OVERVIEW

The Bree, an 86-foot Merritt enclosed-flybridge sportfishing yacht, marries the refinement of a luxury motor yacht with the raw capability of a world-class tournament battlegon. Its fully enclosed bridge provides a sheltered sanctuary for owners and guests, affording sweeping sightlines and easy conversation while protecting from sun, wind, and spray. When seas turn challenging, a Seakeeper gyro stabilizer keeps motion remarkably composed, and potent Caterpillar C32A propulsion paired with a substantial 3,300-gallon fuel capacity yields long-range capability without excessive consumption. Purpose-built to pursue blue marlin and sailfish on the biggest stages, this bespoke sportfish is equipped with next-generation electronics and high-performance tackle, including Omni sonar, to sharpen the edge in any billfish arena.

The owners' insistence on perfection is evident in every detail, reflecting meticulous maintenance and uncompromising standards. The interior plan of five staterooms and five heads is arranged to maximize comfort and privacy, with an elegant primary suite featuring a dual-sink head as a focal point of refined living. The salon centers on an island-style bar that beckons entertaining and casual meal preparation, supported by premium appliances, sophisticated fixtures, and an oversized pantry designed for extended passages. Six Sub-Zero refrigeration units manage provisions with ease, while the cockpit is outfitted with two expansive freezers plus additional fridge/freezer combinations to support serious offshore campaigns.

Hallmark Merritt joinery elevates the interiors, where rich woodwork and a striking custom spiral staircase sweep guests up to the flybridge. The helm reads as a streamlined command center, bristling with advanced systems and appointed with two oversized companion seats flanking the captain's chair for exceptional comfort underway; a drop-down TV provides an additional layer of

onboard entertainment. As a convertible sportfish, The Bree transitions effortlessly between bluewater cruising and dedicated offshore fishing duties. This vessel represents the fourth Merritt commissioned by these owners, and their pursuit of excellence resonates across performance, systems, finish, and fit. Rarely does a tournament-ready enclosed-flybridge sportfisher of this pedigree and condition appear on the market—an outstanding opportunity to own one of the most impeccably maintained custom sportfishing yachts afloat.
























DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Stabilization

A Seakeeper SK 2600 resides in a self-contained compartment below the cockpit deck, delivering whisper-quiet gyroscopic stabilization to keep the yacht composed at rest and underway. Hours: 5,100.

Generators

Twin Kohler 40 kW generators, new in 2019, provide dependable, balanced ship's power. Hours: Port 1730, Stbd 1735.

Electronics

On the flybridge, the integrated helm suite features four 19" 8530 GARMIN screens black box with US charts, one 6FT GARMIN 25KW radar, one 4FT GARMIN 6KW radar, one SIMRAD AP70 auto pilot, one FLIR M-625L thermal/lowlight night vision camera, two ICOM M506-31 VHF radios, one AIRMAR PM411 transducer, one AIRMAR B275 CHRIP transducer, and one FURUNO OMNI sonar. In the tower, navigation and control are extended with one 17" 8612 GARMIN plotter, one 15" 7600 GARMIN plotter, one SIMRID auto pilot, and two ICOM COMAND MIC VHF units. The aft station is equally well equipped with one 20" 8612 GARMIN plotter and two ICOM COMAND MIC VHF for confident docking and maneuvering. Entertainment and connectivity flow throughout the vessel via a Starlink marine mobile dish, a KVH satellite communication dome, a KVH tracvision direct tv dome, Direct tv receivers in all staterooms, a Crestron control system, a Kaleidoscope movie storage hard drive, Apple TV, an Apple ship computer, TVs with surround sound in all staterooms, headphone jacks in the master and salon, and cameras

monitoring the bow, stern, mezzanine, and engine room. Additional equipment elevates capability further with a CAT 360 system w/joystick maneuvering, and dynamic positioning, an Asea transformer power system, a Wards electric control panel, a water maker reverse osmosis system, a Spot zero water purifier, a Headhunter tank sensor system, Humpfree trimtabs, 2 Dometic Eskimo ice makers, and a Hooker electric livewell system with on deck tuna tube hook up.

Fishing equipment

Tournament-ready hardware includes 2 hooker electric Shimano electric teaser reels in the tower and 2 Miya Eroch US-9 electric teaser reels on the flybridge aft. In the cockpit, a Blue water marlin fighting chair pairs with a Blue water sailfish rocket launcher, supported by an 80 gallon indeck livewell and Pipe welders 47' four spreader hydraulic outriggers that pull a powerful spread. Tackle is impeccably organized in a 37 piece fishing rod storage with custom reels storage for 30's, 50's, 80's, spinning reels, and electric reels.

Maintenance & updates

Meticulous care and recent upgrades underscore turn-key readiness: 10/24 ceramic coated all painted surfaces; 10/24 updated all components of Seakeeper to newest models; 10/24 replaced Seakeeper bushings; 9/24 main engines serviced; 9/24 generators serviced; 6/24 replaced washer and dryer to updated Samsung model; 6/24 all new mezzanine cushions; 5/24 complete new coat of varnish on cockpit, aft flybridge, and half rounds; 04/23 ward electric replaced 5 power modules in Asea transformer (10,000 each); 02/23 replace both De'Angelo exhaust risers and gaskets; 08/22 stripped all varnish and rebuilt back up; 09/21 repainted forward black mask; 03/20 install new kohler 40kw generator; 02/20 updated tower and aft station Garmin monitors;

02/20 furuno Omni sonar installed; 10/19 both twin disc transmission replaced.

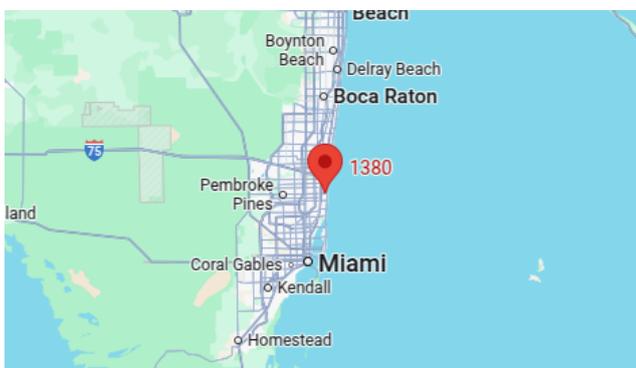
