DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2003 Sunseeker 82 yacht

The 82' Sunseeker welcomes up to eight guests across four beautifully appointed staterooms, anchored by an expansive full beam Master Grand Suite aft and a gracious VIP stateroom forward, with two further guest cabins—one with twin berths and the other arranged with bunk beds—each finished for comfort and style. Every cabin is fitted to an exceptional standard with rich cherry wood veneers, cream carpeting, abundant storage and en suite facilities where specified; the starboard guest cabin benefits from its own en suite while the port guest cabin has convenient shared head access. Discreetly positioned aft, dedicated crew quarters with two cabins ensure privacy and seamless service, and the interior helm features a fully electric seat upholstered in premium white leather, underscoring the yacht's purposeful sophistication. Throughout the interior, high gloss cherry wood finishes, cream leather upholstery and neutral tones create a warm, contemporary atmosphere of understated luxury.

On deck, full teak decking runs from bow to stern and wide side decks make movement safe and effortless, while the forward lounge with a bench and a generous sunpad invites daytime relaxation and evening sunsets. The expansive flybridge is designed for effortless entertaining, equipped with a BBQ, a wet bar and a large dining area, plus a secondary helm station with remote engine and thruster controls that provides commanding visibility and precise handling for confident docking and close quarters maneuvering.

The main salon exudes timeless elegance with plush seating, a coffee table and a formal dining area for eight, all served by full air conditioning and large side windows with blinds to modulate light and privacy. A dedicated drinks cabinet houses glassware for eight, stainless steel

framed sliding glass doors open to the aft cockpit, and halogen lighting with double AC sockets is thoughtfully distributed throughout. An integrated entertainment system and telephone points complete the salon's refined amenities.

Purpose built for extended cruising, the well equipped galley offers refrigerator and freezer capacity, an AC ice maker and the option for an American style fridge/freezer combo for increased cold storage. Culinary preparation is effortless on the four ring ceramic hob, supported by a microwave/oven and dishwasher for easy service and cleanup, with a stainless steel sink supplying hot and cold water and abundant storage in cupboards, drawers and slide out racks. Fire safety equipment and a first aid kit are sited for quick access.

The Master Grand Suite spans the full beam aft as a private sanctuary with a king size berth and storage beneath, a walk in wardrobe, dressing table and settee, all climate controlled and softly lit for relaxation; a 42 inch flat screen TV with surround sound elevates in cabin entertainment. Its private en suite is appointed with a granite vanity, twin basins, a large shower and a Tecma toilet. Forward, the VIP stateroom features a queen berth with under bed storage, a dressing table and wardrobe, air conditioning, an entertainment system and a private en suite head with shower. The starboard guest cabin offers twin berths and its own en suite, while the port guest cabin provides twin bunks with shared head access; both guest cabins include air conditioning, reading lights, wardrobes and premium finishes.

Aft and

separate for discretion, the crew area includes two cabins—a twin and a single—a shared head with shower, useful storage and air conditioning to ensure professional, unobtrusive service on every voyage.

Performance and

reliability are delivered by twin Caterpillar C30 engines rated at 1,550 HP each and showing approximately 3,100 hours, turning five blade bronze propellers on stainless steel shafts. Maneuverability is enhanced by 30 HP hydraulic bow

and stern thrusters and hydraulic trim tabs, while automatic fire suppression and bilge systems provide confident safety underway. Electrical power at anchor and underway is supported by two 23 kW Kohler generators with approximately 4,100 and 4,400 hours respectively.

Electrical and navigation

systems are comprehensive, with 24V and 12V DC systems protected by full circuit protection, battery chargers, immersion heaters and AC sockets distributed throughout. Dual helm stations are equipped with radar and chartplotter, autopilot, depth and speed displays, VHF radio and a compass, complemented by hydraulic power steering, trim tab controls and full analog engine instrumentation for precise, intuitive command.

Elevating the

onboard aesthetic, high gloss cherry wood cabinetry, cream carpeting and leather upholstery are paired with polished granite countertops and flooring in the heads, while elegant lighting throughout completes a yacht whose design, equipment and craftsmanship exemplify Sunseeker's signature blend of performance and poise.
