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## OVERVIEW

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Offered to the market for the first time by her original owners, the 2005 86' West Bay SonShip DAWN TREADER VII is presented with moorage and has been conceived from the keel up for confident owner operator use. Scaled and equipped so a couple can comfortably handle long passages, she reflects the owners' active involvement during design and construction, with every decision made to honor their preferences while preserving the build integrity, seakeeping characteristics, and performance expected of a yacht of this calibre. The result is a distinct raised pilothouse motor yacht that combines refined lines with practical engineering, where each living and leisure space benefits from deliberate ergonomics, clear sightlines, smooth circulation and an expansive, welcoming ambience, all executed in the fine joinery and finish for which West Bay SonShip is renowned.

Systems and overall specification were selected and integrated to simplify routine operation and boost reliability, making DAWN TREADER VII an ideal platform for an owner who prefers hands on stewardship yet desires the capacity to entertain family and guests with ease. Accommodation is generous and thoughtfully arranged to sleep nine guests across three private staterooms, complemented by well appointed crew quarters that ensure professional service and privacy when required.

Her cruising history has been exclusively in Pacific Northwest waters under the steady care of a full time maintenance captain and a dedicated yacht care specialist, ensuring meticulous attention to detail. Propulsion is provided by twin 2005 Detroit Diesel MTU 12V2000 engines, each rated at 1,500 hp and recording just under 650 hours, while electrical support comes from twin 25 kW generators, both with under 850 hours, underpinning dependable operation whether underway or at anchor.

Widely respected for its pedigree, the West Bay SonShip name represents

decades of accomplished yachtbuilding, and this bespoke DAWN TREADER VII stands among the marque's most compelling creations of the last forty years — a seaworthy, elegant motor yacht that harmonizes performance, luxury and straightforward ownership. The prospective purchaser will be offered first right of refusal to retain the current slip at Port Sidney Marina.

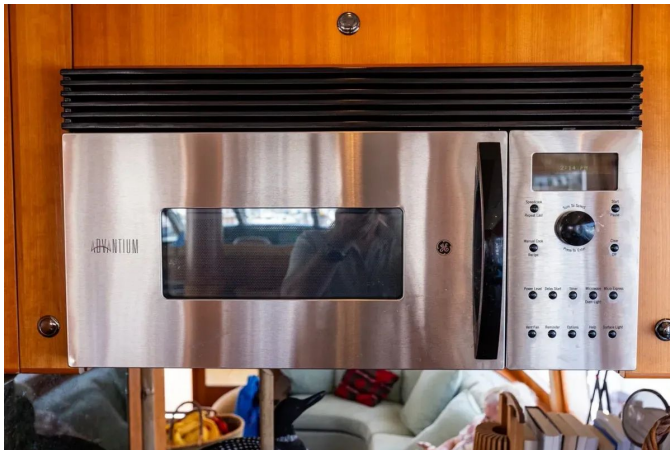


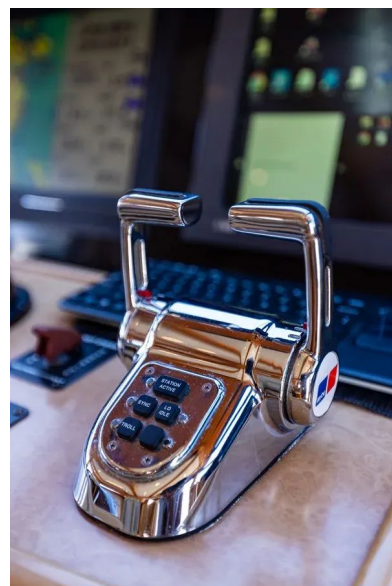






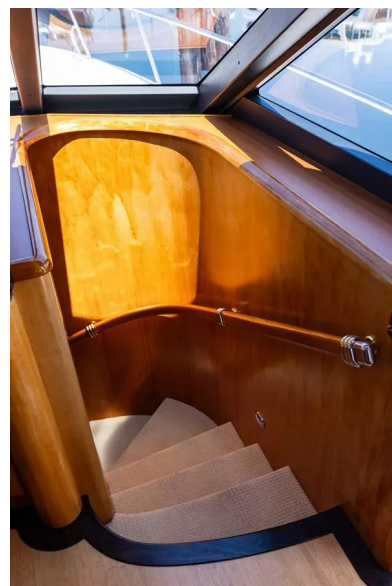
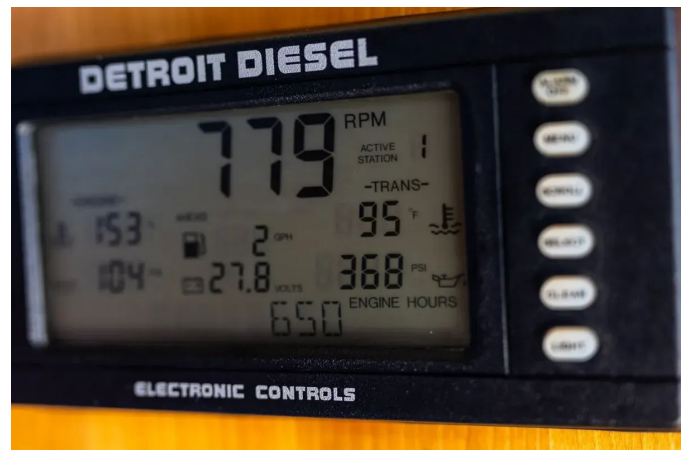


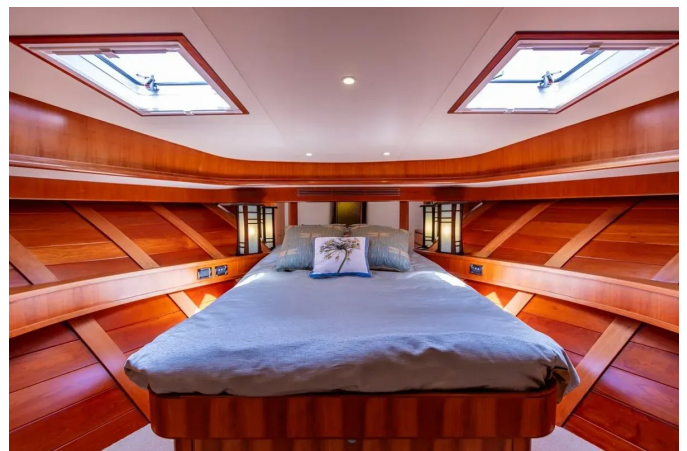
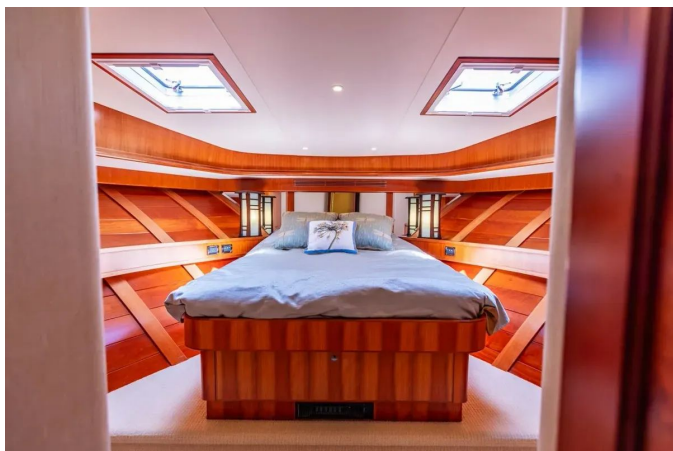
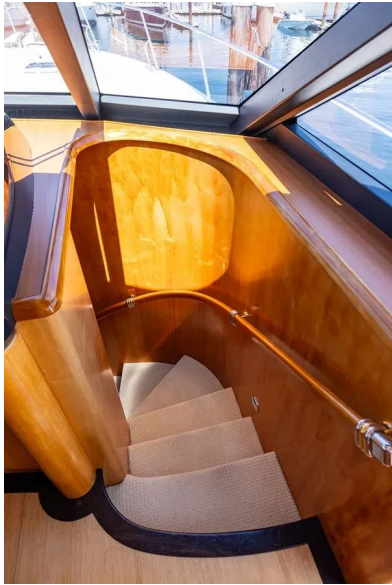








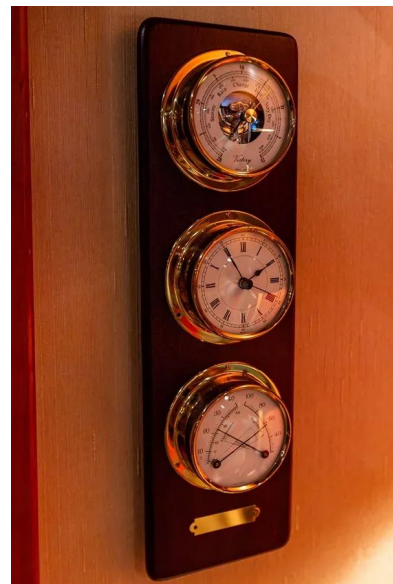


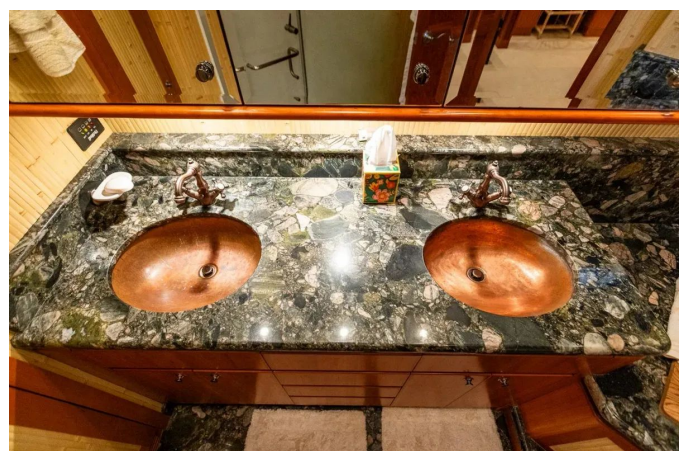




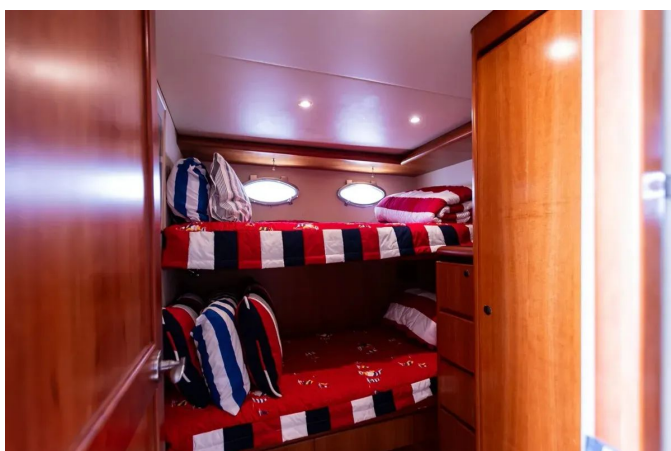














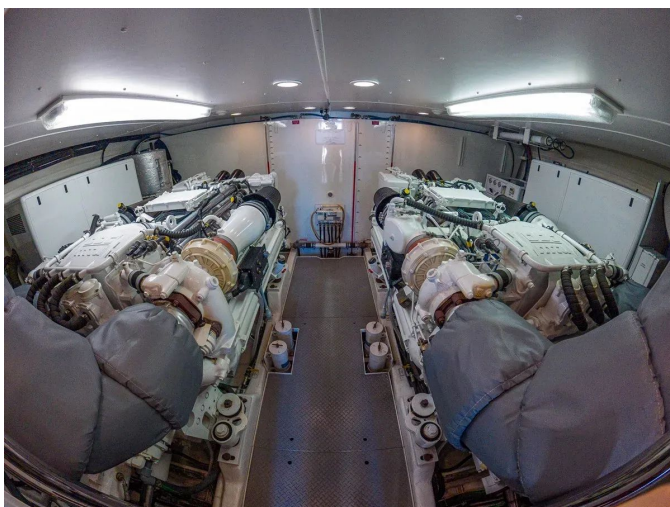
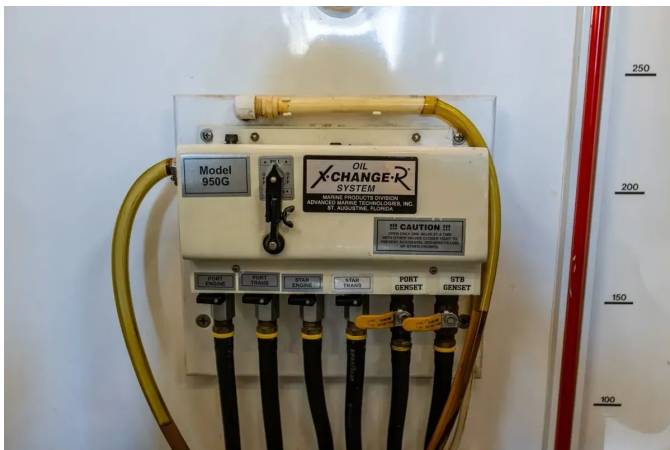
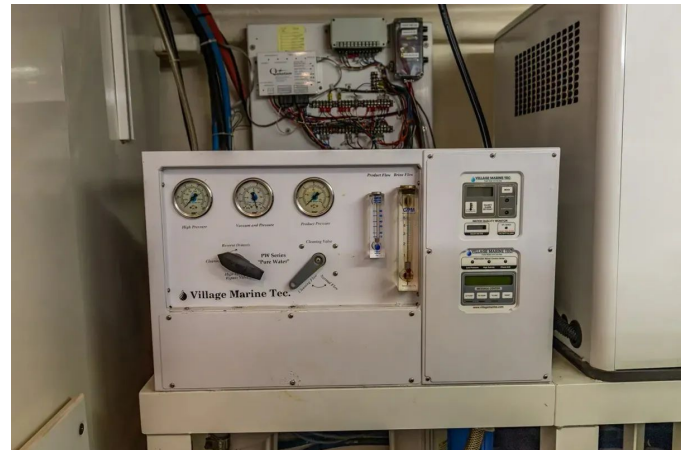


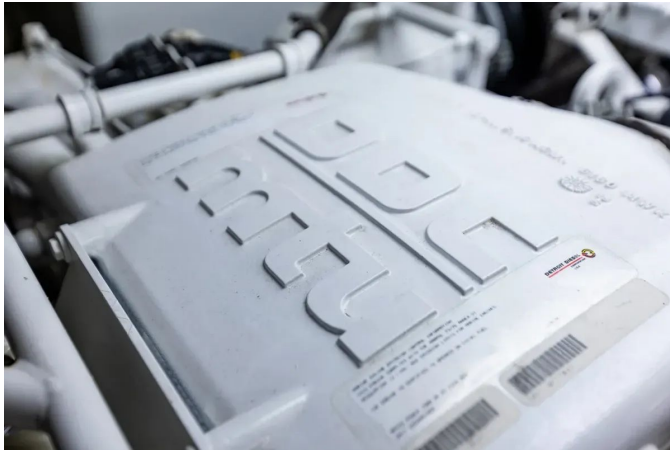
















# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

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## Design elements

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An integrated Command Bridge hardtop is enveloped in a "clear-eze" poly carbon enclosure, creating a protected upper deck that shelters a Command Bridge "futon pad" lounge ideal for evenings beneath the stars and that directly adjoins a bridge-area hot tub. Below, a massive gourmet galley, centered around a serving bar with stools, establishes the social heart of the yacht, while a cruising dinette in the pilothouse, equipped with an expanding table for dining, gaming, or comfortable off-season passages, adapts with ease to every itinerary. A lower-deck library and reading space offers a serene retreat, and the full-beam owner's suite includes a dedicated space for the piano plus a Japanese style soaking tub within the owner's head compartment, reinforcing the piano's presence in the owner's cabin. The portside guest cabin has been upgraded to enhance extended-family comfort, and the generous crew cabin is thoughtfully appointed with family-minded comforts throughout.

## Electronics

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An AIS transponder and a pair of VHF units form the foundation of an advanced electronics package, with an autopilot seamlessly integrated into a full navigation center running Time Zero Nav charts to ensure precise route keeping. High-resolution position and situational awareness are delivered by GPS and radar, complemented by a dedicated plotter and a traditional compass, while a log-speedometer and depthsounder provide essential performance and under-keel information; instruments for wind speed and direction and a network of repeaters distribute these critical data points throughout the yacht. Onboard leisure and connectivity are equally well catered for, with a flat-screen TV alongside an additional television set, a DVD

player, a VCR and a CD player, all supported by cockpit speakers, Wi-Fi and an onboard computer for seamless entertainment and online access. Communications remain robust with four radios carried to ensure reliable contact wherever the voyage leads.

## Inside equipment

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Meticulously appointed for effortless living and reliable performance, the interior systems blend comfort with capability: a high-capacity air compressor together with Cruise Aire reverse cycle air conditioning provide exacting temperature control while two diesel furnaces supply efficient heating. Electrical resilience is maintained by two battery chargers, and true autonomy is supported by a fresh water maker and onboard hot water. The galley is fitted for refined provisioning with a refrigerator, deep freezer, dishwasher, microwave oven and oven, all aided by a sea water pump, and laundry is handled by a washing machine with a separate dryer. Precision handling is assured by Key Power Hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, dewatering is managed by an electric bilge pump, and the sanitary accommodations include two electric heads, one of which is a Vacuflush designated for the crew.

## Additional equipment

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A selection of carefully chosen amenities enhances onboard life, from a calming Jacuzzi located on the open deck for alfresco relaxation to a secluded private office paired with a refined library conceived for focused work and quiet contemplation; expansive full walk-around decks complete the offering, enabling effortless circulation and uninterrupted panoramic views.

## Outside equipment/extras

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On deck the yacht pairs sumptuous comfort with thoughtful functionality: plush cockpit cushions and a convenient cockpit shower cater to relaxed days aboard, while a high-gloss finished teak cockpit table forms an elegant focal point for outdoor entertaining. Launching and recovering the tender is straightforward with a Steelhead davit rated at 1,500 lb, and seakeeping is improved by a Wes Mar fin stabilizer. A swimming ladder provides effortless access to the water, and extensive teak detailing elevates every walkway — a teak cockpit spans the aft deck, transom step and flybridge, with matching teak sidedecks extending across those same areas. Rounding out the exterior equipment, a 2015 Grand S520L RIB tender powered by a 90 hp Yamaha is ready for excursions ashore.

## Covers

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A sculpted Hard Top fitted with a Carbon Poly Enclosure delivers formidable, all-weather shelter while preserving the yacht's pristine, uninterrupted profile and expansive panoramic views.

## Electrical equipment

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A dependable and refined power system is installed aboard, featuring a matched pair of 25kW N Lights generators complemented by two inverters to ensure smooth, continuous operation; when berthed, twin 50/240 shore power inlets provide seamless plug in connectivity for shore-side power.

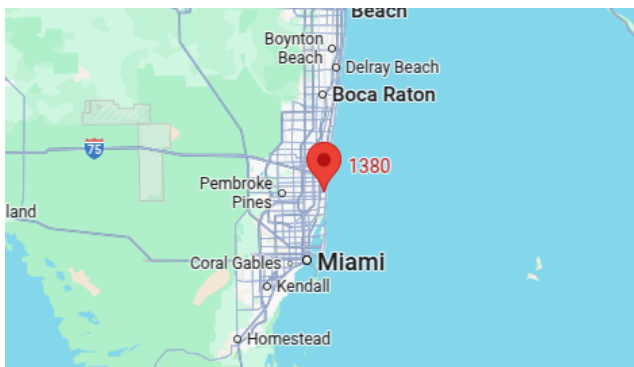
