The broad flybridge is arranged for alfresco entertaining and is equipped with an electric BBQ. Propelled by twin MTU engines delivering 1,920 horsepower, this flybridge motor yacht marries assured performance with elegant comfort. Possessing a superyacht presence yet retaining pilothouse practicality, LIVE MAS is a bluewater-capable cruising motoryacht ready to carry you in style to your next horizon.

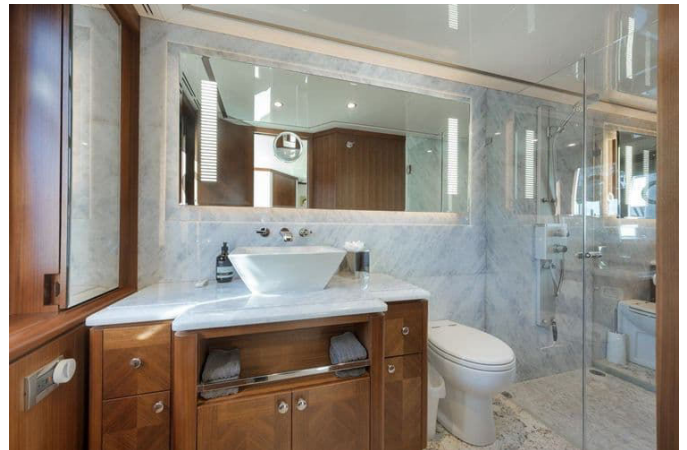

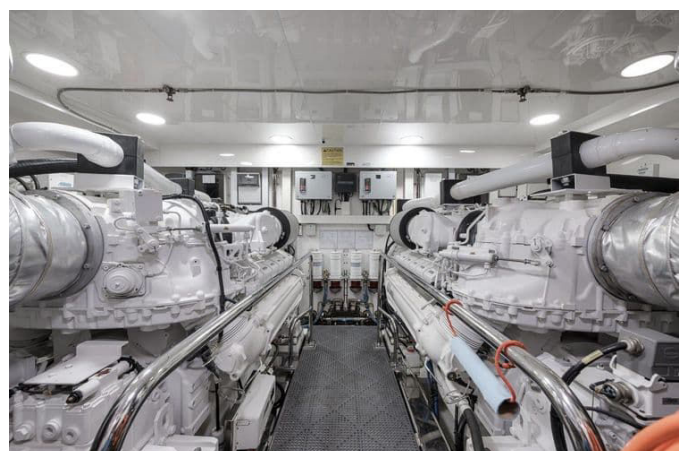














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Main specifications

At 85'0" (25.91m) length overall with a 20'1" (6.12m) beam and a 5'11" (1.80m) draft, this 2017 Ocean Alexander semi-displacement motor yacht blends volume, range, and pace with poise; identified by HIN OAX85E12J617 and measuring 112 tons, she welcomes eight guests attended by a professional crew of two to three. Conceived inside and out by Evan Marshall Design and constructed in fiberglass to Motor Yacht classification, she delivers the resilient integrity and refined finish discerning owners expect. Performance is confident and responsive, with a maximum speed of 25 knots and an effortless 18-knot cruise that yields a 560 nautical mile range while returning consumption at cruising of 52 gph. Practical endurance underpins her passagemaking credentials: fuel capacity is 2,800 gal, fresh water is 350 gal, and grey water is managed by five gallon sump tanks. Proudly flying the USA flag, she is engineered for elegant long-distance passages and seamless life aboard.

Machinery

Power is delivered by twin MTU 12V2000 M96 main engines rated at 1,920 hp each, a combination that couples authority with refinement; engine hours stand at 2,276 on port and 2,281 on starboard as of January 2026. Ship's power is entrusted to Kohler generators with a 32 kW output, showing 2,587 hours port and 2,590 hours starboard as of January 2026, supported by Iso-Boost on 50 AMP and 100 AMP shorepower. Heavy-duty AGM batteries with a 100 AMP charger and a battery paralleling system with control switch provide robust reserve and effortless redundancy. The drive-train system translates torque into quiet confidence, while hydraulic steering gives fingertip precision. Comfort is further stabilized by Sidepower zero-speed stabilizers, effective

both underway and at anchor. Range and self-sufficiency are augmented by a Sea Recovery water maker producing 900 gal/day and an Ecomar waste treatment system processing 600 gal/day. Close-quarters control comes courtesy of Side Power thrusters, with a 55 hp bow thruster paired to a 40 hp stern thruster. Domestic systems are equally premium: a Headhunter Mach 5 fresh-water pump with Viqua VH410 UV sterilizer ensures purity, an air compressor stands ready on demand, and climate is governed by Dometic Air for serene comfort throughout.

Communication and navigational equipment

In the pilothouse, communications are anchored by a Garmin VHF, while navigation is commanded with confidence by a Garmin 25 kW open-array radar, a Ritchie five inch magnetic compass, the Garmin GHC20 autopilot, and Garmin AIS to enhance positional awareness. Entertainment flows seamlessly throughout the yacht with LED TVs and a full A/V system in the main salon and master stateroom, mirrored across all guest staterooms, the aft deck via a flip-down screen, the flybridge, and crew areas—each supported by DirecTV satellite receivers and Starlink connectivity. On deck, atmosphere and rhythm are curated by Fusion audio on both the flybridge and the aft deck.

Galley and laundry equipment

The main galley is appointed for culinary finesse and effortless service, featuring a Jenn-Air electric cooktop, Jenn-Air electric oven, and a Jenn-Air over-the-range microwave, partnered by a Samsung refrigerator/freezer and a Jenn-Air dishwasher for seamless cleanup. The crew galley and mess is thoughtfully outfitted with a Kitchenette fridge to keep provisions close at hand between watches. Laundry needs are fully supported with washing machines and dryers, ensuring crisp linens and impeccable presentation on

every passage.

Deck equipment

Purposeful deck gear underscores capability and ease: the anchoring arrangement includes anchors on robust ground tackle with 500' of chain, while a boat crane stands ready to launch and recover tenders and toys with confidence. Complementing the package is a 2016 16' Novurania 430 DL powered by a Yamaha 60 hp outboard, expanding every anchorage into a playground. Note: equipment and inventory remain subject to change and or negotiation during the buying process.

Security, fire fighting and safety equipment

Security is anchored by a CCTV system integrated with Garmin Marine cameras—two surveying the engine room and one monitoring the aft deck—while an Octoplex NMEA 200 monitor system keeps vital parameters in view. Fire readiness is comprehensive, with a Fireboy CO2 fire suppression system complemented by sixteen portable extinguishers positioned for rapid response. High-water alarms are specified for installation in bilge zones to add another layer of assurance. Safety at sea is equally thorough: two six-man Sea-Safe life rafts stand ready, together with one life ring, a single ACR GlobalFix V4 EPIRB, a full set of flares, and a medical kit—each element chosen to safeguard every mile under way.

Accommodation and layout

The accommodation plan is elegantly simple and eminently livable, centering on a serene owner's cabin, a generous VIP cabin for favored guests, and a versatile single slash double cabin that adapts to family or friends with equal

grace.

Refit list 2023

In 2023 she benefitted from a comprehensive refresh that elevated both aesthetics and function: her exterior received full Awlgrip paint from the waterline up, including new nonskid, while the teak decks were sanded with caulking repaired or replaced as required. All exterior cushions were renewed with tailored covers, the ship's horn was replaced, and the anchor chain was updated to 500'. A mesh enclosure was added aft of the flybridge for comfort and protection, and precise close-quarters handling was enhanced with a wired Glendinning docking remote. The davit was fully rebuilt with new hoses to restore as-new reliability. Interior and service areas saw meaningful upgrades as well: the galley refrigerator was replaced with a new Samsung, and the flybridge and aft deck bar refrigerators were exchanged for efficient refrigerated drawers, complemented by a new wine cooler. Underfoot, new carpet and custom runners were fitted throughout, and the galley, salon bars, and guest cabin surfaces were elevated from granite to elegant quartz.

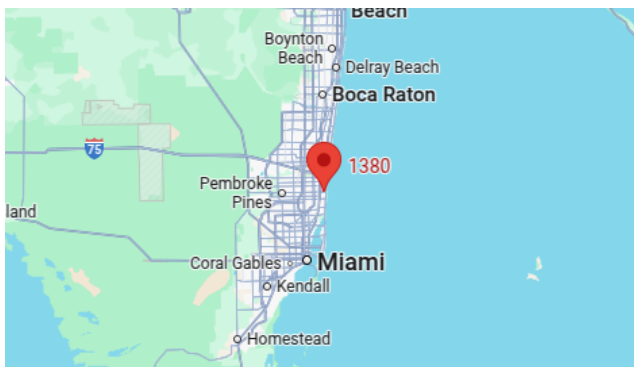
