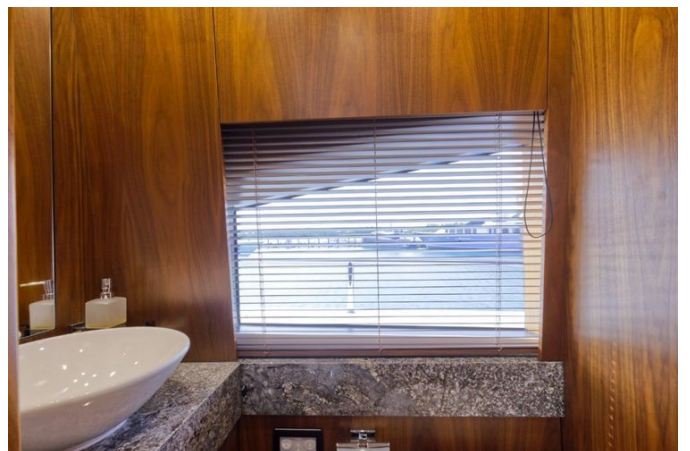

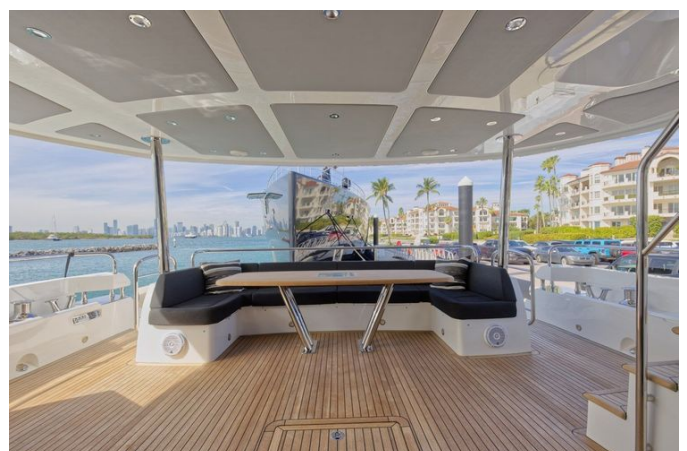

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Flybridge

---

Ascending from the aft deck via teak-laid molded stairs, you arrive on a flybridge finished in rich teak decking and sheltered beneath a carbon fiber hardtop with a retractable canvas sunroof, with a companionway flybridge hatch providing secure access. Relaxation is effortless with two large sunpads—one forward opposite the helm and another aft—and a square spa hot tub, while JL speakers set the soundtrack to every moment. Entertaining is equally refined at the three-stool wet bar appointed with a Victrifrigo ice maker, Waeco refrigerator, Kenyon BBQ grill, and Waeco Cool Box, complemented by a large U-settee with a teak table and an additional forward U-settee with a teak table. The helm station is equipped with full navigation electronics, including two Simrad chartplotter multifunction displays with GPS and radar, two Simrad speed, depth, and compass displays, a Simrad autopilot, and a Simrad VHF with DSC, all underscored by the authority of a Kahlenberg dual trumpet air horn.

## Helm and observation area

---

At the main helm console and observation area, two upholstered, electrically operated helm seats face a comprehensive command suite. Hydraulic power steering and digital engine instrumentation sit alongside fresh water and fuel gauges, trim tab controls, a magnetic compass, remote searchlight control, and the main AC/DC control and monitoring panel with generator controls, complemented by a dedicated monitoring panel for the fire detection system and a conveniently placed fire extinguisher. Three Hatteland System X displays—two for navigation and one for monitoring—anchor the glass-bridge, paired with two Simrad Halo compression radars, Simrad autopilot, Simrad

depth and speed displays, a Simrad VHF radio, Simrad AIS with integrated GPS receiver, and Simrad Go-Free wireless access for iPad. A manual side-opening door leads to the starboard side deck, while to port a sofa seat with table invites relaxed passage-making, enhanced by a 24-inch LG TV, a Fusion DVD/CD/radio, and Tropic Spec air conditioning.

## Deck equipment

---

On deck, a pair of stainless steel stern mooring bollards and fairleads lead the specification, complemented by a stainless steel bow roller with anchor stop and devil's claw and two Lewmar electric winches serving a Lewmar stainless steel anchor with 100 m chain feeding into the chain locker. Practicality meets polish with fore and aft deck wash outlets, a remote-controlled searchlight, and a Kahlenberg dual trumpet air horn with controls at the flybridge and main helms. Comfort is assured by a foredeck sun pad with folding backrest and foredeck bench seating with table, while a Besenzoni passerelle and expansive teak laid to the foredeck, aft side decks, swim platform, and flybridge elevate the yachting experience. Safety and convenience come courtesy of two eight-man liferafts with storage, stern docking floodlights, and a hydraulic lifting swim platform supported by a swim ladder and a hot and cold handheld swim shower, all beautifully accented at night by four blue underwater lights.

## Aft deck

---

The aft deck is finished in rich teak decking and centered around a handsome teak table, with a U-shaped bench offering generous seating and discreet storage below. A Sunbrella enclosure with isinglass windows shields the space from the elements, while stern safety gates and an engine room access hatch add purposeful peace of mind. Storage lockers are thoughtfully integrated, and 24-volt overhead LED lighting with dimmers sets the mood from bright

practicality to evening ambiance. Entertainment is delivered through JL speakers, and precise maneuvering comes courtesy of a third-station engine control with engine throttles, stop/start, and thruster control, complemented by two Lewmar stern docking winches.

## Main salon and dining area

---

Bathed in the warm glow of satin-finished American black walnut interior joinery, the main salon and dining area is grounded by an American walnut sole that sets a refined tone. From the aft deck, a stainless steel framed sliding glass door ushers you inside, while a sliding glass door opens to the side deck balcony and an additional sliding door leads to the starboard side deck with balcony, encouraging seamless indoor-outdoor living. Opposing settees with cocktail tables invite conversation beneath floor-to-ceiling windows to port and starboard, all complemented by powered blinds for effortless ambiance. Entertainment is cinematic, with a 75-inch Samsung LED TV in the dining area paired to a Bose Lifestyle cinema surround system and a Pioneer Blu-Ray. Formal occasions are centered around a dining table with seating for up to eight, complemented by a sideboard cabinet for elegant service. Forward, a wet bar with three stools, a U-line refrigerator, and a wine cooler keeps refreshments at hand, while a conveniently located day head completes this sophisticated social hub.

## Galley

---

Positioned on deck to port side, the galley is outfitted for serious cruising with a Frigoboat refrigerator/freezer, a Miele four-burner ceramic cooktop, a Miele microwave, a Miele oven, and a Miele dishwasher, all efficiently ventilated by a Bosch exhaust fan. A stainless steel sink anchors the workspace amid generous cupboards, drawers, and top-box locker storage, while eight

dinnerware and cutlery place settings are neatly accommodated. Illumination is provided by 24v LED overhead lighting, and safety is prioritized with a sensor connected to the fire detection system, a fire blanket, a fire extinguisher, and a first aid kit. Comfort is assured by Tropic Air conditioning, and a manual side opening door leads directly to the port side deck for convenient service and natural ventilation.

## Accommodations

---

Designed for refined privacy and effortless flow, this yacht offers four ensuite staterooms plus crew quarters aft. The VIP suite enjoys private access forward from the main helm area, while the master suite and two guest cabins are reached via an amidships stairway that invites a graceful transition from deck to sanctuary.

Amidships, the master suite centers on a commanding centerline king berth with generous storage below, flanked by two nightstands. A large walk-in closet with hanging rails, drawers, and shelves accommodates extended cruising with ease. Entertainment is curated through a 55" Samsung TV and a Harmon Kardon Blu-ray/DVD/CD/FM radio with stereo speakers. A vanity table with stool, two sofa seats with a breakfast table, and a panoramic window with opening portholes elevate comfort, while the en suite head features a stall shower for a spa-like finish.

The guest accommodations to port and starboard are thoughtfully appointed. The starboard cabin presents a double berth with storage beneath and a 32" Samsung TV, while the port cabin offers twin berths with a sliding conversion to create a double and a 24" LG TV. Each includes a night stand, a hanging locker, and a Harmon Kardon Blu-ray/DVD/CD/FM radio with stereo speakers, plus an en suite head with a stall shower to ensure every guest enjoys complete independence.

Forward, the VIP suite is an inviting retreat with private entry from the helm

area. It features a centerline queen berth with storage below, a walk-in closet, ample storage cabinets, and a 40" Samsung TV paired with a Harmon Kardon Blu-ray/DVD/CD/FM radio and stereo speakers. The en suite head includes a stall shower for effortless comfort.

Aft, the crew quarters are accessed via a transom entry and comprise two over/under twin-berth cabins served by a 24" LG TV and a Fusion DVD/CD/Radio with stereo speakers. Practical amenities include a Miele washer and dryer and a dedicated crew lounge with a Waeco refrigerator and a Whirlpool microwave oven, complemented by a head with shower to support professional service and extended voyages.

## Mechanical

---

Power comes from twin MTU 12V 2000 M96L engines delivering 1,950 hp each, safeguarded by dedicated fuel filters and water separators serving both the main engines and the generators, complemented by a Separ fuel polishing system to ensure pristine fuel quality. Poise and control are assured with Sleipner hydraulic stabilizers featuring at-anchor stabilization, while precise maneuvering is delivered by Sleipner hydraulic bow and stern thrusters. Ease of maintenance is built in with an oil change system for the engines, gearboxes, and generators, a standby fresh water pump, and pre-installed plumbing and wiring ready for a future water maker. Safety systems include a manual and automatic fire extinguishing system integrated with the engines and generators, automatic bilge and flood pumps with high-level alarms, robust exhaust fans, generator exhaust silencers and water separators, and a sensor connected to the fire detection system. Comfort in any climate is maintained by tropical specification air conditioning.

## Electrical

---

The yacht's electrical architecture is engineered for quiet reliability, led by two 29 kW Onan generators showing 220 hours as of May 2022 and an isolation transformer that safeguards shore power connections. An electrical seamless transfer system keeps the A/V equipment uninterrupted, while a 24v DC network with full circuit-breaker protection underpins all onboard systems. Energy reserves are generous, with eight 24v starter batteries and twelve 24v domestic batteries, managed by automatic battery charge distribution and remote battery switches controlled from the aft cockpit locker. Charging and inversion are handled by a 120 amp battery charger/inverter for 24v circuits and a separate 200 amp battery charger/inverter for 24v circuits, ensuring abundant power delivery and rapid replenishment. Hot water demands are met by three 2 kW immersion heaters for the water heater, and AC sockets are thoughtfully positioned throughout the boat.

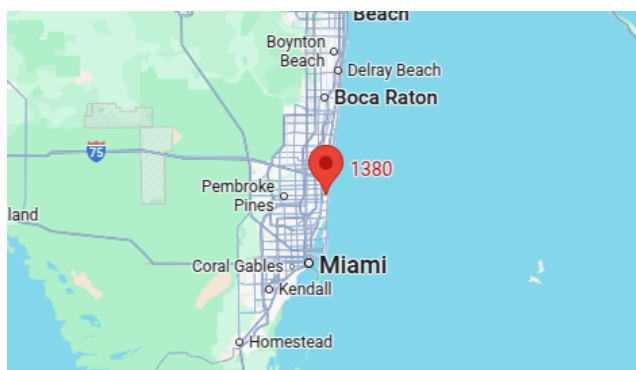
