OVERVIEW

An 80-foot Hatteras-conceived semi-displacement motor yacht from 2004, she carries unmistakable American lineage and a composed presence that speaks to long-range cruising in comfort and style. Her generous 21-foot beam translates to voluminous interiors and expansive decks, while solid GRP/fiberglass hull and fiberglass decks provide the stiffness, quiet ride, and low-maintenance pedigree expected of a finely built American yacht.

Twin inboard Caterpillar diesel engines furnish dependable, smooth power that allows an easy cruising speed of 18 knots, making her equally capable on offshore passages or spirited coastal hops. Fuel capacity in excess of 2,100 gallons supports extended runs without compromise, and a 325-gallon freshwater tank keeps life aboard comfortable and self-sufficient. The systems are laid out for efficiency and long-distance operation, reflecting thoughtful engineering throughout.

Inside, the salon is an elegant yet welcoming space, framed by wide picture windows and refined joinery that create a serene venue for both casual relaxation and formal evenings. The interior plan is practical and graceful: a galley situated to serve salon and alfresco dining with ease, generous lounge seating for conversation or solitary reading, and a dedicated formal dining area to elevate entertaining. Below decks, accommodations prioritize privacy and comfort with a tranquil full-beam owner's stateroom, a luminous VIP suite, and additional guest cabins, each appointed with intelligent storage, en-suite facilities, and sound-dampening construction. Crew quarters are arranged to provide efficient service while preserving guest privacy.

Outdoor spaces are designed for living and seafaring alike. The broad aft deck offers shaded dining and an ideal setting for sunset cocktails, while wide side decks and secure railings reinforce safe passage around the vessel. The flybridge serves as the social high point under way or at anchor, boasting

panoramic sightlines, abundant seating, and room for a wet bar or grill to enhance onboard hospitality. At the waterline a substantial swim platform simplifies tender transfers and invites effortless afternoon swims.

Located in the United States and fashioned by Hatteras to balance performance with poise, this 80-foot GRP motor yacht is a refined choice for owners who prize pedigree, capability, and enduring style. She presents as an accomplished platform for family cruising, elegant entertaining, and confident offshore runs, marrying Caterpillar diesel inboard power with the timeless appeal of an American classic.

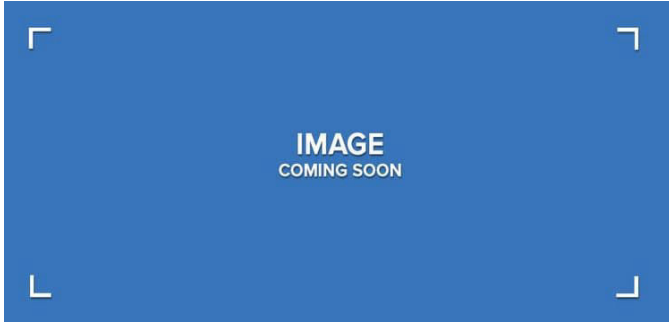

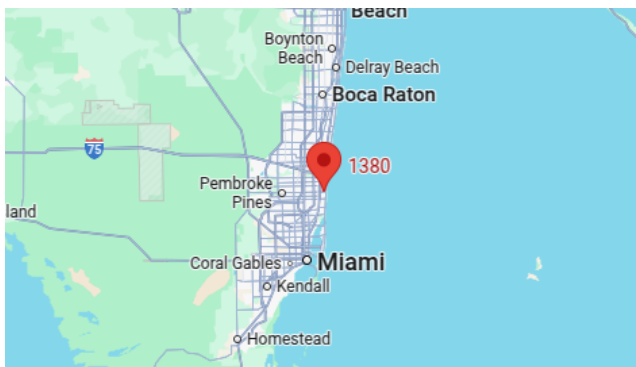
