Propelled by robust twin MAN V12s, she promises swift, smooth passages that complement her flybridge superyacht pedigree and planing performance cruiser capabilities. A prime opportunity with a motivated seller seeking a prompt deal and open to trade in, this Ferretti 850 represents a standout value not to be missed.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description and accommodation

The Ferretti Yachts 850 is a refined Italian flybridge motor yacht that fuses Zuccon's elegant design language with advanced Ferretti engineering and genuinely impressive performance, built to CE Category A standards to deliver swift, comfortable passages and exemplary seakeeping whether as a private family cruiser or a platform for luxurious, guest-focused voyages. On the main deck a generous aft cockpit with a dedicated dining area flows seamlessly through wide sliding doors into a bright, open plan salon where a welcoming lounge and a formal dining space are framed by expansive panoramic windows, creating an elegant yet relaxed ambience, while forward a separate galley ensures complete privacy from guest areas and is complemented by a convenient day head and direct access to the helm station so command remains close at hand. The lower deck is devoted to guest accommodation and comfortably sleeps eight in four en suite cabins, all finished to Ferretti's exacting standards, with a full beam Owner's Cabin amidships offering a true sanctuary with large windows, a walk in wardrobe, a refined vanity and desk area and a private en suite bathroom; forward the VIP cabin features a double berth, excellent storage and its own en suite, and two additional twin guest cabins, each with twin berths and private en suites, complete a layout that promotes privacy and comfort for every guest on board. Crew are discreetly accommodated aft in separate quarters accessed independently from the cockpit, comprising two crew cabins for three to four crew, a crew bathroom and direct access to the engine room to ensure professional, unobtrusive service at all times. Above, the expansive flybridge creates the ideal open air living space with an upper helm station, generous seating and dining areas, broad sunbathing zones and a fully equipped wet bar for effortless relaxation

and entertainment, while aft the opening transom transforms into a wide beach club and swim platform providing easy access to the sea and water toys. Overall the Ferretti 850's balanced deck plan, luxurious accommodation and thoughtful crew separation make her a standout in the 26 metre class, perfectly suited to comfortable family cruising and hosting guests in unmistakable Italian style.

Specification - standard & optional extra

Delivered as an F850 Hard Top version, this yacht is outfitted for effortless, all climate cruising with twin ONAN 27 kW generators showing 2693 hours and 2534 hours, a hardtop on the flybridge with an electric opening awning and Zero Speed fin stabilizers for comfort both underway and at anchor, while manoeuvrability is assured by Side Power hydraulic stern and bow thrusters rated at 24 HP with double propellers and Mediterranean Tropical air conditioning maintains an ideal onboard climate. Deck operations are supported by a Besenzoni crane and a watermaker producing 250 lt/h, complemented by a stationary battery system, two Victron inverters, three Masterworld chargers with inverter and a smoke separator for the generator, and entertainment on deck is elevated by JL Audio exterior speakers on both the flybridge and the cockpit. A comprehensive dual station Simrad navigational suite includes AIS, a steering angle indicator, a radar antenna, electronic engine controls, a chain counter, multiple displays, DSC VHF, navigation lights and a plotter with GPS antenna together with a co pilot seat, while safety and control features comprise an engine alarm, a rotatable spotlight, a horn, a compass and a fire fighting system. Practical detailing abounds with side doors on both the port and starboard walkways, a RACOR filter for the generator, a teak laid flybridge, underwater lights, an aft garage curtain and a flap angle indicator on the flybridge, plus a large electrically controlled rectangular searchlight. The galley and hospitality specification

features a refrigerator with water and ice dispenser operating on 230V–24V via inverter and a ceramic cooking top with four rings, one expandable, while lighting is carefully curated with dimmers in the cockpit, outdoor illumination for the flybridge ladder and the spoiler descent ladder and dedicated lighting for the interior staircase to the lower deck cabins; privacy is enhanced by electric lifts for curtains in the master cabin and on the main deck. Exterior hardware is tastefully customized with Glomex and VHF antennas, one horn and the radar antenna all finished in Vulcan Gray as a non-standard upgrade, while multistandard electric outlets increase versatility. Ground tackle and utilities include an electric anchor windlass, two stern winches and chain washing, plus both automatic and electric bilge pumps, a black water system with a 600 lt tank, 12/220V internal sockets, a 220V dock socket and a dock water socket. Entertainment and domestic comforts are abundant with a satellite TV antenna and TV system, AM/FM radio, stereo and five TVs, an ice maker, a dishwasher, a washing machine and a dryer. Social spaces are superbly appointed with sun loungers, sofas and a table on the flybridge, a large table and chairs on the aft deck, teak laid in the cockpit and on the side walkways, a cockpit cover, aft and bow cushions, window covers and a console cover; for open air cooking and waterside living there is a BBQ/grill on the flybridge, a cockpit sink, an outdoor shower, a bath ladder, a passerelle gangway and a large swimming platform (Tenderlift). Interior enhancements include an additional rug in the main deck salon and armchairs on the main deck, night time atmosphere and safety are refined by LED lights at the bow (eight pieces), LED lights on the flybridge (eight pieces) and LED lights in the cockpit (two on the bench and two on the sides for a total of four pieces), while the salon entertainment package features a 55 inch slim LCD/LED TV with a motorized lift system and the cockpit benefits from four cockpit chairs, with additional loose furniture on the flybridge comprising a dining table and four dining chairs to flexibly tailor the space for al fresco meals and gatherings.
