted to twin CAT C32 engines rated at 1723 HP for confident, effortless performance.

Cabins

Accommodation is arranged around a full beam master cabin featuring a chaise longue and a bathroom appointed with a bath, complemented by a VIP double bed cabin, a further double bed cabin, and a guest cabin with twin beds; the crew are comfortably housed in a dedicated cabin for 3 persons. Enhancing daily life on board, the saloon incorporates a refined sideboard unit, while the cockpit welcomes lingering conversations with 3 wicker chairs.

Standard equipment

Precision handling is assured by a bow thruster (240kgf/529lbf), a dual station remote control electric anchor winch, deck and anchor wash, and electric stern rope mooring winches, while onboard autonomy comes from a 220V/240V diesel generator (27 kW) and full air conditioning throughout. Culinary and convivial moments are elevated by a combination microwave/conventional oven/grill, a full height refrigerator with freezer drawers, an ice maker, and a cocktail cabinet with refrigerator, together with a flybridge bar featuring a sink, barbecue, top loading coolbox, waste storage,

and optional icemaker, plus a dishwasher; in the crew area, a washing machine and separate dryer add welcome practicality. Comfort and entertainment are further enhanced by Vacuflush toilets with a holding tank, a saloon LCD TV/DVD with surround sound, and a flybridge stereo with radio/iPod and MP3 dock. Outdoors, craftsmanship shines with teak laid to the transom platform, cockpit deck, flybridge stairway, the step to side decks, side decks, and flybridge, complemented by a flybridge sunbed, a flybridge crane, an electro hydraulic raise/lower system for the transom platform, a remote control telescopic passerelle, and a hot and cold transom shower.

Additional equipment

Thoughtful enhancements include an icemaker located in the flybridge wetbar, an anchor chain counter serving both the upper and lower helm stations, and CCTV cameras feeding 2 x 6.4" CCTV screens and interfacing with the navigation equipment for confident oversight.

Electrical (tv / radio / telephone)

An elevated entertainment suite features a premium audio system, an iPod docking station in the saloon, and Infinity waterproof speakers at the bow linked to the saloon Bose system for rich, open air sound.

Generator

An additional 13.5 kW/50 Hz ONAN generator provides reassuring redundancy and quiet, dependable power offshore.
