OVERVIEW

A timeless 80-foot expression of seagoing refinement, this 2004 model (built in 2003) combines an authoritative silhouette with inviting warmth, conceived for owners who prize both elegance and genuine cruising capability. Lying in the United States and fashioned in robust fiberglass composite with matching fiberglass decks, she delivers the reassuring solidity, hushed motion, and low-maintenance finish that discriminating yachtsmen expect in a premium motor yacht.

Propulsion is provided by twin MTU inboard diesels, engines celebrated for their smooth power delivery, reliability, and cultivated performance. Those drivetrains translate into poised handling underway and relaxed, economical passages at displacement speeds, whether plotting a short coastal weekend or an ambitious island-hopping voyage. The overall result is calm, composed travel that keeps conversation easy and glasses replenished.

The exterior invites life by the horizon with generous outdoor spaces that feel as integral as the interior. A broad foredeck is ideal for enjoying an anchorage, while the aft area shifts effortlessly from casual lounge to refined alfresco dining beneath the stars. Wide side decks and substantial railings promote a sense of security and ease of movement, and the broad transom makes water access intuitive—precisely what one wants when the tender is away and the sea is calling.

Within, the atmosphere emphasizes light, scale, and fine workmanship. A bright, expansive salon greets guests with refined joinery and soft furnishings, flowing naturally to a dedicated dining area intended for lingering meals and convivial evenings. The galley is arranged to satisfy both professional crew and owner-operators, supporting everything from sunrise espressos to multi-course celebrations. Private accommodations offer serene respite at day's end: a gracious owner's suite and well-appointed guest staterooms

provide ample storage, thoughtful layouts, and quietly luxurious finishes that make extended time aboard effortless.

At the helm, intuitive ergonomics and unobstructed sightlines reflect a purposeful design, while the yacht's engineering—twin inboard diesels, composite construction, and carefully managed weight distribution and sound insulation—converts into an experience that feels as confident as it is refined. This is a vessel built to cruise beautifully and to receive guests with a sense of occasion, season after season.

Currently available for inspection in the United States, this 80-footer is equally at ease hosting a sunset cocktail party at the dock or slipping away to seek an empty anchorage beyond the next headland.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Introducing the stabilized 2004 80' Carat Azimut, a true masterpiece in luxury yachting where elegance, performance, and comfort converge in one extraordinary motoryacht. Her sleek profile and impeccable craftsmanship frame a sunlit main salon with exquisite furnishings, while four luxurious cabins welcome up to eight guests to unwind in privacy and ease. From the first step aboard, the ambiance is refined and inviting, delivering an effortlessly smooth, stabilized ride and an unparalleled cruising experience worthy of the Azimut name.

2021 - 2023 updates

From 2021 through 2023, this yacht benefited from a comprehensive program of upgrades that elevated reliability, comfort, and style. Power resilience was strengthened with two new Kohler/Lamborghini 32 kW generators showing 300 hours and covered by a five-year warranty, supported by Racor filtration, new KVA auto-boost transformers, and shore power inline soft starts. Deck refinement included new teak on the aft deck and flybridge stairs, fresh bow non-skid in 2023, new SeaDek on the platform, and fresh varnish on cap rails, while a telescopic two-stage gangway and sea ladder enhance access.

Underway capability and safety advanced with new radar and a full Garmin navigation suite including new radar, Garmin autopilot, Garmin stern cameras, and a rebuilt stern thruster; shafts were pulled and aligned, dial-indicated, with Propspeed applied to shafts and props, props balanced, and new tide seals, cutlass bearings, new shaft seals, and spares added. Systems modernization brings a rebuilt passerelle with remote control, rebuilt black and gray water systems, new raw water pump and sea strainers, rebuilt fuel shut off valves, a

ship's monitoring system with remote access, and upgraded fire systems with serviced CO2 cylinders and extinguishers. Climate and comfort were enhanced with rebuilt chiller cooling towers and air handler, interior bicolor lights in warm white/red, exterior bicolor lights in white/blue, a water heater upgrade from 11 gal to 13 gal, and new interior Magne shades. The electrical backbone was refreshed with new batteries in 2023, new underwater lighting, a new light up name board, new matching exterior covers, and a wireless phone charger at the flybridge helm. On the bridge, a new U line flybridge refrigerator with icemaker, a flybridge wine cooler/fridge, a newly fabricated Bunny pad, and Fusion/JL Audio exterior sound across three zones join cushions that were renewed in 2020. Entertainment and connectivity were transformed with all new TVs, a new smart TV in the crew quarters, a new Pepwave wireless system integrated with an iPad controlled AV system, and an entertainment center in black plexiglass, while the interior benefited from newly refinished veneer on the dining table and entertainment center, new counter tops in the salon, galley, and mapping station, as well as new interior outlet covers in black and a new coffee table. The galley shines with new countertops, a wine cooler, a new beverage cooler, and a French door refrigerator/freezer, while the crew area gained a new refrigerator/freezer, a new ceramic cooktop, and granite or marble counters throughout. Exterior function and safety improved with a new windlass, a 2023 anchor windlass, new life rafts, a custom windshield cover with the vessel name, a sea ladder, and a telescopic two stage gangway. Performance and steering confidence were reaffirmed with a transmission rebuild using existing clutches and gears, serviced ABT Stabilizers, a rebuilt power steering and autopilot pump, and the servicing of both MTU 12V 2000 main engines, including replacement of fuel injectors, rebuilding EUPs, removal and ultrasonic cleaning of heat exchangers and charge air coolers with reinstallation. Additional refinements include all thru hulls replaced, new Garmin navigation with radar, new forward bilge pump, a new gray water pump, new chalking from the flybridge down, removal

of mirror finish from external windows, new floor runners in the salon and on steps to the sleeping quarters, VIP room and closet wood replaced, a sea ladder for effortless water access, an added Pullman bunk in the crew, and bottom paint to complete the refresh.

Main salon

The main salon welcomes with new beige carpet underfoot and newly refreshed soft goods, setting a warm, contemporary tone beneath overhead paneling punctuated by seven recessed lights. Wood valances port and starboard frame drop shades and drapes, with an aft curtain adding privacy when desired. To port, cherry cabinetry conceals a Samsung flat screen television on a remote control lift, while opposing built in curved sofas to port and starboard—with generous pillows—invite relaxed conversation alongside an aft built in chair. Burled wood countertops outboard to port and starboard complement a cherry table crowned with burled wood and a glass top, as the entertainment suite delivers immersive options with a Samsung Blu ray player, Creston Integrated System, Direct TV, a Sony FM/AM receiver, a Sony AV multichannel receiver, and a WiFi router.

Dining area

Just forward, the dining area exudes tailored sophistication with a suede upholstered overhead and a cherry wood trim piece inlaid with fiberglass, illuminated by five recessed lights. Purpose designed for gracious service, the portside built in cabinetry offers privacy shutters to the galley with dedicated cabinets for secured glassware and china storage, while a full length built in cabinet at the starboard forward bulkhead hides a false upper panel with practical storage below. At center, an oval cherry wood table provides elegant seating, perfectly paired with a Scottsman 32 bottle wine

cooler to set the tone for memorable meals.

Galley

Designed for culinary ease and professional capability, the galley features a Frigidaire refrigerator and freezer, a forward pantry, and an inboard Hoshizaki ice maker. An exit door opens directly to the portside deck, while two cherry wood cabinets—port outboard and centerline inboard—are topped with striking granite countertops. Premium Miele appliances include a four burner smooth surface stovetop, an oven, and an Incognito dishwasher, complemented by a General Electric Profile microwave oven. Two round stainless steel sinks with a single lever faucet sit beneath built in overhead cabinets to port outboard and centerline inboard, and an aft stairway leads conveniently down to the crew quarters and engine room.

Master stateroom

The master stateroom is a serene retreat with an ultra suede overhead accented by six lights and a fiberglass inlay with three recessed fixtures. A king size island berth anchors the space with five built in drawers below, flanked by nightstands with drawers and two swing arm reading lamps, while a mirror on the aft bulkhead amplifies light. An overhead soffit with two recessed lights highlights port and starboard LED arrays—three per side—with drop shades and curtains. To port, a built in dresser offers nine drawers and two cabinets; to starboard, built in drawers integrate an entertainment center with a 42" Samsung television and a Samsung Blu ray player, alongside a vanity with mirror and stool, six drawers, and two cabinets. A generous walk in closet provides a full length mirror, built in drawers, and three recessed lights, while audio is managed via SSBC speaker selector volume control and a Rotel amplifier.

Master head

Refined finishes define the master head, where a marble sole meets a fiberglass overhead with four recessed lights and a fiberglass soffit over the countertop with three additional recessed fixtures. A built-in outboard vanity presents a marble countertop with two sinks and twin mirrored medicine cabinets, complemented by a shaded porthole. The VacuFlush head sits adjacent to a spacious walk-in shower with overhead light, a handheld showerhead, horizontal shower nozzles, and hot/cold faucet for an invigorating spa-like experience.

Guest stateroom, starboard

The starboard guest stateroom offers calm comfort with an ultra-soft suede overhead and four recessed lights over twin berths dressed in refined textiles. Curtains frame a portlight, and a built-in nightstand sits between the berths for convenience. Entertainment arrives via a Sony AM/FM/CD player feeding two stereo speakers and a 12-inch Samsung flatscreen TV, while four mirrored panels on the forward bulkhead add depth. Two swing-arm reading lamps and two air conditioning units—one under each berth—ensure personalized comfort, with a hanging locker completing the thoughtful storage.

Guest head, starboard

Accessible from both the companionway and the starboard stateroom, this guest head features a fiberglass overhead with four recessed lights and a built-in vanity crowned by a marble countertop and sink with mirrored panels above. Outboard, a dedicated storage locker complements the VacuFlush head and a portlight with drop shade. Bathing convenience comes via a shower with a Lexan circular door and a separate shower stall with a circular door for a

bright, watertight enclosure.

Guest stateroom, port

On the port side, the guest stateroom offers a double berth under an ultra suede overhead with four recessed lights. Six mirrored panels aft enrich the sense of space, while a lighted hanging locker to port and a Cruisair SMX air conditioning control ensure tailored comfort. A shaded porthole, Sony AM FM/CD player, and a 12" Samsung flatscreen TV complete this well appointed retreat.

Guest head, port

This guest head pairs warm wood flooring with a fiberglass overhead and three recessed lights. A built in cabinet to port forward features a marble countertop, sink, and faucet beneath a mirrored vanity, with a storage locker close at hand. The VacuFlush head, a portlight with drop shade, and a shower area with a circular Lexan door complete a bright and efficient space.

Guest stateroom, bow

Forward, the bow guest stateroom feels bright and balanced with an ultra suede overhead and a single recessed light paired to a cherry wood overhead soffit with eight recessed lights. Curtains frame the space, while a centerline queen island berth rests over two aft drawers. Built in countertops outboard to port and starboard provide convenient surfaces, and entertainment arrives via a Sony stereo and a 14" Samsung flatscreen TV. To starboard, a walk in closet with overhead recessed lights offers generous storage to settle in for extended cruising.

Guest head, bow

The bow guest head is bright and luxurious with a fiberglass overhead and four recessed lights. A built in curved wood cabinet to port features a marble countertop and backsplash with sink and faucet, complemented by a storage locker and a wood frame mirror over the sink. Amenities include a VacuFlush head and a circular Lexan door to the shower area, where a handheld showerhead, overhead showerhead, and four shower nozzles deliver spa style versatility.

Flybridge

The flybridge is crafted for open air living, with fiberglass decks, curved seating to port and starboard, and an oval table to starboard for al fresco gatherings. Forward, a central cabinet integrates a built in sink, BBQ grill, molded top, and refrigerator, joined by a fiberglass storage cabinet to starboard forward and a forward bench helm seat. Command is intuitive with full VDO engine instrumentation, Jabsco searchlight controls, a steering wheel, Raymarine rudder indicator, trim tab level indicator, and American Bow Thruster control for both bow and stern. Safety and enjoyment are assured with a life ring, a generous sun lounge, an Opacmare davit, and KVH TracVision 7 for at sea entertainment, completing a bridge designed for effortless days under the sun.

Lower helm

At the lower helm, vinyl overhead panels with four recessed lights frame a beautifully appointed command center with a leather dash pad and helm, leather seating, and an adjustable center seat. Climate is set via Cruisair SMX II air conditioning control, while two recessed red lights accent the helm area for

night running. A wood steering wheel pairs with single lever MTU controls and a touch screen control panel to the computer system, guided by a White Star compass. Precision is furthered by American Bow Thruster controls for bow and stern, two stainless steel grab rails, full VDO engine instrumentation, and an ICOM M504 VHF. For navigation and ride quality, the station integrates Raymarine ST 290, ABT Trac Zero Speed Stabilizer, Raymarine rudder indicator, Simrad AP28 autopilot, Garmin 7215 and 7015 GPS plotters, and a Raymarine RL70 radar.

Crew quarters

Practical and welcoming, the crew quarters include an L shaped dinette and a built in cabinet with a granite countertop, stainless steel sink, and single lever water faucet, with overhead storage aft to keep essentials organized. Laundry needs are handled by a Miele Novotronic T1565C clothes dryer and Miele Novotronic W1918 clothes washer, with comfort set via Cruisair SMX II air conditioning control. A Sanyo refrigerator keeps provisions close, while the head pump and vacuum tank under the stairs with a discharge Y valve attest to thoughtful engineering. A dedicated door leads directly to the engine room, and upper and lower bunks ensure efficient, restful accommodation for the crew.

Crew head

The crew head is streamlined and functional with a VacuFlush head, mirrored vanity, and a shower area with a circular door—clean, bright, and easy to maintain for daily use.

Decks and superstructure

Outdoors, the yacht presents a renewed canvas for adventure with a new teak deck sealed in ceramic wax, a welcoming cockpit table, and boarding doors to the cabin on both port and starboard. Teak decks carry forward with non-skid halfway to the bow and a handsome teak cap rail, while lights in the foredeck step up and overhead deck lights—four to port and four to starboard—set the mood after dusk. Forward utility is assured by two windshield wipers with washers, a sun lounge area, and approximately a 90 lb stockless anchor with 250' of chain, supported by an electric/hydraulic passerelle for effortless embarkation.

Aft deck

The aft deck showcases a new teak deck beneath a fiberglass overhang with eight recessed lights, and teak laid over fiberglass for timeless appeal. Storage and function meet with a port forward locker, port and starboard stern cleats, and hawse eyes with rollers, while twin Maxwell 1500 windlasses to port and starboard feature convenient deck controls. Entertaining is effortless around a teak table on stainless steel pedestals with four teak folding chairs, supported by three aft lockers including a center locker with a fire hose outlet, a control panel for the aft stairway, port hatch, starboard hatch, and swim ladder, plus a starboard side freezer. A teak cap rail completes this refined outdoor salon.

Fire fighting and safety equipment

Safety aboard is comprehensive, featuring portable dry chemical extinguishers, a built-in system with three CO2 units, and a 220 volt auxiliary fire pump—robust protection designed for confident passagemaking.

Main machinery

Performance is anchored by MTU engine model 12V2000 power, with the 2000 hour service completed September 2021** to keep operations turnkey. Fuel delivery is safeguarded by dual Racor filters and MTU electronic controls, while long range independence is supported by a Sea Recovery watermaker. Bilge management is thorough with three electric/automatic pumps, two sumps, and a 220 volt electric feed to a compartment manifold, while freshwater pressure is maintained by two 24 VDC systems. Manoeuvrability is assured with BCS bow thruster and a stern thruster, and propulsion is delivered via five bladed NiBral propellers on 3.5" stainless steel shafts. Hydraulic steering and Cruisair direct expansion air conditioning complete a machinery list built for enduring performance.

Engine room

The engine room is bright and organized with fluorescent overhead A.C. lights behind safety lenses, and it houses twin 2021 Kohler 32 kW generators—one mid centerline and one aft centerline—each showing 300 hours and covered by a five year warranty. Each generator benefits from dedicated Racor fuel filters, while hydraulics power the davit, swim ladder, pod hatches, step door, trim tabs, and steering. A main circuit panel anchors ship systems, supported by two fiberglass generator mufflers with water separators and two 24 volt freshwater system pumps with an accumulator tank, filter, and pressure gauge. Additional amenities include a water heater; air conditioning units—two to port and two to starboard; dripless shaft seals port and starboard; a 24 volt fuel transfer pump and manual fuel transfer option; and a circuit panel for the crew quarters. A bilge pump feeds a six compartment manifold with shut off valves, and battery switches serve each generator, each engine, ship's service, and the fuel shut off valves at the centerline forward

below decks. An electric/automatic bilge pump, a Craftsman toolbox, and a Mastervolt 24 volt 75 amp battery charger for two house service batteries round out the serviceability. For safety and power, a 230 volt fire pump, six 12 volt ship's service batteries, an emergency steering wheel with valves, an air conditioning raw water circulating pump, combined A.C. and D.C. circuit panels, and two 12 volt engine batteries are on station, with engine emergency stop buttons and a Sea Recovery watermaker adding final confidence.

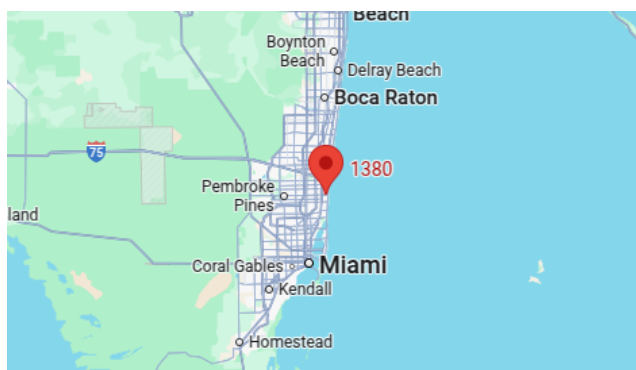
