## OVERVIEW

2005 85' motor yacht, conceived by Bill Gardner, that marries true bluewater capability with gracious onboard living. Now lying in the United States and offered in welcoming condition, this American-based 85-foot vessel reveals sweeping profiles, a confident silhouette, and the expansive interior volume one expects from a 21-foot beam. Clean trades will be considered.

Her composite hull and superstructure quiet the sea and instill confidence underway, while Gardner's celebrated hull lines reward long runs with stability and economical passage-making. Twin MTU inboard diesels deliver dependable, potent propulsion—well-suited to coastal cruising, island-hopping, or extended seasonal passages. With approximately 2,400 gallons of fuel and 425 gallons of freshwater aboard, she is equipped for lengthy stretches away from marinas, maximizing time spent exploring the horizon.

Enter to find an interior of restrained luxury that emphasizes light, openness, and effortless circulation. The generous salon is arranged for relaxed conversation and cinematic sunset views through broad windows, and the adjoining dining area flows naturally from casual family meals to more formal entertaining. The galley is laid out for both chef-led service and simple mornings before departure, with plentiful storage and work surfaces that keep the living areas uncluttered and serene.

Sleeping accommodations are planned for privacy and restorative comfort. Multiple staterooms are complemented by five heads, providing ensuite-style convenience for owners and guests alike. Separate crew accommodations with two dedicated cabins preserve discretion and allow the yacht to run smoothly, whether for weekend escapes or extended itineraries. Throughout, fine joinery, tasteful upholstery, and considered lighting combine to create a calm, refined atmosphere that is both luxurious and welcoming.

Outside, the generous beam becomes generous outdoor living. A shaded aft cockpit offers an ideal setting for alfresco dining, while elevated vantage points and flybridge or raised pilothouse spaces frame wide ocean vistas. Safe, broad side decks and solid railings ensure confident movement aboard both underway and at anchor, and durable fiberglass decks minimize upkeep so your focus remains on the voyage.

Engineered for practical, long-range cruising yet conceived to deliver beautiful moments at sea, this 85-foot motor yacht stands as a versatile platform of pedigree and presence, balancing substantial capability with elegant style. She is available now for inspection in the United States; bring your ideas, step aboard, and imagine the passages ahead.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

## Description

---

An exceptionally upgraded gentleman's yacht, the 2005 Pacific Mariner 85 JULE embodies timeless styling, renowned seakeeping, and a caliber of modernization rarely seen in her class. Celebrated for superior build quality and true ocean-going performance, Pacific Mariner yachts command industry respect, and JULE stands apart as a pristine example. Custom-built from new with a hinged hardtop that lowers to permit passage to the Great Lakes through the Hudson River, she marries pedigree with purposeful engineering for versatile cruising. Over the past twelve months, more than \$700,000 has been invested, with nearly \$2,000,000 in upgrades over the last five years, including Humphree Zero Speed Stabilizers with interceptors, a comprehensive MTU W4 engine service, and wide-ranging mechanical, electrical, and interior refinements that elevate reliability and comfort underway and at anchor. Her luxurious twelve-millimeter Burmese teak decking extends across every exterior deck—making her the only Pacific Mariner 85 with this premium specification—and her equipment list continues to impress with a brand-new sixteen-foot AB aluminum tender, Starlink connectivity, premium Zeno mattresses in every stateroom, and numerous system updates. The result is an ownership experience that rivals yachts far newer and significantly more expensive. For the buyer seeking a truly turn-key motor yacht defined by pedigree, comfort, and exceptional value, JULE presents a rare opportunity at a fraction of replacement cost. WILL ACCEPT CLEAN TRADES!

## Key highlights

---

Among her most compelling attributes are a four-stateroom layout plus two crew cabins and a full-beam master reached via a private staircase,

underscoring true owner privacy. Performance and poise are assured by Humphree Zero Speed Stabilizers with interceptors installed in 2020, while machinery confidence is anchored by an MTU W4 major service completed in 2021 with approximately 1,000 hours since. A complete twelve-millimeter Burmese teak decking installation in 2023 elevates every exterior space, and the equipment roster continues with a new AB sixteen-ALX aluminum tender powered by seventy horsepower in 2025, a 2025 Starlink internet system, and premium Zeno mattresses added to all staterooms in 2025. Extensive mechanical, electrical, and safety upgrades carried out across 2025–2026 complement over \$700k invested in just the last year.

## Vessel overview

---

Boarding via the new boarding ladder and optional aft gates, you step onto a generous aft deck crafted for alfresco entertaining, where a large teak dining table encircled by seating invites long, relaxed meals while a dropdown television provides effortless open-air cinema. The visual rhythm continues with Burmese teak laid throughout the yacht—the aft deck, flybridge, side decks, and foredeck—all finished in sumptuous twelve-millimeter planking that imparts a richness rarely seen on this model. Forward, the foredeck lounge tempts with cushioned seating, an ideal retreat for a quiet anchorage or sunrise passage. Inside, stainless steel sliding doors glide open to a warmly appointed salon with sweeping aft views. An inviting L-shaped sofa anchors the space alongside two barrel swivel chairs, a custom high-low cocktail/dining table, and a walk-behind bar complete with icemaker and wine cooler, while a retractable television disappears at a touch. The ambiance flows seamlessly into a formal dining area comfortably accommodating six to eight guests, creating an open-plan environment that connects salon, aft deck, and dining into one convivial social stage.

## Galley and pilothouse

---

Three gentle steps forward bring you to the galley, settee, and pilothouse level—a wonderfully social hub where conversation flows as easily as cuisine. The large peninsula-style galley is equipped with full-size appliances, a new refrigerator installed in 2025, a 2025 Miele dishwasher, and a new water filtration system, while three custom Crown Cantilever bar stools and a casual forward settee invite guests to linger. The pilothouse centers on two custom Stidd helm chairs and a comprehensive suite of modern navigation electronics, including Simrad chart plotters, HALO radar, autopilot, and dual VHF's. Port and starboard side doors grant excellent visibility and effortless access to the side decks, simplifying every evolution.

## Accommodations

---

Accessed by a private staircase, the full-beam master stateroom rivals suites on yachts in the 110–120 ft class. Appointments include a California King berth, walk-in closets, abundant drawer and cabinet storage, and an office desk with bookshelves, all bathed in natural light from oversized portlights. The ensuite head features dual sinks and a spacious shower, enveloping the owner in quiet luxury. A separate staircase leads to three additional guest cabins: a forward VIP with a queen berth and ensuite, a starboard aft VIP with a queen berth and ensuite, and a port twin guest cabin with side-by-side berths and an ensuite. All staterooms were upgraded in 2025 with premium Zeno mattresses, ensuring deeply restorative sleep throughout. Aft, the crew area provides privacy with two cabins accommodating three to four crew who share a head with a separate shower.

## Flybridge

---

Purpose-built for both command and camaraderie, the flybridge pairs Stidd helm seating with a companion guest bench and mirrors the lower helm with duplicate navigation electronics. Entertaining unfolds around a large L-shaped dining settee crowned by a high-gloss teak table, complemented by a walk-up bar with bar stools, multiple refrigerators and freezers, and an additional curved lounge. Aft, the expansive boat deck houses the tender and, once it is launched, transforms effortlessly into a generous open-air venue for larger gatherings.

## Mechanical and performance

---

Driven by MTU power, JULE delivers confident cruising at approximately eighteen knots. Recent mechanical work underscores diligent care: a major MTU W4 service in 2021, new cylinder heads, new turbos, fresh injectors and injection pumps, renewed charge air coolers, oil coolers, and fuel coolers. In 2025, updates continued with new injector pumps, turbo wastegate actuators, a full coolant service, alternator inspections, and routine oil and filter services. At sea or at anchor, stability is assured by Humphree Zero Speed Stabilizers with interceptors installed in 2020 and serviced again in 2025.

## Recent upgrades (2025 - 2026)

---

The latest suite of enhancements reads like a refit wish list: bottom paint and PropSpeed in 2026; a new AB sixteen-ALX aluminum tender with seventy hp in 2025; davit service and repaint with a new remote in 2025; a complete Metcalf exhaust riser system in 2025; Starlink satellite internet added in 2025; a Hubble Smart Boost electrical upgrade in 2025; dual Racor fuel filter systems for both engines and generators in 2025; a steering system rebuild in 2025;

new shore power cords in 2025; new boarding ladders and hardware in 2025; and an Aquabanas “Party Bana” floating lounge in 2025. Each item contributes to a yacht that feels fresher, runs cleaner, and operates with reassuring simplicity.

## Summary

---

Meticulously upgraded and genuinely turn-key, JULE is a standout Pacific Mariner 85 distinguished by luxurious finishes, advanced stabilization, exhaustive recent services, and a supremely livable layout—delivering one of the strongest values in today’s eighty–ninety foot motor yacht market. For buyers seeking a proven cruising platform equally at home in the Bahamas or on extended passages, JULE offers pedigree, performance, and value that are increasingly rare to find.
