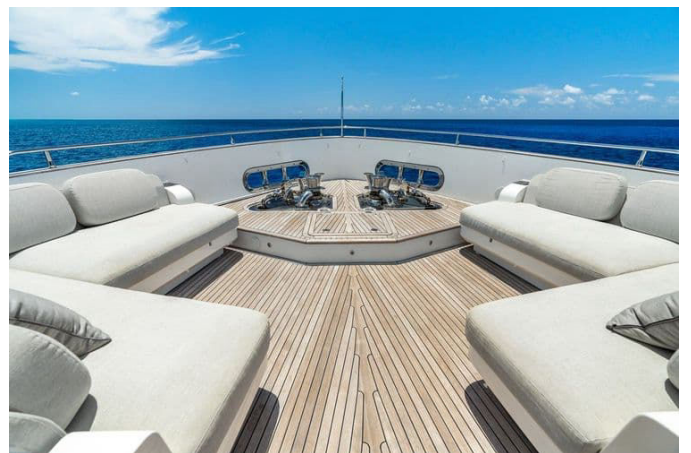

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodation

Designed to host nine guests in four serene cabins, the accommodation plan harmonizes privacy, versatility, and refined detail to create an onboard experience that feels like a private residence at sea. Amidships, the full-beam master suite is a sanctuary with a king-size bed featuring foldaway storage, a generous walk-in wardrobe, a vanity and private sitting area, and a sumptuous ensuite finished in marble with a spacious shower, dual washbasins in Marfil Creme marble, and separate toilet and shower enclosures. Forward, the VIP cabin is nearly as expansive as the owner's, presenting a transversal double that is effectively a queen-size bed, abundant storage, and a well-appointed ensuite. Between these suites sit two additional guest cabins: one to starboard with two single beds and thoughtful storage, the other to port with a crosswise double, both cabins configured so their twin beds convert into doubles to suit families or friends, and one guest cabin adding a discreet Pullman bed that folds down from the wall when required. Each guest cabin has its own private head with modern amenities, LED lighting, and individual air-conditioning control, and in total there are five guest bathrooms plus a dedicated crew bathroom, ensuring seamless comfort throughout. Life onboard flows effortlessly between elegant indoor spaces and inviting open-air decks; the aft deck is crafted for relaxed alfresco living with a built-in sofa, additional chairs, and a large teak dining table set over rich teak flooring, while an innovative beach club integrated into the transom serves as a versatile lounge and watersports staging area, complemented by a hydraulic swim platform that simplifies launching and retrieving water toys and forms a safe, stable platform at sea level. Above, the flybridge becomes the social heart of the yacht, a generously scaled entertaining zone with a bar, dining table, and sun loungers

protected by an automated louvered opening hard top that modulates sunshine and breeze with effortless precision. Inside, the main salon welcomes with sweeping panoramic windows and a curated blend of freestanding and built-in furniture—an expansive sofa, armchairs, and a refined coffee table—anchored by an entertainment center featuring a hidden TV on a lift system and a high-quality audio suite, while the forward formal dining area seats up to eight guests, glowing with natural light accented by integrated LED illumination to create a warm, convivial setting at any hour. The saloon and dining room’s full-beam sensibility is enhanced by an inviting L-shaped sofa, lacquered ceiling panels punctuated by LED spotlights, and a convenient day toilet with a marble top and mixer tap, bringing the grace of a private residence to sea. The galley is both stylish and practical, fully equipped with high-end appliances, ample storage and a highly functional layout for effortless service, and crew operations remain discreet thanks to a separate crew entrance and well-conceived crew quarters that include two crew cabins accommodating up to four crew members—comprising a captain’s cabin with two bunk beds and a crew cabin with two bunk beds—plus a shared head with washbasin, toilet, and shower, washing and drying machine and dedicated storage, while depending on service configuration the crew area may also be described as providing accommodation for up to three crew via the separate access, preserving total guest privacy without compromise.

Navigation and electronics

At the helm, state-of-the-art Raymarine navigation empowers confident passage-making with crisp multi-function displays, precise autopilot, powerful radar, and AIS for traffic awareness, all integrated into a yachtwide control environment that makes lighting, climate, and entertainment adjustments intuitive and effortless, so the captain commands situational awareness while routine comforts remain at fingertip control.

Key features

Crafted to US specifications, this yacht blends ocean-going poise with global versatility, highlighted by Starlink satellite internet for always-on connectivity and an Asea Converter (220V/110V – 50HZ/60HZ) that ensures seamless power compatibility worldwide. Safety and comfort are elevated by a smoke detection system, stabilizing fins that quell roll, and a responsive stern thruster for precision close-quarters handling. Long autonomy is assured by a watermaker rated at 180 L/H – 39.6 GAL/H, while lifestyle luxuries abound in the removable sunshade with carbon fiber poles aft on the flybridge, an American bar on the flybridge with two Batyline fabric stools, and an automated louvered opening hard top that modulates shade at a touch. The beach club invites you to the water's edge, complemented by a bow sun shade with removable carbon fiber poles, a co-pilot seat on the flybridge for shared navigation, and exterior dimmer lights in the cockpit and on the flybridge to set the perfect mood. Practical excellence includes a tender hauling and launching system, teak flooring on the bow, flybridge and garage areas, and an additional bed in the captain's cabin for flexible crewing. Interior refinement features a galley top in Black Lapitec, a king-size bed in the master cabin with a dedicated safe, mirrors on the lower deck to amplify light, and elegant wood flooring through the salon and dining area, while entertainment is equally considered with an audio/video package culminating in a Hi-Lo TV system on the flybridge for cinematic evenings under the stars.

Standard features

Everyday excellence is built in: access to the flybridge is effortless via external spiral steps and an internal companionway; underfoot, GRP flybridge flooring with an anti-slip coating adds surefooted confidence. Entertaining flows naturally with a flybridge bar complete with sink, fridge, and waste bin, and a

dining area arranged around a comfortable C-shaped sofa with a fixed teak table. Forward on deck, a well-designed chain locker with a central hatch and drainage is paired with dedicated fender storage and a chain washing system, while teak flooring enriches both bow and cockpit areas. The cockpit itself offers longitudinal seating with a fixed teak dining table and a bar cabinet with sink, fridge, and storage, all served by LED lighting and protected by efficient scuppers, and technical access and safety are assured by a watertight engine room door and an extendable gangway system with electro-hydraulic control, simplifying boarding in varied conditions.

Platform and garage

The water's edge is engineered for pleasure and practicality alike: access is via robust GRP stairways with teak steps leading down to the sea, a pivoting garage door conceals a dedicated hauling and launching system for the tender, a telescopic manual swimming ladder and an external shower head make post-swim rituals effortless, and a thoughtfully positioned service compartment with a foldaway ladder keeps technical needs tidy and close at hand.

Additional systems

Robust infrastructure underpins quiet luxury: dual Kohler generators, rated 21 kW USA and showing 4029/4000 hours, provide resilient power; comprehensive battery management and charging systems keep energy delivery optimized; and Raymarine navigation instruments with autopilot dovetail with the helm for precise passages. Vigilant bilge and fire extinguishing systems stand ready, while fuel and water systems with large-capacity tanks extend range. Climate is individually tuned by air conditioning with independent controls in each area, and multi-zone

audio/video systems by FUSION, with speakers distributed across key spaces, envelop guests in rich, customizable sound.
