“Salvatore II” is an exceptional 86-foot expedition motor yacht, born of Nordhavn’s bluewater heritage and crafted to offer a serene, high-luxury onboard experience for extended voyaging. Recently emerging from an extensive refit and presented in immaculate condition, she has been engineered as a genuine long-range cruiser so owners may wander great distances with complete comfort and confidence. Broad teak clad decks flow to a generous salon and sweeping al fresco entertaining spaces, while elegantly appointed guest staterooms are complemented by a private, full beam owner’s suite that opens onto its own secluded terrace. Propelled by twin MTU engines and guided by a comprehensive Furuno navigation suite, with zero speed stabilizers and heavy duty offshore systems installed, “Salvatore II” fuses the virtues of a passagemaker, expedition trawler, and luxury motor yacht — delivering authentic go anywhere range with the assurance, craftsmanship, and timeless elegance that mark her as a premier explorer yacht and bluewater cruiser.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Nordhavn N86

A true example of global passagemaking pedigree, Salvatore II embodies Nordhavn's renowned craftsmanship, long-range capability, and rugged elegance, a purpose-built eighty-six-foot expedition motor yacht freshly refreshed by a major 2025 refit and presented in exceptional condition ready to embark on its next adventure. Stepping aboard, the teak-laid swim platform announces quality and meticulous attention to detail, where polished stainless-steel railings frame the space and integrate eight rod holders with an additional ten fitted along the transom for dedicated anglers; teak steps to port and starboard lead up to an expansive cockpit where the teak continues underfoot and an aft fixed settee wraps a handsome timber dining table, complemented by director's chairs and shaded on demand by a removable awning to create an inviting alfresco setting for meals or sunset aperitifs. To port, a built-in BBQ and sink make outdoor entertaining effortless while a convenient day head set off the starboard side deck ensures quick access after a swim without the need to head inside, and wide teak side decks lead safely forward for surefooted movement around the yacht.

Through sliding glass doors the saloon greets you with generous volume and warmth, panoramic windows flooding the interior with natural light to highlight beautiful joinery and elegant furnishings; a large chaise-style sofa sits to port with additional armchairs opposite around a refined coffee table and a large Samsung TV to starboard stands ready for movie nights or relaxed entertainment at anchor. Forward, the formal dining area comfortably seats eight while opposite a sociable bar anchors the space with shelving for spirits and glassware and a substantial refrigeration suite comprising two Vintec wine fridges and two Dometic beverage fridges, and direct side-deck access allows

guests to drift effortlessly between indoors and out.

Forward of the dining area the galley is a chef's domain designed for both performance and conversation: a breakfast bar with three stools invites casual bites and convivial moments while premium appliances elevate every culinary task, including an upright Sub-Zero fridge/freezer with built-in ice maker, a Sub-Zero freezer with a second built-in ice maker, a Miele induction cooktop, dual Miele ovens, and a Miele dishwasher; ample counter space and abundant storage deliver the ideal balance of practicality and social connection to the main deck. Guest accommodation is arranged to maximize comfort and privacy: to port of the galley a staircase descends to a versatile guest cabin with a three-quarter double bed, a Samsung TV, and a vessel monitoring system, equally suitable as a captain's cabin if desired, complete with a private ensuite and separate shower. To starboard a second staircase leads to the principal guest area where a spacious mid-level VIP suite offers a queen bed, generous storage, and a private ensuite, and continuing to the lower accommodation deck two additional guest cabins each configurable as twin singles or a double with private ensuites ensure flexible arrangements for family and friends; all guest cabins are equipped with Samsung TVs for seamless entertainment. Forward of these cabins lies a dedicated utility room with separate washer and dryer, a sink, ample storage and hanging space—an invaluable asset for extended voyaging.

From the galley an internal staircase leads up to the commanding pilothouse where twin Stidd helm chairs face a professionally equipped navigation console centered on supersized Furuno multifunction displays and a comprehensive Furuno electronics suite; port and starboard pilothouse doors provide immediate deck access for docking or fresh air while an inviting L-shaped seating area with a table aft of the helm forms a relaxed observation or social zone. For assured comfort in any sea state Salvatore II is equipped with ABT TRAC stabilizers with Zero Speed functionality and American bow and stern thrusters, delivering composed handling underway and reassuring

stability at anchor. Directly aft of the pilothouse the owner's stateroom creates a private sanctuary: the ensuite to port features dual sinks and a large separate shower while the full-beam suite centers on a king-size island bed framed by finely crafted timberwork and bathed in natural light, with a drop-down Samsung TV seamlessly integrated for in-cabin entertainment and a private terrace extending aft complete with a removable shade awning and two sun lounges—an intimate retreat for morning coffee, quiet reading, or simply taking in the sea's panoramic sweep.

Forward of the pilothouse two wing control stations enable precise maneuvering with excellent sightlines down either side of the yacht; a comfortable bench seat forms a scenic perch and steps lead down to the teak-laid foredeck where a MarQuipt davit handles tender operations with ease and robust ground tackle—dual plough-type anchors serviced by Maxwell windlasses—stands ready for secure holding in diverse anchorages. Returning inside, an internal staircase from the pilothouse ascends to the flybridge where twin Stidd helm chairs with footrests are complemented by a Furuno navigation suite, three-sided clears provide protection while preserving open views, and central bench seating with a hi/lo table converts easily into a daybed; the teak-laid deck lends a luxurious tactile feel while a sink and additional rod holders make this elevated space equally suited to relaxation, entertaining, or light sportfishing.

Crew quarters are accessed from the cockpit via a door to port near the saloon entrance and present a well-designed domain with a compact kitchenette featuring a bar fridge, a Sharp microwave, and a sink, two cabins that provide privacy and comfort for extended passages—one with a double berth and a Hisense TV and the second with a single berth—and a head with shower to ensure dedicated facilities for the team. Aft of the crew area the spacious lazarette, also accessible via a hatch through the cockpit sole, offers generous storage for water toys, fenders, lines, and other cruising essentials, keeping decks clear and organized; both the lazarette and engine room doors are

stainless steel, underscoring Salvatore II's uncompromising build quality. Beyond lies the heart of the yacht: a meticulously maintained engine room housing twin MTU Series 60 engines rated at 600 hp each, twin Onan forty kilowatt generators, and Parker Village Marine and Stella Marine water makers, the space clean, well-lit and intelligently arranged for access and service with a workbench above the generators and room to move—hallmarks of Nordhavn's thoughtful engineering.

Salvatore II stands as a remarkable long-range motor yacht that blends expedition capability with refined luxury, and with her 2025 refit, generous accommodation plan, and robust systems she delivers true go-anywhere confidence without compromising comfort or style—a vessel that invites you to explore the world's oceans in elegance, safety, and total peace of mind.


