OVERVIEW

THYKE, a 26.76-metre Sanlorenzo SL86 launched in 2019, epitomizes refined motor-yacht elegance; her thoughtfully arranged flybridge provides an inviting, harmonious space for relaxation and entertaining, while accommodation for eight guests is distributed across four en-suite cabins and crowned by a generous full-beam owner's suite, with Zero Speed electric stabilisers delivering composed motion underway and the same serene steadiness at anchor.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Detailed description

THYKE is a 26.76-metre Sanlorenzo SL86 motor yacht, delivered in 2019, her lines refined and contemporary, with a harmonious flybridge arrangement and generous exterior living areas that make her an ideal platform for private cruising around the Mediterranean. The exterior programme is spread across the flybridge, main deck and bow, with the flybridge conceived as the principal open-air entertaining space — generous sunpads, a dining area and relaxed seating sit beneath a hardtop finished with a powered louvre roof that offers flexible shelter and ventilation.

On the main deck the aft cockpit opens straight into the saloon, creating a fluid connection between interior and exterior living, while a hydraulic swim platform provides smooth, comfortable access to the water for swimmers and tenders alike. Accommodation is laid out for up to eight guests across four en-suite cabins: a full beam Owner's stateroom is positioned amidships on the lower deck and includes a walk-in wardrobe and private bathroom, accompanied by a forward VIP cabin and two twin guest cabins situated between the Owner's suite and the bow, one of which features sliding berths to form a double. Crew quarters sleep three in two separate cabins.

THYKE is powered by a pair of MTU 12V2000M96L engines, each producing 1,947 HP, and the yacht's systems are specified for comfort and ease of handling with Zero Speed electric stabilising fins, hydraulic bow and stern thrusters and a fixed third MTU control station located in the cockpit. Onboard equipment includes a Raymarine Diamond navigation package, an electro hydraulic passerelle, a hydraulic swim platform, a 180 L/h watermaker, 4G Wi-Fi, satellite TV antenna and CCTV. Full specifications and private viewings are available upon request.

Layout & accommodation

Accommodating up to eight guests within four sumptuous staterooms, the yacht has been arranged to deliver both seclusion and comfort in equal measure. Each guest cabin is appointed with its own en-suite bathroom, while the full-beam Owner's cabin, positioned amidships on the lower deck, boasts a spacious walk-in wardrobe and a private bathroom. A refined forward VIP cabin on the lower deck offers an elegant private retreat, and situated between the Owner's suite and the bow are two twin guest cabins, one of which features sliding berths that effortlessly convert into a double. The professional crew are quartered in two cabins configured for a three-person team, served by a single dedicated crew head.

Machinery & technical equipment

Twin MTU 12V2000M96L diesel powerplants drive the yacht, each producing 1,947 HP and currently showing 1,000 h on the main engines. Comfort is assured both underway and at anchor by Zero Speed electric stabilising fins, while a hydraulic bow thruster and hydraulic stern thruster deliver confident, responsive maneuvering; a fixed third MTU control station in the cockpit provides precise handling when required. Onboard electrical supply comes from two generators—one rated at 26 kW and the other at 25 kW—each recording 2,500 h. Extended autonomy is supported by a 180 L/h watermaker and a 100 L stainless steel hot-water boiler.

Navigation & communications

Helm and vessel control center on the Raymarine Diamond navigation package, with the interior dashboard appointed with two 12-inch multifunction colour displays and the flybridge helm furnished with an additional 12-inch

multifunction colour display. Core navigation and safety instruments include autopilot, AIS, a dedicated GPS antenna, a wind transducer and rudder angle indicators provided at both the internal helm and the flybridge, while voice and VHF data communications are available from the interior station and the flybridge. Enhanced situational awareness is delivered by a 48-inch, 72 nm open array radar antenna, complemented by a Sanshin searchlight operable from both the flybridge and the internal wheelhouse, and a comprehensive CCTV installation comprising two fixed cameras in the engine room and one fixed camera in the cockpit. Onboard connectivity and entertainment are assured with a 4G Wi-Fi internet system and an ST24E satellite TV antenna.

Exterior and deck equipment

Every exterior detail is crafted for effortless enjoyment on the water, beginning with a hydraulic swim platform that ensures simple sea access and an electro-hydraulic passerelle with teak grating and a stainless steel frame that delivers seamless boarding. A discreet tender garage houses the Williams tender, preserving the yacht's clean profile while allowing rapid launch. The aft cockpit converts at the touch of a button thanks to an electric hi/low table, and the flybridge offers refined open-air living beneath a hardtop with a powered louvre roof, complete with a bar cabinet, refrigerator, ice maker and Teppanyaki grill for elevated entertaining. Forward, the bow lounge beckons with an expandable table and manual hi/low movement, and after a swim a hot and cold aft deck shower and manual bathing ladder provide welcome convenience. Four underwater lights bathe the stern in sophisticated illumination at dusk, shore power is handled by a Glendinning CM7 cabledmaster, and precise manoeuvring in port and at anchor is assured by two electric mooring winches and two reversible anchor windlasses.

Interior, galley & laundry

Sumptuously appointed interior spaces open to a main saloon fitted with electrically operated curtains, the same effortless control extending to the owner's cabin and the VIP cabin for seamless privacy and ambiance. The galley is fully equipped for gourmet service, featuring a hob, extractor hood, double sink with mixer, dishwasher, garbage disposal, oven and fridge/freezer, while a dedicated saloon refrigerator and a 23-bottle wine cooler ensure provisions and selected vintages are kept at perfect serving temperatures. Practicality for the crew is also considered, with a washing machine and dryer thoughtfully located to provide efficient, discreet service.
