## OVERVIEW

---

Lazzara 84 "Living the Dream" returns to the market with completely refurbished Caterpillar C32s, delivering as-new confidence and exhilarating performance. Launched in 2008 by the esteemed Lazzara Yachts, this 25.6-meter flybridge motor yacht blends American craftsmanship with contemporary styling, and now benefits from an investment exceeding \$300,000 in a full restoration of her twin 1,650 hp CAT C32 engines. The comprehensive overhaul was executed to exacting standards to ensure smooth, reliable running and long-term peace of mind, with approximately 50 hours showing since the work was completed.

Purpose-built as a luxury cruising yacht, Living the Dream offers a finely balanced package of speed, comfort, and volume. Her sleek GRP hull and superstructure emphasize performance while maintaining a refined aesthetic, complemented by a beam of 6.13 meters and an approximate gross tonnage of 106 GT. Displacing around 64,000 kg (141,000 lbs), she provides a reassuringly solid ride, supported by ABT fin stabilizers that enhance comfort underway and at anchor. A planing hull form, shaft-and-prop propulsion, and a hydraulic steering system together deliver crisp handling characteristics, with a hydraulic bow thruster on hand for confident maneuvering in tight marinas.

On the water, this performance motor yacht is thoroughly engaging. Top speed is an impressive 32 knots, with a fast, efficient cruise at 24 knots for spirited passages. For extended adventures, she offers a maximum cruising range of about 415 nautical miles at 10 knots, and her fuel capacity of 2,000 gallons supports flexible itineraries. Ground tackle is equally robust, featuring two 110 kg anchors each with 100 meters of chain, ideal for secure anchoring in a variety of cruising grounds.

The accommodations layout is tailored for family yachting and private charter-style hospitality, sleeping up to 10 guests in five cabins that include a

full-beam master suite, a VIP stateroom, a double, a twin, and a single cabin. Six well-appointed heads ensure easy circulation and comfort for all aboard, while separate crew quarters for three allow for discreet, professional service. Throughout the interior, a chilled-water air-conditioning system maintains a serene onboard climate, and the expansive salon forms a welcoming heart of the yacht, perfect for relaxed lounging and elegant entertaining.

Technology and navigation are thoughtfully specified for modern cruising. A Raymarine suite provides radar, GPS, plotter, and sonar, while updated Garmin electronics add contemporary functionality at the helm. Communications are comprehensive, including VHF, satellite capability, and onboard Wi-Fi to keep guests connected at sea. A versatile split 50/60 Hz electrical system was designed for worldwide use, simplifying international cruising and enhancing resale appeal for global buyers.

Mechanical and utility spaces have been engineered with reliability and serviceability in mind. The yacht is fitted with twin Kohler 23 kW generators for dependable onboard power, with options also encompassing twin Onan 27.5 kW units. AGM battery banks supply services and engine starting, and the engine room offers excellent access for maintenance—an appreciated hallmark of Lazzara's build ethos. Taken together with the recent CAT C32 restoration, the machinery suite underscores a turn-key proposition for an owner focused on effortless, enjoyable time on the water.

Lifestyle amenities elevate Living the Dream into a truly luxurious flybridge yacht. A hydraulic swim platform simplifies tender operations and invites lazy afternoons by the water. Entertainment is immersive, with a Bose sound system serving both the salon and flybridge, and a full media setup with TV and Blu-ray for movie nights. The galley is equipped with high-end appliances to delight discerning chefs, and practical touches like a washer and dryer speak to extended-cruise convenience. Interior and exterior LED lighting add a sophisticated ambiance from cockpit sundowners to late-evening flybridge

gatherings.

As a turnkey GRP motor yacht that has benefited from a major mechanical investment, M/Y Living the Dream stands out sharply in today's luxury yacht market. The rare combination of freshly overhauled 1,650 hp CAT C32 engines, ABT stabilizers, robust Raymarine navigation with updated Garmin components, world-ready 50/60 Hz power, and a five-cabin, six-head layout puts her in a class of her own for an 84-foot planing flybridge cruiser. Currently lying in Miami, Florida, she is available for private viewing by appointment, and awaits an owner ready to enjoy confident performance, refined comfort, and effortless style from day one.

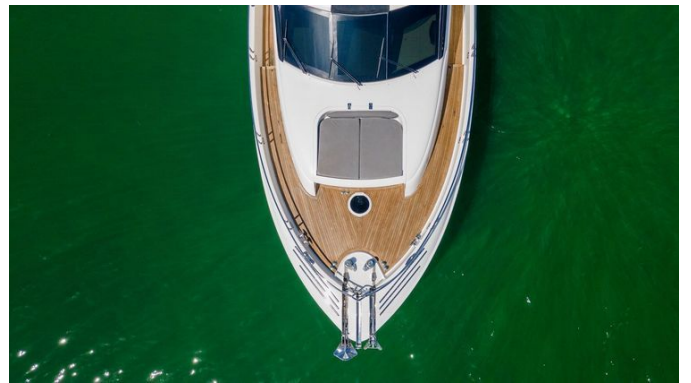
