The distinguished SL82 range, celebrated over a twenty-year production life from 1995 to 2015, concluded when the SL86 made its debut at the Düsseldorf International Boat Show in 2015; what was once a widely admired model has become increasingly rare, heightening its appeal. As the only SL82 presently offered in the Americas, LOSAND represents an uncommon chance to purchase a pedigreed flybridge cruiser from a shipyard renowned for sumptuous finishes, innovative thinking, meticulous craftsmanship and longstanding yachting credentials—without commanding the price of a brand-new flagship. For owners who demand true bluewater capability, spirited performance cruising and timeless elegance on a proven luxury platform, LOSAND is an exceptional proposition.

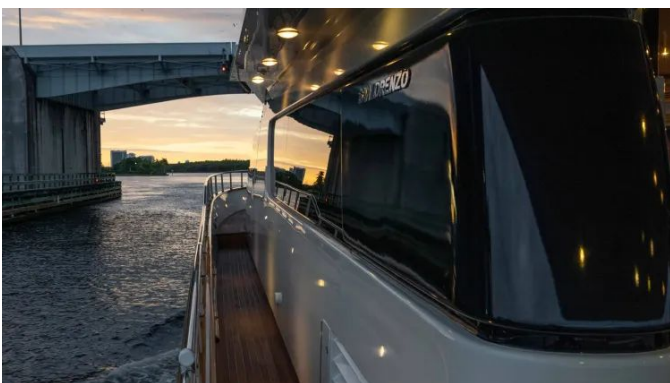

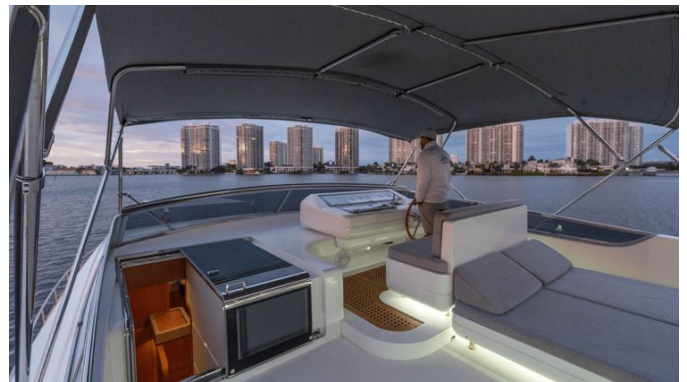
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Technical details

Launched by Sanlorenzo in 2005, this GRP deep V planing yacht stretches 82' / 23.95 m overall, with a beam of 20'2" / 6.18 m and a draft of 6'8" / 2.08 m, and carries a gross tonnage of 68 GT. Naval architecture is by Sanlorenzo, the exterior lines were penned by Architect Della Role in partnership with Sanlorenzo, and the interior was conceived by Franco and Anna Della Role. The yacht's topsides are finished in Awlgrip Kingston Grey, and propulsion is provided by twin Caterpillar C32 ACERT main engines capable of a 30 knot top speed at one third load, a 25 knot cruising speed and an economical 18 knot passage speed. Guest accommodation consists of four staterooms for eight guests, complemented by a single crew cabin for three and four heads. Tankage includes 2,113 gallons / 8,000 liters of fuel, 449 gallons / 1,700 liters of fresh water and 105 gallons / 400 liters of black water capacity.

Mechanical equipment

The engine room pairs commanding performance with meticulous engineering: twin Caterpillar C32 ACERT engines are mated to twin ZF BW 2060V gearboxes to deliver assured, responsive propulsion, while hydraulic bow and stern thrusters make dockside and tight turn handling effortless. Electrical resilience is provided by two Kohler 20 kW generators working alongside a Glendinning shore power system to supply a distribution network configured for 12V, 24V and 230 AC. Charging is overseen by three Mastervolt 100 A/24 V chargers supplemented by an additional 50 A/24 V unit, and a Charles ISOBoost 100 power/isolation transformer guarantees clean, stable current. Guest comfort and onboard self sufficiency are equally prioritized with Dometic Cruisair air conditioning rated at 180,000 BTU/h, an Idromar MC

water maker, and a TECMA electric toilet system with bidet.

Navigation equipment

At the helm, a pair of Garmin sixteen-inch touchscreen multifunction displays forms the central command, paired with two CAT digital MFDs that deliver detailed engine and navigation information. ZF throttle control and BCS bow and stern thruster management provide precise handling for close-quarters maneuvers, while a SIMRAD AP26 autopilot ensures a steady, reliable course. Positioning and charting are handled by the SIMRAD CX54 GPS, and situational awareness is enhanced by the SIMRAD IS15 wind instrument and depth sounder. For traditional redundancy, a six-inch White Star compass is fitted, accompanied by a dedicated rudder indicator and a trim tab level indicator for immediate, accurate feedback.

Communication equipment

Onboard communications are entrusted to a Garmin GHS20 VHF, delivering dependable voice connectivity, while a CAMOS CCTV-Monitor provides clear visual oversight to elevate situational awareness throughout the yacht.

Deck equipment

The foredeck has been meticulously arranged to ensure dependable anchoring and effortless operation, outfitted with a pair of Lofrans windlasses rated 2000W/24V each and equipped with integrated capstans, alongside a pair of 105 kg HHP galvanized anchors. The anchoring system is supported by 100 meters of 12 mm chain, delivering substantial holding power and smooth, controlled retrieval. Water access is finished with understated elegance and practicality, featuring stainless steel swimming ladders complemented by a

Marquipt aluminum boarding ladder.

Entertainment equipment

Throughout the general and living areas, a Bang & Olufsen Surround Sound System is integrated with a Fusion AV System and a Denon Receiver to produce richly detailed, refined audio; a Direct TV HD Receiver delivers high-definition programming to a crisp 47-inch Samsung TV, and a Samsung DVD player together with a Sony Compact Disc Player complete the ensemble, ensuring seamless enjoyment of both modern broadcasts and classic media.

Galley & laundry equipment

The galley is a refined, professional-grade workspace centered on a Miele four-burner induction/electric cook top that pairs seamlessly with a Bosch convection, self-cleaning oven, while a Bosch microwave handles swift reheating and a Bosch warming drawer keeps dishes at perfect serving temperature; cold provisions are stored in a spacious Fisher & Paykel double-door refrigerator/freezer, and post-service cleanup is made effortless by a Fisher & Paykel stainless steel two-drawer dishwasher alongside a stainless steel basin sink. For longer passages, a dedicated laundry suite with one Bosch Axxis washing machine and one Bosch Axxis dryer ensures linens and wardrobes remain impeccably maintained aboard.

Security and safety equipment

Safety onboard is thorough: a EUROVINIL liferaft rated for eight passengers and fitted with a hydrostatic release is carried together with a USCG ring buoy, six Type I portable fire extinguishers, and an ACR Global Fix Pro 406 MHz EPIRB, offering fully compliant, confidence-inspiring protection for both

nearshore and offshore cruising.

Tender

The AB tender glides to shore with poise and dependability, its nimble hull propelled by a Yamaha outboard engine delivering forty horsepower to provide assured, responsive handling on every transfer.

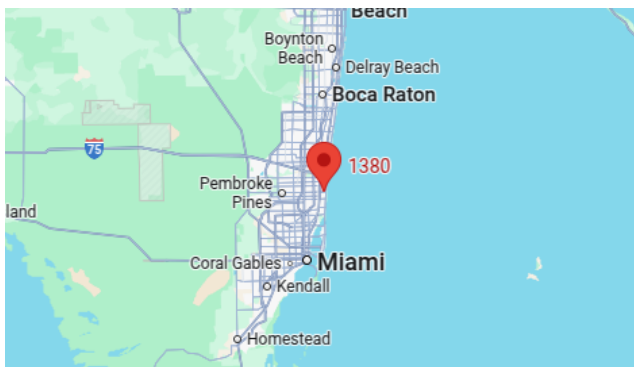
