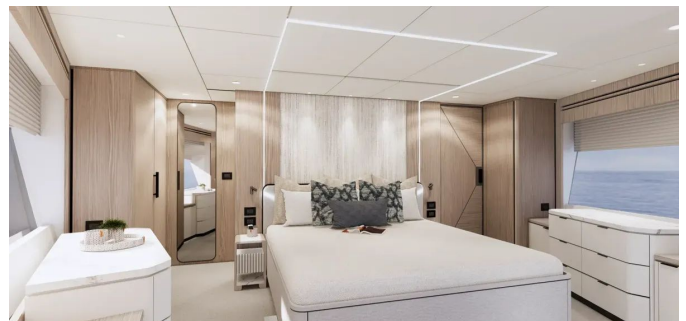

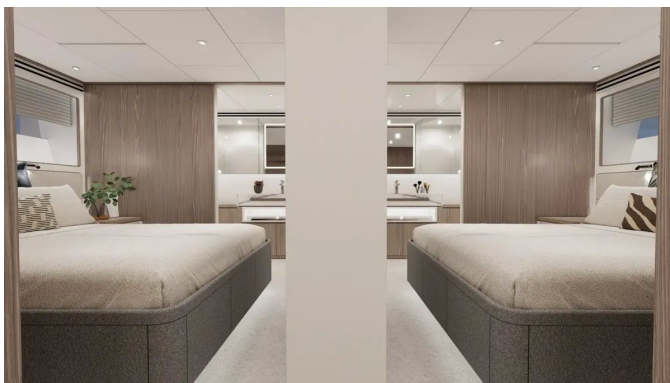

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Quick specifications

Designed for effortless passage-making and sumptuous onboard living, this yacht artfully marries a flexible cockpit layout with a fold-down swim platform and a crow's nest that houses a compact helm station, delivering commanding visibility. Interior accommodations encompass four well-appointed staterooms, highlighted by a full-beam on-deck master suite, while an enclosed skylounge incorporating the main pilot console provides a tranquil command environment in any weather. The boat deck is arranged for relaxed entertaining with a loose L-shaped sofa set and coffee table, augmented by a Hi-Lo propane BBQ for leisurely alfresco dining. Propulsive and handling excellence come from high-performance S-class five-blade propellers, Side Power SPS93/VF1650 stabilizers and Side Power SH550 bow and stern thrusters. Tender operations are simplified by a Steelhead davit ES2500 (1130 kg/2,500 lb), extended autonomy is provided by Spot Zero fully automatic watermakers, and a comprehensive Maretron monitoring system supervises onboard systems.

Hull and main structure

A pristine white gel coat crowns a single-piece hull and superstructure, crafted with the licensed SCRIMP™ process and further enhanced by Horizon's patented 6D infusion to seamlessly integrate both longitudinal and transverse stringers. The hull, deck and superstructure employ this advanced SCRIMP™ technique to achieve superior strength while minimizing weight, and the hull's hybrid-design bottom pairs sandwich construction with solid fiberglass to deliver exceptional rigidity and impact resilience. High-density Divinycell or an equivalent foam core reinforces the hull sides, decks and superstructure, with

the stringers themselves cored in high-density foam, and all interior structural elements are precisely bonded to the hull with a robust collision bulkhead adding an extra layer of protection. Below the waterline the laminate is safeguarded by an international-brand antifouling bottom paint combined with anti-osmosis treatment, while underwater appendages receive PropSpeed/PropGold metal paint; performance and fuel efficiency are enhanced by draft-reducing tunnels and a High-Performance Piercing Bow (HPPB) protected with stainless steel plates, and the upper deck is elegantly developed with bump-out sections on both the port and starboard sides.

Foredeck and aft deck

The deck layout marries refined relaxation with serious seafaring capability, beginning with a formidable ground-tackle arrangement of two ACCO 300 ft high-tensile 1/2-inch anchor chains paired with two 90 kg stainless steel anchors and operated by two Maxwell VWC 3500 windlasses. Deck handling is further assisted by a single Maxwell VC2500 electrical rope capstan on the bow deck and two Maxwell VC2500 electrical rope capstans on the aft deck, while a manual freshwater and seawater anchor chain washdown system and two chain counters located in the pilothouse guarantee accurate, dependable control. Frameless glazing enhances the yacht's clean silhouette and onboard comfort, featuring a windshield in slightly tinted tempered laminated Low E glass and side windows in tinted tempered laminated glass.

Access to the foredeck is provided via a starboard staircase and the main-deck walkaround, where guests are welcomed by built-in U-shaped seating with sliding tables, a generous sunpad cushion equipped with cup holders and two pop-up lights, and optional sunshades for the bow seating as per layout, creating an inviting open-air lounge. A beautifully finished teak aft deck encourages effortless entertaining and circulation, with two aft deck bulwark side doors for boarding, a wind door on each side of the aft deck opening onto

the side walkways, a MarQuipt seven step side boarding sea stair and a 43 inch electric flip down TV for alfresco enjoyment.

Crow's nest

The crow's nest features a non-skid deck beneath a supportive helm bench and is elegantly surmounted by a radar arch fitted with an antenna bracket; access is effortless via an automatic carbon ladder paired with a sliding hatch. The compact helm station is exquisitely appointed with a stainless-steel steering wheel set into a carbon-fiber dashboard panel, comprehensive engine controls with start/stop capability and dedicated engine displays, and an MFD 9213 thirteen-inch display. Navigation and systems include autopilot, a Marin Instrument repeater and VHF handsets, while precise maneuvering is provided by dedicated bow and stern thruster controls. A magnetic compass, air horn button and a convenient cup holder complete the ensemble.

Cockpit

The teak-clad cockpit and swim platform present a refined, non-skid surface for onboard activity, with generous storage lockers tucked beneath the cockpit sole to keep gear discreetly stowed. Two transom doors integrated into the aft coaming allow effortless boarding and access, while a convertible, fold-down transom swim platform instantly expands the waterline playground. Anglers will appreciate eight rotating fishing rod holders and two Hubbell outlets positioned for seamless rigging and dependable power, and an Eskimo fishbox ice system keeps the catch impeccably chilled as an illuminated bait tank sustains live bait well into the evening.

Skylounge and boat deck

The enclosed skylounge centers on a forward helm station equipped with two helm chairs, while aft an L-shaped settee and a convenient day head provide comfortable accommodation for guests. Entertainment is effortless with a 43-inch electrically operated fold-up TV, and a bespoke two-tier bar—complete with three bar stools, sink, refrigerator and ice maker—creates an elegant focal point for socialising. The custom helm is appointed with a comprehensive array of engine gauges, dedicated monitoring for vital systems, fuel and water indicators, a Riviera ASTRA magnetic compass, an integrated surveillance camera system, a bilge pump control panel and navigational lights to ensure assured operation in any conditions. On the boat deck a hydraulic Steelhead davit ES2500 (1130 kg / 2,500 lb) handles tender operations with authority, while the upper deck offers open-air relaxation with L-shaped seating and a wet bar with sink, complemented by a chest freezer, a 24-inch Hi-Lo propane BBQ and generous storage.

Engine & propulsion details

Propulsion is provided by twin CAT C32A engines, each rated at 1,600 hp, channeling robust power to high performance S class 5 blade propellers mounted on bronze struts with backing plates for enduring strength and efficiency. Shaft and rudder packing glands are protected with Tides Marine dripless seals or equivalent, ensuring clean, reliable operation, while engine monitoring is maintained by an engine alarm system built to engine standard. Precise motion and comfort underway are delivered through Side Power SPS93/VF1650 stabilizers in combination with a Side Power SH550 bow thruster and SH550 stern thruster, augmented by a Zipwake interceptor system for fine trim control and a Hydrive marine power steering system that produces effortless, responsive handling. Engine loads are isolated by flexible

mountings affixed to a stainless steel engine bed securely bonded to the FRP hull girder, and exhaust is routed via an underwater arrangement fitted with bypass mufflers and anti noise treatment to preserve a refined, low sound cruising experience. Maneuvering flexibility is extended by a tethered remote handheld controller for throttles, gears and thrusters with convenient plug in connections in both the cockpit and pilothouse, allowing fingertip control from either station. The engine room is specified for easy upkeep and safety, featuring Delta T demisters, an onboard air compressor, a lightweight access floor, a heavy duty insulated engine room door, and stainless steel overhead grab rails on each side of the engine to support serviceability and secure movement.

Electrical systems

Designed with an emphasis on safety and dependability, the electrical fit-out incorporates GFI protection on all AC outlets in the exterior living areas, heads, galley and engine room. A full electrolysis bonding network and cathodic protection system, equipped with zinc anodes, provides continuous defense for shafts, struts and related underwater hardware. Lighting throughout the yacht is handled by a comprehensive LED system that illuminates interior and exterior spaces, augmented by six underwater lights and two high-intensity LED search lights. Onboard power is delivered by two Kohler 40kW (60Hz) generators fitted with sound shields, all coordinated through a Maretron monitoring and control platform. Shore power arrangements are equally robust, featuring two 100A boost polarization transformers, two 100A Cable masters and two 100A shore power plugs with bow inlets. Additional thoughtful provisions include pre-wiring for an illuminated LED boat name on the stern and on both port and starboard skylounge sides, together with pre-wiring for a wireless yacht controller.

Mechanical systems

Engineered for long-range cruising and absolute reliability, the yacht carries 2,700 US gallons of diesel in tanks fitted with sight gauges and electrical level monitoring, backed by two Racor 500 MA primary fuel filters—one dedicated to each generator—and two electric fuel transfer pumps, as well as a 210 GPH fuel polishing system to ensure fuel cleanliness and system integrity.

Freshwater needs are addressed by a 400 US gallon FRP tank, dual 20 US gallon water heaters, a high volume AC freshwater pressure pump with a DC backup, and a hot water circulation pump, while potable water production and purification are provided by a Spot Zero SeaXchange XTC II 1200 watermaker and a ZTC II 2000 water purifier, with charcoal filtration plumbed into the freshwater line at the shore water inlet and again at the galley for added peace of mind. Climate control is delivered through a Marine Air VARCX chilled water conditioning system, and system protection is enhanced by the ELECTRO SEA ElectroStrainer Pro.

Sanitation aboard is managed by a Tecma toilet arrangement tied to a 100 US gallon holding tank with a deck fitting for convenient dockside pump out and electric level indicators to monitor tank status, with grey water handled by a dedicated sump pump system and onboard treatment provided by a Headhunter sanitary unit. Safety and dependable operation are priorities throughout the vessel, with an electric bilge pump, high water bilge alarm, bilge exhaust ventilation fans, comprehensive engine room fire insulation and fire resistant sealing of pipe penetrations, plus an automatic fire damper system. Supplementing these fixed systems are four portable fire extinguishers and an integrated pilothouse fire alarm network, along with carbon monoxide and smoke detectors installed in every cabin.

Interior décor and equipment

Accommodation on board is arranged with a master stateroom situated on deck and three VIP staterooms located forward, to port and to starboard, each enjoying private en suite facilities, while the crew spaces have been intelligently planned to include a captain's cabin and a crew cabin, a head with shower and a private access route from the starboard side of the salon.

Household services are well provided for with a dedicated laundry room fitted with a washer/dryer, ironing board, sink and ample storage, complemented by an additional stacked washer/dryer in the crew quarters. A bespoke interior package enhances the vessel's décor and lighting throughout, and the galley is comprehensively equipped with a full Wedgwood GIO tableware service for ten—complete with a dish holder, pots and pans, dishes and plates, knives and forks, glasses and related items. An extra set of bed linens is supplied for every guest cabin and for the crew.

Salon

Step through a stainless steel manual sliding entrance door equipped with a self-locking mechanism into a salon where refined styling meets practical flexibility. A dayhead accessible by two doors adds a layer of convenience, while an L-shaped sofa paired with an armchair encircles a coffee table set upon a bespoke area rug, creating an intimate lounge. Behind the seating, a port-side buffet cabinet offers elegant storage, complemented by a convertible folding dining table with chairs configured to the chosen layout and a carefully integrated breakfast bar. Electric sheer shadings allow precise control of daylight and privacy, and onboard entertainment is discreetly available via a 55-inch TV that descends from the ceiling when required.

Galley

An enclosed galley appointed with a Hi Lo blind forms a refined, professional culinary center, with abundant storage configured to each layout's specifications. Cold provisions are exceptionally handled by full height Sub Zero refrigeration—both freezer and refrigerator—while a dedicated Sub Zero wine cooler keeps bottles at their optimal temperature. Meal preparation and cleanup are entrusted to premium Miele appliances, including the cooktop, oven and dishwasher, complemented by a Bosch over the range microwave for added convenience. Natural light and ventilation are provided through a single opening porthole.

Master stateroom

A serene haven anchored by a king bed with storage drawers beneath and flanked by nightstands, the master stateroom also houses a secure safe for valuables and electric Roman shades that modulate the ambiance at the touch of a button. The ensuite head is luxuriously appointed with double sinks, a rain shower and a toilet, while chests of drawers on both sides deliver ample wardrobe capacity. Daylight and fresh air enter through one opening porthole, onboard entertainment is provided by a 55-inch TV, and safety is assured by an escape hatch in the master complete with a ladder.

Lower staterooms

The forward VIP stateroom offers a peaceful sanctuary, centered on a sliding double bed with drawers beneath, complemented by generous hanging lockers and additional dedicated storage; its ensuite head is complete with a sink, a rain shower and a toilet, and a 32-inch TV provides entertainment whether at anchor or underway. The mirrored staterooms uphold the same

standard of elegant comfort, each featuring a queen bed flanked by nightstands, a private ensuite head with sink, rain shower and toilet, and a crisp 43-inch TV for individual viewing.

Crew quarters

Arranged to balance comfort with operational efficiency, the crew accommodations include a starboard bunk cabin with upper and lower berths and a port Captain's cabin furnished with a double bed, all served by a shared head fully equipped with a sink, shower and toilet. A Miele washer/dryer adds practical laundry capability for extended voyages.

Electronics

Pre-wired for SAT TV and SAT phone, the yacht is outfitted for flawless media reception and uninterrupted communications. Offshore broadband is handled by a Starlink Maritime Flat High-Performance satellite internet kit, while a 4G/5G cellular router system with onboard Wi-Fi ensures seamless integration with shoreside networks. A Sonos stereo system, fully integrated with Control4, centralises audio-visual control throughout the fore deck, skylounge, aft deck and main deck, extending into the salon and master stateroom for effortless, whole-boat entertainment.

Pilothouse navigation

The pilothouse is furnished with a comprehensive Garmin navigation suite, anchored by one Garmin GMR 1236 xHD3 open-array radar and one Garmin Fantom 24x dome radar, supported by one Garmin GSD 25 Premium Sonar Fish Finder Module and four Garmin GPSMAP 9222 22-inch multifunction displays. Complementing this array are Garmin GPS, a Garmin autopilot

system, a Garmin wind, speed, and temperature transducer, a Garmin VHF with built-in loudhailer, and Garmin AIS, all seamlessly integrated to provide assured command and precise situational awareness in any conditions.

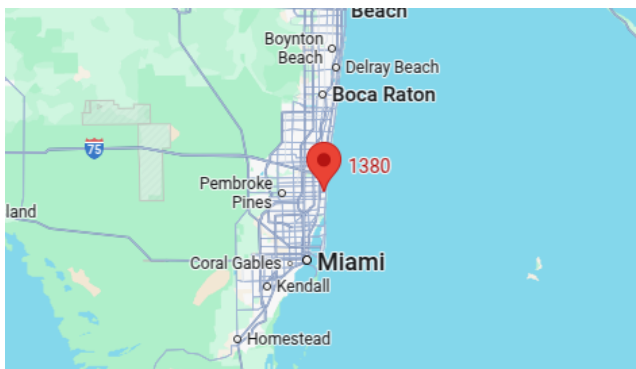
