OVERVIEW

The Bering 88 is an 88-foot long-range explorer motor yacht conceived for owners who insist on genuine passagemaking capability, ample range, and the assurance to venture well beyond familiar harbors. Built as an ocean-going expedition yacht, it melds rugged naval engineering with the polished appointments of a contemporary luxury vessel, making it a compelling choice for anyone seeking a long-range expedition yacht for sale.

Designed for extended voyages, the Bering 88 embraces a full-displacement philosophy that emphasizes strength, stability, and practical utility—qualities that serve island routes, regional crossings, and ambitious bluewater itineraries alike. Its construction and practical onboard layouts reflect robust build quality intended to support lengthy passages while preserving the comforts of everyday life aboard.

Though its profile speaks of adventure, the yacht is crafted to feel like home. Generous interior volume, abundant storage, and a liveaboard-ready plan provide residential comfort amid exploration. Social areas invite entertaining and relaxation, and private cabins offer quiet retreat between legs of passage. Owners seeking a luxury expedition yacht that refuses to sacrifice capability for comfort will appreciate how the Bering 88 balances functionality with a superyacht-level finish.

A hallmark of the model line is a “systems first” approach: machinery spaces arranged for reliability, logical access for maintenance, and equipment selections that favor real cruising. Whether considering an expedition trawler yacht or a steel expedition yacht with serious offshore intent, the Bering 88 presents a platform engineered for endurance, redundancy, and self-sufficiency—the defining traits of a true bluewater passagemaker and displacement yacht.

yacht" grows, the Bering 88 fits the trend toward autonomy, safety, and comfort over top speed. Sized for genuine liveaboard cruising at 88 feet, it remains manageable for a professional captain and crew or a confident owner-operator. 

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Bering 88 expedition yacht

The Bering 88 is a steel expedition yacht crafted for owners who prioritize offshore confidence, long-range cruising practicality, and true customization, conceived with an explorer mindset and engineered to support extended time underway and comfortable living at anchor, with a strong focus on systems, redundancy-minded upgrades, and real-world functionality that reward ambition with range, reliability, and composure.

Advanced energy options and hybrid capability

Multiple energy-forward configurations are available to reduce generator hours and elevate onboard efficiency, with E-motion serial hybrid drive packages offering tiers of battery storage to give owners the flexibility to tailor capacity to cruising style and power demand; for renewable support the Bering 88 can be specified with a solar array comprising five 360 W Victron BlueSolar monocrystalline panels with MPPT control, and for additional electrical optimization a peak shaving solution is offered using Victron batteries and an inverter system rated at 61.4 kWh designed to smooth load peaks and enhance overall energy management across the vessel.

Propulsion controls, shafts, and cold-weather support

For precise maneuvering and assured command, the Bering 88 can be equipped with Glendinning EEC4 electronic engine throttle control in the pilothouse per station, delivering intuitive response where it matters most; SeaTorque shafts are listed as an upgrade option to reinforce a robust,

low-vibration drivetrain, and for high-latitude runs and shoulder seasons a Webasto diesel heater can be specified to heat circulation water in low ambient sea temperatures, elevating comfort and extending usability in colder cruising grounds.

Fuel management for expedition cruising

Long-range itineraries demand clean, dependable fuel, and the Bering 88 addresses this with a Reverso fuel polishing system for the day tank—an invaluable addition for remote routes and extended passages where fuel quality can vary and reliability is non-negotiable.

Water, waste, and environmental systems

To support extended time aboard, the Bering 88 offers high-capacity watermaking solutions including HP watermaker options with RP TRONIC control, complemented by an HP silver ion sterilizer system for the fresh-water circuit, while for grey and black water a Headhunter wastewater treatment system provides modern compliance and comfort; on the seawater side the yacht can be specified with a Cathwell Sea Chest anti-fouling system and Cathwell hull cathodic protection, both aimed at reducing maintenance and safeguarding long-term durability.

Mooring and anchoring package

Serious cruising begins at the bow, and the Bering 88's mooring and anchoring upgrades reflect that ethos with extension of two anchor chains up to 160 meters, upgraded 160 kg stainless steel anchors, and an automatic fresh-water flushing system for the chain locker, while control and awareness are elevated with a MUIR wireless remote featuring a chain counter and antenna,

complemented by a fixed pilothouse remote with chain counter to enable confident anchoring across varied conditions and smooth, short-handed operations.

Fire safety and seawater fire line

Safety-minded outfitting forms a core pillar of the Bering 88, with automatic-deployment fire suppression canisters in the lazarette adding passive protection, while a Gianneschi fire pump and seawater fire line system furnish a robust active response capability tailored for offshore cruising.

Stabilization and handling comfort

For superior motion control underway, the Bering 88 can be upgraded to a Sleipner (Side Power) four-fin stabilizer system that refines roll reduction and heightens guest comfort as sea states change, and for added operational ease during close-quarters work a wired handheld remote control by Glendinning is also available.

Interior comfort and liveaboard functionality

Inside, the Bering 88 is configured for true liveaboard comfort with purposeful upgrades and quality appliances such as electric blinds paired with pilothouse forward window electric heating wires for effective defrosting, a salon capable of hosting a 55-inch Samsung TV, Isotherm drawer refrigeration, a wine cooler, and an automatic sliding door configuration; the master area may be specified with an under-table drawer refrigerator and a washer/dryer combo within the walk-in closet with Bosch or Miele noted, while the galley can be elevated with a built-in Miele oven, a Bosch or Miele built-in coffee machine, and optional separation between galley and salon via an electrical partition and an

upgraded electrical door, with guest cabins able to host 43-inch Samsung TVs and crew areas likewise benefiting from dedicated entertainment upgrades.

Laundry, storage, and long-stay provisioning

For extended cruising, thoughtful provisioning capacity is essential, and the Bering 88 answers with options such as a second washer and dryer, additional freezers, an extra tall refrigerator with deep freezer, and even a dedicated fridge room—features that support longer itineraries, larger guest parties, and genuine independence from marina schedules.

Deck equipment, outfitting, and adventure additions

Outdoor living and expedition readiness converge across the Bering 88's deck options, where the flybridge can be specified with a built-in wet bar, additional air conditioning capacity, sun awnings, removable soft enclosures with transparent PVC windows, and practical appliances such as an electric grill and Isotherm refrigeration; for utility and tender handling a Steelhead CT 3000 yacht crane supports active cruising and watersports, while the cockpit and boarding experience can be elevated with an Opacmare passerelle and additional enclosure options, the swim platform can be outfitted with a fishing package that includes outriggers, a live bait well, a tackle station, a cleaning station, and other angling-focused equipment, and for visual drama and night-time enjoyment Lumitec SeaBlaze LED underwater lights are available.

Navigation, connectivity, and entertainment

Modern expedition cruising demands reliable connectivity, and the Bering 88 delivers with an advanced Starlink setup featuring dual flat high-performance

antennas, a 5G modem, exterior antenna and cabling, plus an additional terrestrial internet option, while for navigation and onboard electronics an upgrade to an “ultra package” is available and audio can be elevated with premium stereo systems from K-Array or Bose depending on the requested configuration.

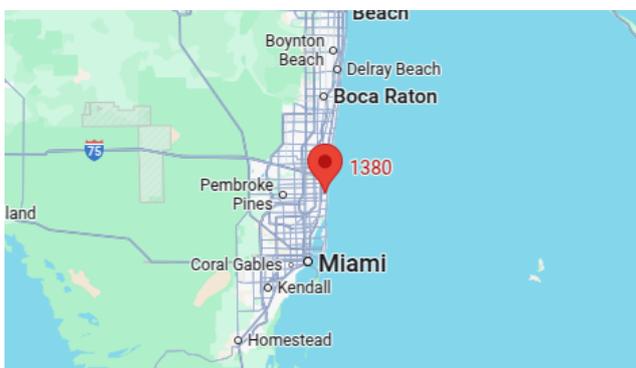
