Meticulously maintained with an exhaustive service history, BELLISSIMA stands out as one of the most pristine and carefully preserved convertible sportfish yachts in her class, offering the scale and conveniences of a large luxury motor yacht while delivering tournament-caliber fishing performance. The 82 Hatteras Convertible underwent a comprehensive refit in 2018, received new paint in 2019, and has continued to benefit from ongoing upgrades and professional servicing, ensuring she presents in exceptional mechanical and aesthetic condition.

Accommodations are generous and thoughtfully laid out, with four staterooms and five heads complemented by proper crew quarters. The full-beam owner's suite, forward VIP, and two additional guest cabins create a gracious private quarters arrangement, while a spacious salon, a gourmet galley, and a well-equipped pilothouse provide superb volume for extended cruising and refined entertaining. The flybridge is appointed for serious angling and comfort alike, crowned by a custom tuna tower with integrated teaser reel stations and comfortable bench seating, and the cockpit is purpose-built for sportfishing with teak decking, a Release Marine battle saddle, an integrated transom fish box, and a hot-and-cold freshwater shower. Propulsion is provided by twin 1,450 hp Detroit Diesel engines, and the yacht's seakeeping is enhanced by Naiad stabilizers and a bow thruster, combining to form a proven blue-water platform ready for both competitive fishing and luxurious offshore passagemaking.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Notable features

Designed for uncompromising offshore performance, the yacht is equipped with a custom tuna tower fitted with teaser reel stations that deliver elevated sightlines and enable rapid bait deployment, Naiad stabilizer fins that preserve composure in a seaway, and a bow thruster for precise handling in close quarters, while an onboard watermaker extends time away from the dock. A robust bow davit streamlines lifting and launching operations, and a Release battle saddle secures the cockpit to give anglers confidence during the most hard-fought encounters.

Recent servicing & upgrades

In 2026 the yacht completed an extensive programme of works to ensure top-tier performance and reliability: a major running gear overhaul addressed shafts, bearings and seals with precision alignment; both propellers were removed, fully reconditioned and dynamically balanced; the Naiad stabilisers were substantially rebuilt and serviced; fresh bottom paint was applied and Propspeed was laid on the running gear; rudder and shaft zincs were replaced; and nine underwater lights were installed. In 2024 two new rudders were fabricated and installed, with accompanying servicing of the rudder bearings and the steering system. In 2022 the batteries were replaced. In 2019 she received an Awlgrip paint finish and was fitted with two 250V/100A Glendinning Cablemasters.

Salon

Step aboard to an elegant living area crafted for both tranquil relaxation and

lively entertaining; a 55-inch Samsung TV is paired with a Blu-ray player and a premium stereo system with speakers to deliver a fully immersive media environment. The wet bar features a U-Line wine refrigerator and dedicated stemware storage so refreshments are always within reach, while the Marine Power entrance door, fitted in 2022, provides a refined, modern entry. Plush seating—including a generous U-shaped sofa, an inviting ottoman and two chairs—is arranged to encourage effortless conversation and ultimate comfort whether underway or at anchor.

Pilothouse

Crafted for unhurried passages and seamless entertaining, the pilothouse welcomes guests with an inviting settee and companion couch positioned beneath overheads replaced in 2020. A carefully appointed wet bar with a U-Line refrigerator keeps refreshments close at hand, while a 27-inch Samsung television anchors the entertainment suite, supported by a Marantz NR1508 stereo, a Sony Blu-ray player and integrated speakers. Generous, unobtrusive storage is found throughout, allowing every essential to be stowed neatly without interrupting the clean, contemporary ambiance.

Galley

The galley is a study in refined functionality, marrying premium finishes with household-grade appliances to deliver a sophisticated culinary environment. Smooth Corian countertops line the workspace and frame a General Electric four-burner stove with oven, while a full-size KitchenAid side-by-side refrigerator—complete with water and ice dispensed from the door—sits alongside an auxiliary ice maker discreetly installed within the freezer. Polished stainless steel sinks provide a durable prep and cleanup station, which is further eased by a KitchenAid dishwasher, and a KitchenAid trash compactor

keeps refuse out of sight. A KitchenAid microwave offers swift reheating and convenience for gourmet shortcuts, and a comfortable settee creates a relaxed nook for dining or conversation. Intelligent storage solutions keep provisions and cookware organized, entertainment is within view on an eighteen-inch Insignia flatscreen TV, and a conveniently placed day head serves the galley and the nearby social areas.

Master cabin

The master cabin is a tranquil, full-beam sanctuary centered on a spacious berth, where onboard entertainment is elevated by a 55-inch Samsung TV, a Sony Blu-ray player and a Marantz NR1608 stereo system for truly enveloping sound. Clothes and personal effects are kept immaculate in cedar-lined walk-in wardrobe closets, with abundant storage distributed throughout the cabin to maintain a clean, uncluttered ambiance. Completing the suite is a private ensuite head featuring both a bathtub and a separate shower, delivering a refined, spa-like retreat on board.

Forward guest cabin

The forward guest cabin has been meticulously curated to soothe and pamper, featuring a Samsung eighteen-inch television complemented by integrated speakers and a Clarion DRX6175 AM/FM/CD stereo for effortless, refined entertainment. Ingeniously arranged storage throughout ensures personal effects remain discreetly tucked away, while the ensuite head with a walk-in shower offers private, spa-like comfort aboard.

Port guest cabin

A tranquil sanctuary for guests, the port cabin is equipped with an

eighteen-inch Samsung television paired with a Clarion DRX6175 AM/FM radio stereo to deliver refined onboard entertainment. The adjoining ensuite head boasts a walk-in shower, while abundant storage woven throughout the cabin ensures lasting comfort and effortless organization.

Starboard guest cabin

Carefully designed for comfort and ease, the starboard guest cabin is equipped with an 18-inch Samsung television and a Fusion NRX300 stereo control for seamless entertainment, while a private ensuite head with a walk-in shower offers personal luxury; integrated storage throughout keeps belongings neatly concealed, maintaining a tranquil and refined atmosphere.

Flybridge area

Panoramic sightlines and meticulous craftsmanship define the flybridge, which is crowned by a custom aluminum tuna tower. The area is anchored by a refined helm station and complemented by a comfortable bench on the flybridge aft deck with discreet storage beneath, refreshed with new cushions and protective covers. Overhead on the aft deck, two Penn 345 GTI electric teaser reels stand ready for action, while a stereo system with four speakers bathes the space in rich, immersive sound. An Axis 360 camera mounted beneath the hardtop further enhances visibility and situational awareness.

Foredeck

Purpose-built spray rails running along the port and starboard edges of the bow deflect oncoming seas and preserve a dry working area, while high-output floodlights wash the foredeck in crisp illumination so operations after nightfall are undertaken with complete confidence. Underfoot, a heavy-duty nonskid

surface offers sure footing in every condition, and the deck is fitted with twin jet ski cradles, a dedicated tender cradle and a robust davit to make launch and recovery seamless and efficient.

Cockpit

Beneath a foundation of teak covering boards and sumptuous teak decking, the cockpit is arranged for both serious sportfishing and refined entertaining: a Release battle saddle is affixed to an offset pedestal to place the angler in command, while an integrated transom fish box and a separate flush-deck fish box with macerator pump handle the day's catch with ease, supported by an ice chipper in the fishbox to ensure optimal preservation. Powerful floodlights brighten the working surfaces, and an overhead canopy supported by substantial stanchion poles provides gracious shelter from the sun. Tackle remains tidy in a dedicated rod storage locker on the aft deck, and a pedestal table with seating—appointed with new chairs and cushions—transforms the area from tournament platform to al fresco lounge in an instant. Practical luxuries include a hot-and-cold freshwater shower for quick rinses, custom teak finishing in the transom for a handcrafted look, and a docking station with throttle controls to simplify precise close-quarters maneuvering.

Machinery

Twin Detroit Diesel 16V-92TA engines provide the vessel's propulsion, each rated at 1,450 HP and displaying 4,661 and 4,669 hours respectively, while Naiad stabilizers and a bow thruster ensure composed seakeeping and precise maneuvering in tight quarters. Steering is hydraulic with trim tabs for refined helm response, and systems designed for long-range reliability include a dedicated fuel transfer arrangement, dual Racor fuel filters and a lube oil storage tank. Routine maintenance is simplified by an integrated oil change

system servicing engines, generators and transmissions, supported by an engine room ventilation scheme and continuous oversight from the Hatteras Systems Monitor. Guest comfort and independence are assured by a central air conditioning and chiller installation, a hot water system and a capable watermaker, and vessel safety and electrical resilience are addressed by an automatic fire suppression system, a robust 24V DC electrical network and shore power transformers for effortless dockside connection.

Navigation & communication

The helm is luxuriously appointed to inspire confidence at sea, centered around both three-inch and six-inch Ritchie compasses and an advanced Garmin electronics suite that provides GPS, chartplotter, speed log, distance log, radar and depthsounder functionality; long passages are kept unwavering by a Simrad autopilot. Voice and data communications are managed through an ICOM VHF, while freshwater and fuel tank gauges together with the dedicated Hatteras systems monitor panel present all vital system information at a glance. For entertainment and extended connectivity there is SAT TV with antenna, and safety equipment is enhanced by a high-output spotlight and a reliable horn for clear signaling.
