OVERVIEW

The Burger 85' Simaron emerges from a comprehensive 2025 refit as a meticulously prepared expression of luxury motor-yacht excellence. Retained by its original owner and maintained to exacting standards, she has undergone a full MTU main engine rebuild to zero time and is supported by a one-year MTU warranty, ensuring dependable, superyacht-class performance and peace of mind at sea.

The connection to Burger Boat Company goes back to the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show in 1996, when the owner set out to acquire a first yacht and found Burger's unrivaled pedigree, finish, and attention to detail the decisive choice—an allegiance reflected in every inch of this vessel today.

Between 2024 and 2025 Simaron was the focus of an intensive \$1,000,000 program of upgrades that elevate her well beyond many contemporaries in the Burger fleet. Her MTU 12V 2000 mains were rebuilt to zero hours and carry a full one-year MTU warranty, the electronics and electrical systems were modernized throughout, and the 30 kW Kilopak generators were fully overhauled. A fully equipped flybridge galley creates a natural center for entertaining, while dedicated crew accommodation sleeps three across two cabins with an ensuite head to support proper yacht operations. All systems addressed in 2024 were refitted by Yacht Assist (YA) and come with a complete one-year warranty on the workmanship, underscoring the depth and quality of the refit.

The result is a flush-deck motor yacht that outclasses many current designs in luxury, capability, and value. Interior spaces by Douglas Richey harmonize with Don O'Keeffe's naval architecture and exterior styling, and the hallmarks of American Burger craftsmanship unify the composition, marrying classic Burger lines to a refined, higher-freeboard presence for a timeless yet commanding profile.

From every angle Simaron captivates: three generous decks provide sumptuous living and effortless entertaining, while a collection of alfresco areas invites lounge and dining beneath sun or stars. Whether enjoying the tranquil, well-appointed interiors or the open-air grace of the flybridge, the experience aboard is unmistakably elevated. "Simaron is more than just a boat; it's the best decision I ever made."

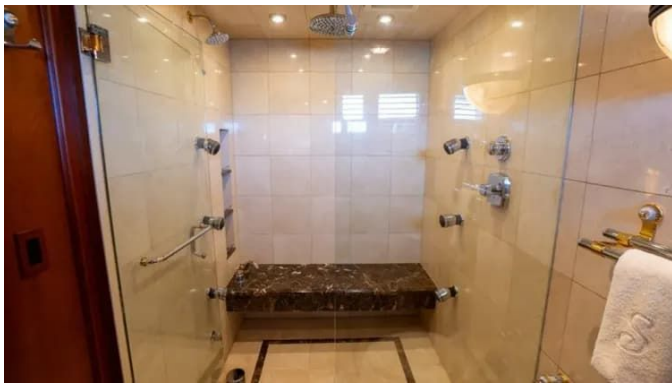






















































DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Features

An extensive, professional-grade electronics suite ensures assured navigation and situational awareness, highlighted by B&G depthsounders, a B&G log-speedometer with repeaters, a Garmin navigation center and Garmin GPS, and four Garmin plotters. Steering and direction are managed by a C Plath autopilot, supported by two compasses and dual ICOM VHF radios. Onboard entertainment and connectivity have been curated for both relaxation and utility, with a DVD player, a Nakamichi radio, a Sony CD player, cockpit speakers, B&G wind speed and direction instruments, WiFi, two radars, four flat-screen televisions, and AIS.

Power and comfort systems are engineered for sustained, dependable operation, featuring a 100-amp, 240V shore power inlet, two 30 kW generators, an Atlas power converter, and brand-new batteries. Thoughtful luxuries such as underwater lights and a dedicated wine cellar further enhance life aboard. Stabilization and galley capabilities are well appointed with Koopnautic stabilizers and a MIELE oven, while sanitation and provisioning are robust thanks to five Head Hunter electric heads and three deep freezers. Maneuvering is aided by a hydraulic bow thruster, and a major air compressor was rebuilt in 2024.

Hot-water and household systems were recently refreshed, with two new water heaters installed in 2024, two MIELE dishwashers, and a GAGGENO microwave oven. Electrical and safety systems include three battery chargers, seven electric bilge pumps, a five-ton chilled-water air-conditioning plant, and a Watermakers Inc. fresh-water maker. Everyday convenience is addressed with a washer/dryer, five marine heads, and four refrigerators located in the master, galley, flybridge, and engine room; redundancy and utility are further

assured by a manual bilge pump, heating, and a seawater pump.

Deck appointments combine craftsmanship with practical luxury, featuring a teak cockpit and teak sidedecks, a hydraulic gangway supplemented by two additional gangways, plush cockpit cushions, and two swimming ladders. A cockpit shower fitted new in 2024 adds modern convenience, and a 2,000 lb davit, rebuilt in 2024, stands ready for tender operations. The tender is a 5.20 m Nautica RIB 17WB powered by a Yamaha F115TLR, and onboard safety and leisure gear includes a liferaft and a cockpit table, while a fin stabilizer contributes to steady motion underway. When the yacht is not in use, full exterior covers protect the foredeck cushions, aft deck seating, and the entire flybridge.

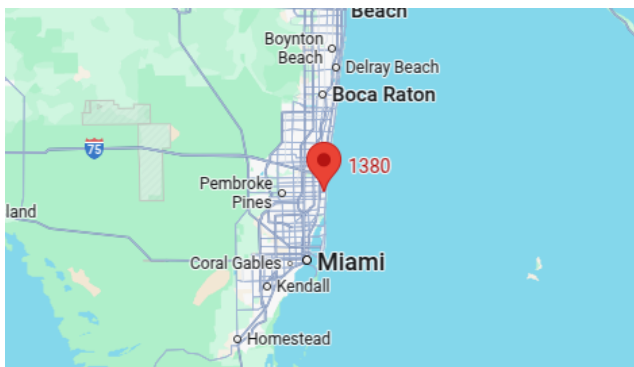
