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OVERVIEW

BELLA LUNA is a 26.3m Monte Carlo Yachts MCY 86 flybridge motor yacht, delivered in 2016 and freshly refitted in 2026 by the renowned Italian yard Monte Carlo Yachts, with both exterior and interior penned by Nuvolari Lenard. She artfully combines refined lines, assured performance and relaxed cruising capability, establishing herself as a distinguished example in the desirable 80–90ft luxury yacht sector.

Built with a lightweight composite hull and superstructure, BELLA LUNA benefits from enhanced fuel efficiency, secure seakeeping and notably low vibration levels. Twin MAN V12 engines provide a comfortable cruising speed of 16 knots and a spirited top speed of 28 knots, while a generous 6.55m beam affords impressive interior volume yet keeps the yacht ideally suited to an owner-operator or a compact professional crew.

Outdoor living has been meticulously considered, from the aft deck designed for alfresco dining to the inviting foredeck lounge and the expansive sundeck appointed with a Jacuzzi, sunpads and a wet bar. A fold-out balcony adjacent to the main saloon and a hydraulic swim platform enhance on-water access and further elevate the day-boat superyacht experience.

Inside, contemporary Italian design is paired with abundant natural light streaming through floor-to-ceiling windows, creating bright and soothing social areas. The main saloon, dining space and fully equipped galley are laid out for effortless entertaining and efficient service, while upgraded AV systems, modern climate control and Starlink connectivity ensure comfort and convenience on every passage.

Accommodation is arranged for up to 10 guests across four cabins, including a full-beam master suite, a VIP stateroom and two convertible twin cabins with Pullman berths, supported by crew quarters for up to 4. Zero-speed stabilisers deliver exceptional comfort both underway and at anchor.

With a charter-friendly layout, contemporary amenities and a true turn-key condition following its recent refresh, BELLA LUNA presents an enticing proposition for private ownership and a compelling charter-yacht investment within the premium flybridge motor yacht market.

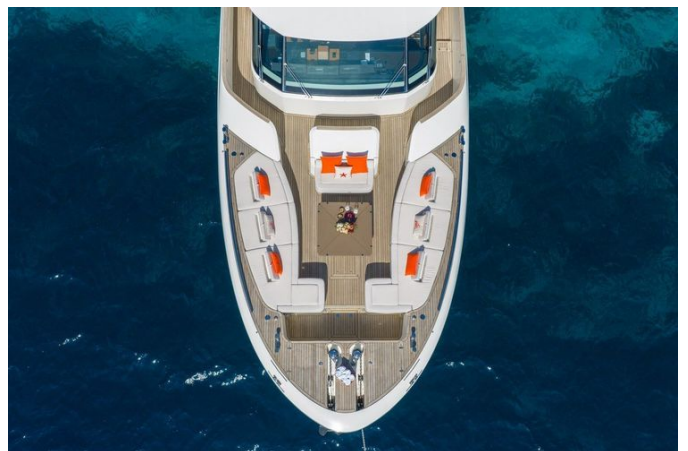

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Machinery

Twin MAN V12-1800 (D2862LE436) main engines, each showing 1,547 hours, deliver the yacht's primary drive through a pair of ZF 3050 V gearboxes with a 2.520:1 ratio and a V-drive shaft arrangement, engineered for smooth, efficient propulsion. Onboard electrical generation is handled by two Kohler 28EFOZD units, each rated at 27 kW, with the port generator recording 3,319 hours and the starboard 3,560 hours; fuel consumption is approximately 10 L/h per generator at full load, and shore power capability is provided at 115/230 V / 50 Hz. The battery installation includes 24 V for main engine starts, 12 V for generator starting and a dedicated 24 V circuit for emergency service, while climate comfort is assured by a chilled-water marine air-conditioning system. Supporting systems comprise a Sea Recovery Aquamatic 1400 watermaker, Humphree Interceptor trim and list control integrated with a Seakeeper SK9 gyro stabilizer for superior running attitude and roll reduction, hydraulic bow and stern thrusters and hydraulic steering. Fuel quality is maintained via a Racor fuel filtration system, and onboard services are backed by a black water holding tank arrangement and a pressurised fresh water system.

Navigation systems

The yacht's bridge is lavishly equipped with radar systems from Raymarine and Bonning, supported by a Raymarine gyrocompass and a Raymarine magnetic compass to ensure precise heading information. A Raymarine autopilot reliably maintains the chosen course, while GPS and plotter suites from Raymarine and Bonning offer accurate positioning and intuitive route management. Full situational awareness is rounded out by a Raymarine depth sounder and a Raymarine wind and speed log, providing the dependable instrumentation

needed for confident navigation in every condition.

Entertainment system

The yacht's multimedia arrangement has been crafted for effortless luxury, with three Panasonic televisions placed in the saloon, master and VIP areas, and a Samsung television installed on the flybridge to extend viewing al fresco. Content is delivered seamlessly through a PlayStation 5 Pro for gaming, Yamaha MusicCast for distributed audio, four Apple TV units and four IPTV receivers, ensuring streaming and entertainment are available in every zone. The acoustic setup is anchored by a Bowers & Wilkins system powered by four amplifiers driving ten Bowers & Wilkins speakers with one subwoofer, while a complementary Rockford Fosgate array supplies ten additional speakers and two subwoofers to broaden coverage and deepen the low end throughout the vessel.

Galley and laundry equipment

Engineered for effortless entertaining, the main galley is luxuriously appointed with Miele cooking equipment, an AEG refrigeration/freezer and a Miele dishwasher. The crew galley and mess reflect the same dependable specification, featuring Miele cooking equipment, Miele refrigeration/freezer and supplementary Miele appliances throughout. Other galley areas are similarly furnished with Miele cooking equipment, Miele refrigeration/freezer and additional Miele units, creating a cohesive fit-out that simplifies service across the vessel. Completing the fit-out, the main laundry is equipped with Miele.

Tenders & toys

A refined array of tenders and water toys transforms every anchorage into a private playground, beginning with a Surmarine four-meter tender propelled by a sixty-horsepower Suzuki outboard. Dive equipment is minimal, comprising a swimming suit, while adrenaline seekers will relish the Spark 90 jet ski and two Seabobs. Guests can also enjoy a waterski, two subs, two canoes, a ringo and a flyer disc, offering a versatile mix of relaxed exploration and high-energy water fun.

Deck equipment

All deck operations are executed with precision by a matched pair of Maxwell anchor windlasses working in concert with two Maxwell aft warping capstans, and the yacht carries two Ultra anchors, each backed by two 100 m lengths of chain. Tender movements are handled with ease by one boat crane and davits, while guest embarkation is conducted with refinement via an Opacmare passerelle. Aft, a hydraulic swimming platform enhances sea access and is complemented by three inflatables.

Security, fire fighting & safety equipment

A refined suite of security and safety systems ensures peace of mind aboard, beginning with a discreet CCTV arrangement of three cameras feeding five strategically positioned monitors to deliver uninterrupted surveillance of the vessel's most important zones. Fire protection is provided by a comprehensive fire control installation, augmented by portable extinguishers and a network of integrated alarms distributed throughout the yacht. For lifesaving readiness the yacht carries two life rafts and six life rings ready for immediate deployment, together with one EPIRB for emergency position reporting and a

full complement of twelve flares, while dedicated medical equipment is kept on board to handle urgent care needs.

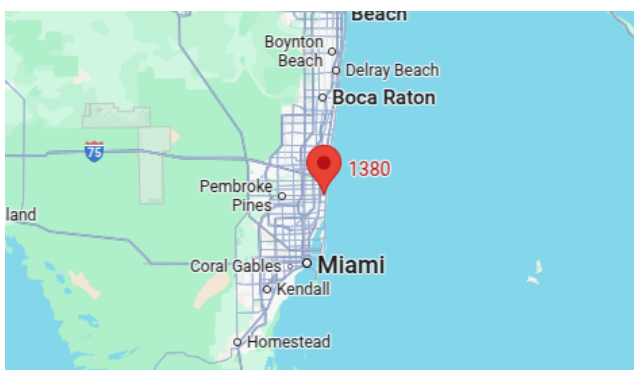
