OVERVIEW

Pearl Yachts has re-envisioned this category with the Pearl 82, a refined 25 metre raised pilothouse motor yacht that introduces levels of innovation rarely encountered at this scale. The layout provides five en suite staterooms, centred around an on deck owner's suite, while a spacious tender garage houses a RIB, a jet ski and a generous assortment of water toys. A Riviera style aft deck is designed to maximise open air lounging and dining, and the flybridge configuration underscores her dual identity as both a superyacht and a luxurious long range cruiser. Naval architecture and exterior styling by Bill Dixon of Dixon Yacht Design confer elegant lines, efficient performance and assured seakeeping, marrying dynamic capability with serene comfort. Step aboard to find contemporary refinement, intelligent spatial solutions and the effortless poise of a true bluewater yacht.

Main features

A raised pilothouse design anchors a full beam main deck master stateroom, complemented by five beautifully appointed en suite staterooms plus dedicated crew accommodation, offering an intuitive layout that privileges privacy and conviviality. Enjoy direct access from the main deck master to the forepeak terrace and the effortless flow of a Riviera aft deck layout, while a large garage accommodates a Williams 345 jet tender, a Sea Doo Spark and a SeaBob, and a foredeck lounge with generous sun pads, seating and a table invites relaxed days at anchor. There is direct access from the flybridge to this foredeck lounge, and the extended flybridge itself offers a full sized dining table, a multi functional wet bar and expansive sun pads beneath a hardtop

with a tilt and slide sunroof. The indulgent interior is by renowned British design star Kelly Hoppen CBE, with naval architecture and exterior design by Bill Dixon of Dixon Yacht Design, and confidence is underwritten by a comprehensive five year warranty.

Interior features

The main deck arrangement features an open galley flowing into the salon and dinette, set off by elegant wood flooring to create a warm, cohesive living space. In the raised pilothouse, upper and side windscreen blinds ensure comfort and control, while both port and starboard guest cabins offer powered sliding berths that convert from twin singles to a double, with additional fold down Pullman bunks neatly integrated into the bulkheads. The master cabin benefits from a below deck storage compartment, and the ambience is elevated by Kelly Hoppen collection interior accessories, artwork and scatter cushions, finished with a refined patio door curtain.

Deck and hull

A sleek hardtop with a tilt and slide opening sunroof crowns the yacht, complemented by an electrically operated stern sun awning integrated into the hardtop, while the flybridge features a hot tub with a sunpad and storage and the foredeck offers a Bedouin style bimini with telescopic carbon fibre poles that shades a table with an electrically operated leg. Practicality meets panache with fold down side wings to the cockpit, a semi electric pantograph door to the starboard side deck, and a comprehensive garage tender and jet ski recovery package including launch recovery system, winches and controls. Teak is fitted to the flybridge, side decks and forepeak, with cockpit side boarding gates and a full set of external covers in Cadet Grey. Additional hull rub rails to port and starboard enhance protection, Sleipner Vector 1450 fin

stabilizers elevate comfort, an Ultramarine 100kg stainless steel anchor underscores capability, and an In Port Water connection adds shore side convenience.

Navigation

Command with confidence thanks to a Garmin Fantom Open Radar scanner, a Garmin 8416 MFD display and an additional Garmin VHF 315i located inside the crew cabin mess, while the raised pilothouse houses three Garmin GPS MAP 8422 MFD displays and the flybridge helm station carries two Garmin GPS MAP 8422 MFD displays; a Garmin AIS 800 with a Garmin GPS GA38 antenna completes a robust, integrated suite designed for precision and situational awareness.

Audio visual

Entertainment is elevated by an upgraded 65" salon TV, with the deck salon gaining an additional pair of flush mount speakers and a subwoofer, while the lower deck forward guest cabin features a 27" TV linked to two pairs of flush fit speakers and a soundbar. The main deck master and the lower deck aft guest cabin are equipped with Fusion Apollo head units, a subwoofer and ceiling speakers, and exterior AV is enhanced by an additional pair of flybridge speakers, a Fusion ERX400 aft cockpit control and foredeck speakers with a Fusion remote control. The crew enjoy Smart TVs in the Captain's Cabin and the Crew Pullman Cabin, connectivity is powered by an onboard Pepwave MAX PRO BR1 5G WIFI router, and the flybridge TV rises and falls on a lift mechanism. Wireless phone chargers are fitted at both upper and lower helms, and a Starlink wiring pull cable is installed from the flybridge hardtop to the salon AV cabinet.

Electrical

Power and convenience abound with US 110v sockets and a Side Power 13 hp stern thruster, complemented by upgraded hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, while boarding is effortless via an Opacmare hydraulic passerelle and the stainless steel patio door is upgraded to an electrically operated door. Shore power handling is strengthened by two Glendenning Cable Master units rated at 100 amps each and an upgrade to a Boost Isolation Transformer. Docking assistance includes Lewmar C3 stern winches, low level LED strip lights fitted to the side decks, four underwater lights and rear docking lights, while security is enhanced by four CCTV cameras. Comfort is elevated with electrically operated blinds throughout, plumbing and wiring prepared for the future fitment of a water maker, a Miele separate washing machine and condensing dryer located in the lower deck lobby, an icemaker on the flybridge, an aft cockpit wetbar with coolbox and icemaker, and a Vitrofrigio C130 LX crew cabin fridge.

Mechanical

Climate control is formidable with tropical air conditioning upgraded to 180,000 BTU, suitable for ambient temperatures up to 40 degrees Celsius, and five AC vents fitted to the guest ensuites, while underway comfort is assured by Sleipner Vector 1450 fin stabilizers and maintenance is simplified by an oil change system.

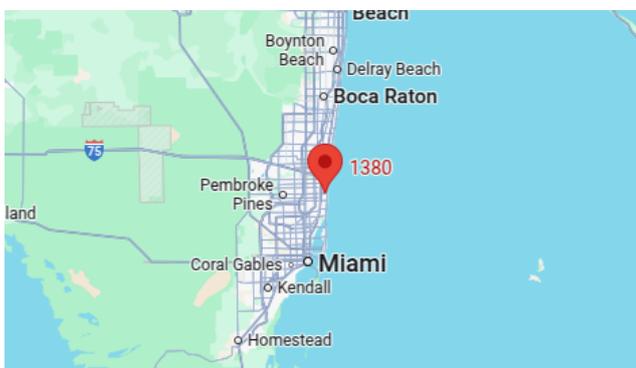
