OVERVIEW

This Sunseeker Predator 82' is a thrilling performance motor yacht that marries open air freedom with meticulously finished interiors, embodying the unmistakable DNA of Sunseeker's sport cruiser heritage. Its low, sculpted silhouette, generous internal volume and lively top end promise attention wherever she sails; following a comprehensive 2025 refit she now presents contemporary accents that sit comfortably alongside her inherently athletic spirit. Equally at home as a glamorous open yacht or a compact superyacht, she delivers an immersive, stylish life at sea.

The refit left no detail untouched: a complete exterior repaint has refreshed her lines with a crisp, modern coat; brand new Flexiteek decking extends across every outdoor area for durability and visual continuity; custom sunpads fore and aft increase the options for lounging; and a reimagined salon ceiling bathes the interior in added light and a heightened sense of refinement. Below deck, engines, generators and the vessel's principal mechanical systems were fully overhauled to restore peak performance, ensure silky cruising and provide the long term reliability expected of a premium sports yacht.

Inside, warm teak flooring flows uninterrupted out to the aft cockpit, forging a seamless transition beneath the sleek hardtop. The broad aft deck is arranged for alfresco dining and relaxed lounging, while the hydraulic swim platform lowers the threshold to the water—making sea entries and tender launching effortless, ideal for extended Mediterranean anchors or spontaneous coastal excursions.

Accommodation is thoughtfully planned to sleep up to eight guests across four well proportioned cabins: a full beam owner's suite with its own private en suite, a generous VIP stateroom with an independent bathroom, plus a twin cabin and a bunk cabin that share an additional washroom. Crew are comfortably housed in dedicated quarters for two, allowing service to remain

discreet and professional so every moment on board flows with ease.

The main salon is both inviting and versatile, anchored by a large sofa and a dining table for eight that suit informal family gatherings and refined evening entertaining alike. Outside, the spacious aft dining area sets the scene for starlit meals, and expansive sunpads at bow and stern encourage slow, sunny afternoons. A new removable bow awning, supported by lightweight carbon poles, creates a cool shaded sanctuary at peak midday warmth without interrupting the yacht's clean, sporty profile.

With a considered layout, refreshed finishes and targeted upgrades throughout, this Predator 82' presents as a refined, high performance motor yacht — an exceptional platform for Mediterranean cruising in absolute comfort and style, perfectly suited to private ownership or luxury charter as a true sports cruiser and open superyacht.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

Thoughtfully arranged for privacy and effortless service, the interior features a fully equipped aft galley set apart from the main saloon to keep hosting seamless and refined. Immediately adjacent, crew quarters for two with a dedicated bathroom ensure smooth, discreet operations. Below, four cabins welcome up to 8 overnight guests: a full-beam owner's suite amidships with an en-suite bathroom and a walk-in wardrobe; a forward VIP cabin, also with its own en-suite and walk-in wardrobe; a twin guest cabin with side-by-side single beds and a private bathroom; and a twin guest cabin with bunk beds and a private bathroom. Every space is finished to elevate comfort while preserving the yacht's harmonious balance of volume, light, and flow.

Refit

In 2025, Light Blue completed a total refit that elevated her design, comfort, and mechanical reliability to the highest standards while preserving her iconic Sunseeker lines. Externally, a full wrap across the hull and superstructure delivers a fresh, contemporary aesthetic while shielding the original surface. Brand-new Flexiteek decking now spans all exterior areas, including the cockpit and swim platform, combining durability with a premium finish. All exterior sunpad cushions were replaced with custom-made loungers at the bow and aft to maximize comfort and visual impact, and a removable awning system with carbon-fiber poles creates a shaded retreat on the foredeck during the hottest hours. Internally, the salon ceiling was completely redesigned to improve brightness and acoustics and to instill a more refined, modern atmosphere; refreshed soft furnishings and interior detailing blend Sunseeker's original charm with updated elegance, while subtle upgrades across all guest areas

enhance comfort, style, and finish. Technically, the yacht benefited from a comprehensive mechanical overhaul: the main engines and generators received full service for optimal performance and reliability; hydraulic systems, air conditioning, water systems, and navigation electronics were thoroughly checked and serviced; and the engine room was fully cleaned, detailed, and repainted, presenting a professional, orderly technical space.
