OVERVIEW

A 2010 Ferretti 800, offered with EU VAT paid, presents a rare chance to acquire a beautifully maintained 24m flybridge motor yacht. Styled and finished to an exacting standard, ANTONINA is widely recognised as the finest Ferretti 800 currently available, a luxury craft from one of the marque's most celebrated series, enhanced by numerous owner-led upgrades.

A painted flybridge hardtop with an elegant glass sunroof crowns the upper deck, admitting light and lending refined presence to the exterior lines. The interior plan is exceptionally well considered for its class, providing genuine separation and privacy between the salon and dining areas and the galley and crew quarters, a layout that suits both intimate family cruising and polished entertaining.

Sleeping eight in four generous cabins with panoramic windows, the accommodation is calm and contemporary, defined by clean lines, pale timber finishes and fresh white accents that create an airy, sophisticated ambiance. Outside, living spaces are abundant and inviting: a welcoming foredeck lounge, a beach-club style aft platform complete with garage, a capacious cockpit and an expansive flybridge with plentiful sunbathing areas, all ideal for Mediterranean passage aboard a planing performance yacht.

Propelled by twin MAN V12 1800s, ANTONINA cruises comfortably at 24 knots and exceeds 30 knots at top speed. She is available to view in Malta and must be seen to appreciate the quality and presence she offers.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Main characteristics

Built by Ferretti, this 800 from 2010 measures 24.71 m in length with a 6.28 m beam and 1.85 m draft, displacing 75,000 kg in robust GRP. Certified to CE Category A, she is equipped for serious cruising with fuel capacity of 6,750 liters, fresh water of 1,320 liters, and black and grey water tanks of 330 liters each. The specification balances volume, seaworthiness and range to deliver confident passage-making.

Accommodations

Four cabins comprising a full-beam master, a generous VIP, a double and a twin are each served by their own ensuite, creating a private retreat for every guest. Crew are comfortably accommodated in two crew cabins for a team of three with a dedicated crew ensuite, ensuring seamless service and discretion.

Engines & performances

Power comes from MAN V12 1800s delivering twin 1800 hp, coupled to ZF V-Drives and showing 1600 hours, with ship's power supported by two Kohler generators. She cruises confidently at 24 knots with a maximum of 31 knots, offering a range of 300 nm at cruising speed and consumption around 350 lph at 24 knots.

Technical

Onboard systems are specified for effortless handling and comfort: Condaria air conditioning throughout pairs with Sidepower electric bow and stern

thrusters and a pair of ARG gyro stabilizers. Long-range autonomy is bolstered by an Idromar watermaker producing 180 lph, while deck gear includes two electric Lofrans windlasses working twin 50 kg Bruce anchors on 90 m of 12 mm chain, matched by two electric Lofrans capstans. Access is via a Besenconi gangway, with a beach-club style swim platform aft and a Besenconi crane rated at 450 kg for tender handling; propulsion turns on Rolla propellers with BCS trim tabs. A hardtop with glass roof crowns the exterior, complemented by a foredeck lounge with sun shade and panoramic cabin windows. Electrical architecture is Mastervolt-driven with charger and inverter on a 24/220 V, 50 Hz system, and onboard utilities are by Gianneschi for fresh, grey and bilge systems with Tecma plus Gianneschi for black water. After dark, underwater lights set the scene and a remotely controlled search light stands ready for precision maneuvers.

Navigation and electronics

The helm is outfitted with a Furuno black box plotter, Furuno radar, Furuno autopilot, Furuno echo sounder and Furuno VHF, all guided by a magnetic compass and backed by an engine-room CCTV. A Naviop monitoring system centralizes ship data, while KVH satellite TV and a Bose sound system elevate entertainment underway and at anchor.

Appliances

In the galley, a full-height refrigerator is paired with a full-height freezer featuring an ice dispenser, supported by a dedicated icemaker for effortless hospitality. Cooking and clean-up are handled by Bosch appliances throughout, including oven, stove, dishwasher and a combined washer/dryer, while an electric BBQ on the flybridge turns sundowners into signature moments.

Toys, safety and exclusions

Your days on the water are amplified by a Capelli 360 tender powered by a 40 hp Yamaha for smooth shore runs and exploration, with life rafts aboard to underline a safety-first ethos.
