OVERVIEW

Launched in 2013, GIADA is a Custom Line Navetta 26 Crescendo—one of an exclusive series of just eight—whose tri-deck silhouette combines classical poise with the presence of a superyacht. Inside, Zuccon's scheme unites pale oak joinery with expansive panoramic glazing so that natural light and warmth suffuse the living spaces; the main salon commands sweeping views and is appointed with a grand piano and ample seating, perfectly suited to both intimate family moments and refined entertaining.

Comfortable accommodation is arranged for up to 10 guests across four staterooms: a generous owner's suite on the main deck, and on the lower deck a double cabin and two twin cabins with Pullmans, complemented by a versatile fifth room currently fitted as a cinema/TV lounge that can be transformed into an additional cabin. Four crew are berthed separately to provide discreet, attentive service.

Deck areas are crafted for leisure and conviviality: a shaded aft terrace invites alfresco dining; the skylounge aft on the flybridge houses a full bar, modular seating and a retractable sunshade; forward, built-in sunpads form a secluded sunning retreat, while a broad swim platform ensures effortless access to the water, tender and toys.

Underway she is a semi-displacement, long-range cruiser—efficient and exceptionally quiet—offering a comfortable cruising speed of 12 knots, a top speed of 14 knots and an approximate range of 800 nautical miles. Stability is exceptional both at anchor and underway, thanks to Seakeeper gyros paired with ABT-TRAC fin stabilizers.

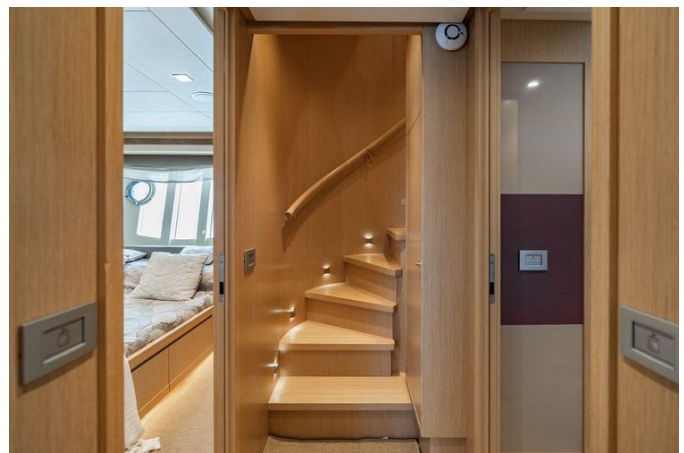

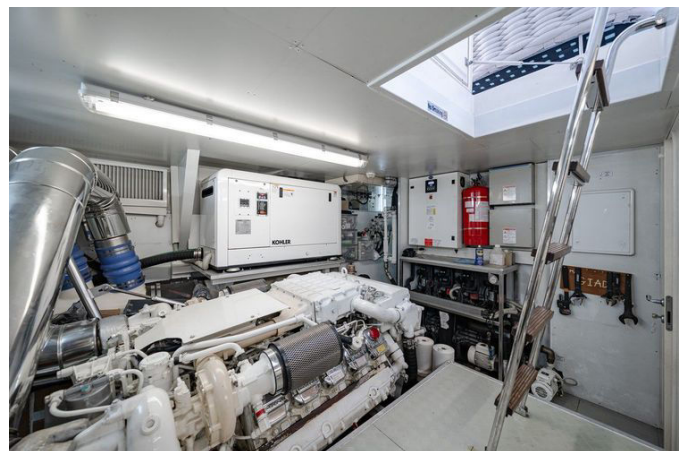












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Specifications

With a beam of 6.30 m and a draft of 2.20 m, this GRP yacht presents a finely balanced profile and a gross tonnage of 123 t, conceived inside and out by Zuccon International Project and flying the Cayman Islands flag. She is propelled by two MAN 1200 hp engines (approximately 3000 hours) through ZF gearboxes on a shaft drive with commercial propellers, and electrical independence is supported by two Kohler 28 kW generators (approximately 3350 hours). She reaches a maximum speed of 16 knots, with an overview cruising speed of 13 knots and performance data referenced at 10 knots to deliver a range of 500–600 nm with fuel consumption of approximately 100–110 L/h. Comfortable handling at sea is assured by ABT-TRAC fin stabilizers and a Seakeeper gyro, complemented by a bow thruster for precise close-quarters control, while the mechanical suite is comprehensive, including a Hydromar watermaker, fuel oil separator, dedicated fire and bilge pumps, boilers, and Dometic air conditioning. Fuel capacity is 12,500 L, complemented by 2,000 L of fresh water, 500 L of grey water, and 500 L of black water, and electrical systems comprise 220V AC shore power alongside 12V/24V DC batteries. Accommodation welcomes ten guests in four cabins—one master, one double, and two twins—with one cabin currently arranged as a cinema/entertainment room that retains its en suite and can be reconverted to a guest cabin at any time; crew quarters provide for four in two cabins. The galley and laundry are appointed with a Miele stove and oven, Miele dishwasher, and Miele washer and dryer, paired with Gaggenau refrigerators and freezers, while navigation and control are anchored by X band radar, a Furuno chart plotter and magnetic compass, a Simrad autopilot and GPS, and a Furuno AIS. Communications are robust with Simrad VHF, SART and Starlink

internet, and entertainment systems are thoughtfully curated: the main salon features LG and Panasonic TVs paired with a McIntosh sound system, the master suite enjoys a Bang & Olufsen TV, the double cabin carries a Sharp TV, the twin cabins are equipped with Sharp TVs, and the cinema/entertainment room is centred on an LG TV. Safety and security equipment is complete and commercially specified, with two life rafts, SOLAS and standard lifejackets, SART, FM200 fire suppression in the engine room, and portable extinguishers comprising fourteen dry powder units and two foam units. On deck, Lofrans anchors and chains are operated by a Lofrans windlass, a Besenzoni passerelle streamlines boarding and a swimming ladder completes the bathing setup, while tenders and toys include an Extender EXT 460 folding RIB with a Honda 40 hp outboard and two Point 65 Tequila! kayaks.
