OVERVIEW

The newest iteration reveals a redesigned flybridge, main deck and lower deck, conceived to maximize comfort, elegance and adaptability. Silken contours, crisp lines and the seductive Italian aesthetic that defines Azimut are embodied in the Azimut 84 Flybridge motor yacht. Outdoor living is elevated on the refreshed flybridge, which hosts a fully appointed bar with stools, a large open air BBQ, lounge height tables, generous seating and a hydraulic davit arm. The main deck rewards owners with an intelligent, practical layout; the galley has been enlarged for extra room, improved sightlines and direct service to the new bar. A true flybridge yacht and luxurious bluewater cruiser for discerning escapes.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Detailed description

Accommodation aboard is conceived as a private sanctuary, beginning with a full-beam master stateroom accessed through its own entrance off the main salon, where abundant natural light from generous windows frames a king bed with discreet under bed storage set against a palette of light woods and refined dark wood accents over soft carpeted flooring. The master is appointed with an integrated AV system and a Mac mini, a dedicated computer closet and extensive storage cabinetry, and an en suite head that indulges with his and hers sinks, considered vanity storage and a capacious walk in shower. Forward, the VIP stateroom presents a queen bed with under berth storage, a portside vanity and wardrobe, windows to either side and an overhead hatch for fresh sea air, together with its own AV system; the light and dark wood palette and carpet underfoot echo the yacht's serene aesthetic while the en suite provides a vanity and a walk in shower. The port guest cabin continues the theme with a queen bed and under berth storage, large windows, an AV system, storage cabinets and a closet, the same light wood with dark accents and a carpeted floor, plus a private en suite head. To starboard, sleeping arrangements are flexible with two twin beds on a sliding mechanism that convert to a queen and include an additional Pullman, storage beneath the berths, large windows, AV systems, a storage cabinet and closet, identical light/dark wood finishes and carpet, and their own en suite head. The galley and laundry are specified for effortless living and chef grade service, anchored by a Sub Zero refrigerator with two freezer drawers and an ice maker, a Miele four burner stove, a Miele oven new in 2022, a Miele vent hood with integrated lighting, a Miele dishwasher and a sink waste disposal unit to ensure clean, quiet operation underway or at anchor. Navigation confidence is

provided by a professional suite across the helm stations that includes a four inch Zenith compass, two Raymarine GS165 GPS chartplotters, Raymarine autopilot, dual Raymarine radars with a seventy two nautical mile range, the Azimut ship monitoring system, the Azimut hailer system, MAN engine displays, bow thruster controls, an ACR spotlight, Humphree trim tab control and CMC stabilizer controls, with mirrored capability at the upper station featuring a second four inch Zenith compass, two Raymarine GS125 GPS chartplotters (one new in 2021), a Raymarine radar repeater, repeated bow thruster controls, an additional ACR spotlight and Humphree trim tab control to ensure fingertip command whether at the lower helm or on the flybridge. Communications are equally comprehensive with four Raymarine VHF units providing clear ship to ship and ship to shore contact, all integrated with the navigation suite described above to deliver seamless operation across both helm stations. Entertainment is immersive and beautifully integrated throughout: KVH TracVision keeps you connected while Bose surround sound enriches the salon, the master and all guest cabins; outdoors the aft deck and flybridge each feature Samsung 32" TVs paired with JL Audio surround sound; in the salon a Samsung 60" TV rises on a powered lift complemented by Apple TV and an additional Samsung 32" TV at the salon bar; the master enjoys its own Samsung 60" TV with Apple TV and each guest cabin is fitted with Samsung 32" TVs with Apple TV, while the crew area is equipped with a Samsung 24" TV and a Bose DVD player. Tenders and toys have been curated for confident exploration and effortless beach transfers, including the 2019 ZAR tender with a LOA of 15' and a beam of 7'2", a wet weight of approximately 1400 lbs and a responsive Tohatsu 90HP outboard that comfortably seats nine; the tender's helm features a Garmin seven inch touchscreen chartplotter, entertainment from a Fusion stereo driving two speakers and durability enhanced by a PlasDeck teak package. On deck, premium equipment underscores safe handling and elegant guest flow: an Opacmare hydraulic swim platform simplifies tender launch and retrieval, a

Lofrans vertical electric anchor windlass manages ground tackle with authority, two Lofrans electrical deck winches port and starboard support dock handling, and an Opacmare hydraulic passerelle extends a gracious welcome to shore; underwater lights set the mood at twilight, a central vacuum system eases housekeeping and hot water is assured by two water heaters rated at 26.4 gallons each. Additional appliances extend convenience throughout the yacht with a Miele washer and dryer thoughtfully located in the guest hallway, an Isotherm refrigerator on the aft deck new in 2022, two Isotherm refrigerators and an Isotherm ice maker on the flybridge plus an Isotherm refrigerator with freezer in the crew area; in the salon a Sub Zero wine fridge preserves vintages while a Kenyon two burner electric grill on the flybridge invites open air cooking with a view.
