Her size is purposefully set just below the crucial 24-meter threshold applied by many tax authorities, above which a leisure craft is reclassified as a pleasure craft and becomes subject to a different tax regime; at 23.98 meters in length, the 80 remains firmly within the leisure craft category. The Ferretti 80 sets the pace for pleasure yachts, evolved from the Ferretti 225 in a way that not only preserves but heightens that model's acclaimed performance, reducing the usually accepted gap between top speed and cruising speed to ensure dynamics that befit its exclusive role as a compact superyacht. The added length and evolution from the 225 bring further refinements: the engine room is positioned more advantageously; the fuel tanks play a dual role, storing fuel while serving as an effective sound barrier for the master cabin; the crew cabins and the auxiliary room adopt a more practical layout. Increased size also allows the aft mooring area to be kept separate from the cockpit so guests can watch operations undisturbed, and this relentless attention to quality and thoughtful design has kept Ferretti ahead — in five years, thirty-eight prestigious Ferretti 80s have been delivered.
