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OVERVIEW

DESTINY was commissioned from Fifth Ocean Yachts in Ukraine and delivered in 2014 as a tailor-made 24-metre expedition motor yacht conceived for owners who prioritise extended autonomy, fuel economy and genuine bluewater capability rather than high speed. Constructed with a robust steel hull and aluminium superstructure and penned by Ginton Naval Architects, she carries the hallmarks of a true full-displacement explorer: reassuring strength, seakeeping and long-range intent.

At 78'5" (23.9m) overall and with a generous 21'10" beam, DESTINY offers exceptional interior volume and a stable platform for her size. Propelled by twin Caterpillar diesel engines, she cruises efficiently at displacement speeds and reaches a top speed of approximately 11.5 knots, making her particularly well suited to extended cruising and serious passagemaking.

The accommodation layout sleeps up to eight guests across four elegantly appointed cabins, centred around a full-beam owner's suite, while professional-minded owners will appreciate the dedicated crew quarters that support smooth operation and attentive service. Interiors are warm and inviting, enriched by large windows and a spacious main salon, with living spaces arranged for comfort during prolonged stays aboard.

Outside, convivial alfresco dining on the aft deck is complemented by multiple seating areas on the upper decks and broad open decks for relaxation whether underway or at anchor. More than many production yachts of similar length, DESTINY possesses genuine explorer credentials: a steel construction, economical running profile and a purposeful internal arrangement that together make her a compelling choice for those seeking a capable long-range cruiser with character. From Mediterranean sojourns and island-hopping to more adventurous bluewater itineraries, this displacement passagemaker delivers a confident, comfortable platform engineered to go farther.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations & entertainment

DESTINY comfortably accommodates up to seven guests across four elegantly appointed ensuite staterooms, arranged to maximise privacy, comfort and long-range livability. The full beam master suite serves as an expansive owner's sanctuary, appointed with a generous berth, a sofa seating area and vanity, a walk in wardrobe and a private shower room. Forward, the VIP stateroom offers a gracious guest retreat with a full length wardrobe and its own ensuite shower. On the port side a twin guest cabin provides two berths, a full length wardrobe and a dedicated ensuite shower, while the starboard single cabin features a single berth, full length wardrobe and private shower room. Two double crew cabins are provided, sleeping up to four crew, enabling professional onboard service while preserving owner and guest seclusion during extended passages.

The yacht's entertainment package is designed for effortless, whole yacht enjoyment of audio and video. Samsung Smart TVs are installed in every guest cabin, complemented by a pop up Samsung Smart TV in the main salon and an additional Samsung TV in the master suite. Premium audio is delivered by Bose loudspeakers in the salon and master stateroom, with integrated Bose speakers extending coverage to the guest and crew cabins, galley and all bathrooms, plus extra Bose units on the aft deck and flybridge for al fresco listening. An AMX multiroom media server provides access to onboard films and music fleetwide, and the smart entertainment system is compatible with iPad, iPhone and iPod control. The specification is rounded out by a SAT TV installation, a Panasonic PBX communications system in the wheelhouse and Bang & Olufsen telephones in all cabins and living areas.

With expansive ensuite accommodation, dedicated crew quarters and a fully

integrated entertainment system that spans interior and exterior decks, DESTINY delivers the comfort, convenience and creature comforts expected of a capable long range explorer yacht.

Wheelhouse

Designed for extended offshore voyages, DESTINY's wheelhouse pairs sweeping, wraparound glazing with ergonomically arranged controls and a full suite of navigation systems. Large panoramic windows provide uninterrupted sightlines while a bespoke helm console positions every primary switch and display within effortless reach; rich timber veneers and custom cabinetry introduce a warm, refined atmosphere that underscores the space's purposeful elegance and explorer class character.

A commodious helm chair accompanied by adjacent companion seating invites guests to share the passage, turning the pilothouse into both a highly functional operations center and an inviting vantage salon for underway viewing.

The navigation and helm package centers on three Raymarine e165 15.4 inch multifunction displays integrated with a Raymarine RS130 GPS receiver and supported by a Raymarine DSM300 HD digital sounder module, a Raymarine i70 instrument display, a Rotavecta wind transducer, a Raymarine SS270W wide beam depth transducer, and a CS4500 LP ultrasonic speed sensor to deliver precise situational awareness. Surveillance and control are further augmented by a 4 kW 48 inch HD digital open array radar, Raymarine AIS650, the Raymarine Lifetag system, a Raymarine SmartController wireless autopilot, a Raymarine p70R autopilot controller, and the Raymarine SPX SOL SmartPilot core pack.

Communications and safety appliances include a Raymarine Ray218E VHF radio with a Raymarine Ray101E handheld VHF for backup, SAILOR 150 FleetBroadband satellite communications, a SAILOR 60 satellite TV system, a

SAILOR SE406 II 406 MHz EPIRB, a SAILOR SART, a Thrane & Thrane Navtex receiver and a Furuno NX 300 receiver. Rounding out the helm fit are an Ultrasonic WX 200 weather station and a MARCO marine whistle.

Specified with the demands of true blue water cruising in mind, DESTINY's pilothouse delivers the visibility, technology and composure required for confident passagemaking; whether threading tight coastal channels or embarking on extended ocean crossings, her wheelhouse exemplifies the capable refinement of an authentic explorer yacht.

Deck areas

The exterior spaces of DESTINY are conceived with the same pragmatic explorer yacht mindset that governs the entire vessel. Expansive teak decking, tall stainless steel safety rails, sheltered walkways and ample outdoor living areas provide a secure and comfortable environment for guests and crew whether underway, at anchor or alongside. Visually, DESTINY presents a purposeful, enduring silhouette: a dark hull contrasted with a white superstructure and generous panoramic windows that speak to her long range cruising pedigree. A substantial bow, elevated bulwarks and broad side decks attest to solid construction and genuine offshore capability, while the open deck layout ensures excellent practical use throughout.

The aft deck functions as an inviting social hub for entertaining and relaxed passagemaking, shaded beneath the overhang of the upper deck to allow alfresco dining, morning coffee or evening cocktails in comfort. A built in upholstered settee encircles a teak dining table to form an intimate gathering area, complemented by teak underfoot, polished stainless steel detailing and the yacht's classic white superstructure. Large sliding glass doors create a seamless connection to the main salon for true indoor outdoor living, while a convenient staircase rises to the upper deck and wide side decks permit safe passage forward to the foredeck.

Teak-laid side decks run fore and aft to join the aft deck, foredeck and wheelhouse, promoting secure, easy circulation for crew and guests both underway and at anchor. High stainless steel railings and substantial bulwarks provide reassuring protection, and covered portions of the walkways offer shade and shelter from the elements. Oversized tinted salon windows bathe the interior in natural light and accentuate DESTINY's clean, timeless lines, while the pragmatic side-deck arrangement is perfectly suited to line handling and daily operation.

The upper deck blends sociable outdoor living with purposeful utility. Finished in teak, it is equipped with a built-in outdoor galley that includes a stainless steel grill, sink, generous countertop workspace and storage cabinetry—an ideal venue for open-air cooking and convivial gatherings. An elevated vantage point and open plan afford sweeping views and a comfortable place to relax whether underway or at anchor. In keeping with DESTINY's explorer heritage, this deck also serves as the dedicated area for tender and equipment handling, supported by heavy-duty stainless steel railings and deck hardware and arranged for extended cruising operations.

Forward, the teak-laid foredeck underscores the yacht's functional design and rugged build. Heavy-duty windlasses and anchoring systems work alongside stainless steel cleats, fairleads and deck fittings to ensure safe, efficient handling, while high bulwarks and safety rails further enhance security. A generous working area provides confidence for anchoring and line handling, and integrated forward seating offers a comfortable vantage to enjoy the view—an elegant demonstration of capability engineered for dependable offshore performance.

Swim platform

Situated at the stern, DESTINY is equipped with a carefully integrated swim platform and boarding area that provides direct, effortless access from either

the dock or the water. The stern's robust, purposeful lines reflect the yacht's explorer character, while polished stainless-steel handrails and thoughtfully arranged boarding details ensure confident, safe movement on and off the vessel. The transom is arranged to accommodate watersports, tender operations or smooth marina embarkation with ease.

When at anchor, the swim platform becomes central to life aboard — encouraging easy entry to the water for swimming, supporting a variety of on-water activities and allowing swift access to tenders — all reinforcing DESTINY's practicality as a cruising yacht conceived for extended periods on board.

Overall deck impression

DESTINY's exterior decks have been crafted for extended passages, presenting generous, highly functional spaces that seamlessly combine guest-focused comforts with practical operational features. Expansive teak-clad surfaces and robust deck equipment frame welcoming entertainment areas while secure, well-proportioned walkways ensure safe movement around the yacht. A shaded aft deck creates an elegant setting for alfresco dining, the upper deck is organized as a dedicated barbecue and social hub, broad side decks permit easy and secure transit along the hull, and the foredeck is purpose-built to support serious anchoring and line-handling tasks. Together, these exterior zones confirm DESTINY's explorer-yacht character—sturdy yet refined, eminently practical and fully prepared for long-range cruising.

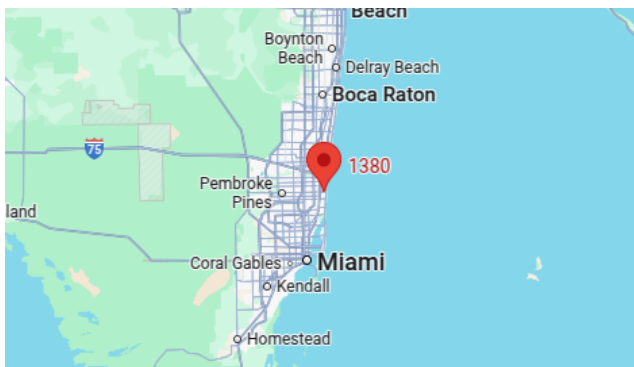
