Laziza is a 24,99 m luxury motor yacht delivered in 2004, masterfully constructed in Italy by the Benetti Sail Division and embodying refined Italian craftsmanship. She accommodates up to 8 guests across four elegantly appointed cabins (1 Master, 1 VIP and 2 Twins), with comfortable accommodation for a crew of 3. Maintained to impeccable standards by her owner and presented in outstanding condition, Laziza received numerous notable upgrades in 2022–2023, remaining an elegant Italian-built superyacht and long-range cruising motor yacht for discerning yachting.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Interior equipment

Designed to elevate life on board, the interior specification blends comfort with absolute control, where zero speed stabilizers keep the yacht composed at anchor and a bow thruster assists with precise harbour entries. Both electric and manual bilge pumps are fitted for steadfast redundancy, complemented by a sea water pump and an air compressor that support the vessel's systems. Climate is refined through full air conditioning and heating with hot water always on tap, while power resilience is ensured by a battery charger feeding the domestic network and an electric head offers modern convenience. Entertainment is curated by a TV set and a rich sound system, and long-range autonomy is assured with a fresh water maker and generous cold storage that includes a deep freezer alongside three fridges and three freezers. Daily living is effortless with a washing machine/dryer, an oven, a ceramic hob and a microwave — every detail poised for extended, elegant cruising.

Electrical equipment

A robust electrical backbone empowers every voyage: a shorepower inlet feeds the systems alongside two Kohler generators, while an inverter and a dedicated battery charger keep energy seamless under way. The Idromar watermaker and the comprehensive air conditioning are comfortably supported, and anchor handling is effortless with two electric windlasses delivering dependable muscle at the push of a button.

Electronics

A captain's toolkit of precision instruments places the sea at your fingertips: a

full navigation centre integrates radar, a log-speedometer, a compass, and wind speed and direction instruments, with Simrad depth sounder and Simrad autopilot bringing fingertip accuracy to every leg. Route planning and situational awareness are enhanced by a Furuno GPS plotter and clear comms via a Furuno VHF radio, while CCTV watches discreetly over deck and machinery spaces. Integrated stabilizers complement the helmsman's confidence, Electric Morse engine controls deliver silky throttle response, and the bow thruster adds finesse in close quarters.

Outside equipment

Purposeful deck gear invites seamless outdoor living: a hydraulic gangway offers graceful boarding, complemented by a crane to handle the tender with ease, while a swimming ladder turns every anchorage into a private beach. Power on deck is assured with two electric winches, and the Flexiteek deck pairs beautifully with a teak cockpit and teak side decks for timeless footing and warmth. After a swim, a cockpit shower refreshes; then sink into plush cockpit cushions around the cockpit table for unhurried moments over sea views.

Flybridge

The flybridge is a sanctuary of open-air ease: a generous solarium invites sun-drenched lounging beneath the shelter of an awning, while a dedicated manoeuvring bridge with duplicate electronics mirrors the main helm for confident control aloft. Entertaining is effortless with a fridge close to hand, and the Flexiteek deck underfoot completes a refined, barefoot-friendly ambiance.

Covers

Protection and shade are elegantly assured with a Bimini top for long, cool afternoons and a stern lock cover that encloses the aft area when the weather calls for shelter.

Safety equipment

Prepared for bluewater confidence, the yacht carries two life rafts and a radio beacon for swift location and alerting, supported by a CO2 firefighting system that brings professional-grade protection to the machinery spaces.

2022-2023 refit history

Meticulously refreshed for the seasons ahead, the yacht benefited from a comprehensive program in 2022–2023: Flexiteek coverings on the deck and flybridge were renewed and a complete antifouling process was carried out for a clean, efficient hull. The electric windlass underwent a full overhaul, the entire electrical system received a professional audit, and the engines saw a major service/overhaul at 1,500 hours. Fuel and water tanks were thoroughly cleaned, the watermaker was overhauled, and the generator received scheduled service at 5,500 hours. Propeller shafts and propellers were inspected, and the navigation system was upgraded with replication to the flybridge. The topsides, hull, and superstructure were repainted with Awlgrip, while grey water tanks were replaced. Fresh water pumps rated 12/24WA and 230/380WA were renewed along with a 220WA socket, and the tender itself was replaced. Safety gear was both renewed and overhauled, bilges were sanitized and painted, and the complete antifouling procedure was confirmed. A hydrodynamic and stability study was conducted with the boat's weight baseline, and the maintenance book is fully up to date.
