OVERVIEW

2009 Sunseeker 86 Yacht, lying in Hong Kong, offered at USD 1,850,000 (approx. HKD 14.4M). This refined flybridge motor yacht marries performance, comfort and style, presenting itself to discerning owners as a superior planing motor cruiser.

Her propulsion comprises twin MTU engines, showing roughly 3,300 hours (Q4 2023), and she is supported by two 28kW KOHLER generators, a combination that ensures quiet, dependable cruising and the assured manners expected from a premium yacht of this class. A vigilant, hands-on owner together with professional yacht management has maintained her to a high standard, and she wears a striking deep navy-blue hull, an iconic Sunseeker choice that underscores her presence at sea.

The interior and layout are flexible and guest-focused, offering four guest cabins: a full-beam Master, a generous VIP and two Guest suites, while two crew cabins (four berths) located adjacent to the engine room facilitate efficient, crewed operations. Inside, rich dark oak joinery infuses every space with a glamorous, quintessentially British character. The saloon provides ample lounge seating and an eight-place dining table to starboard invites leisurely meals whether at anchor or underway.

Above, the flybridge delivers abundant fixed seating and a versatile aft zone configured for loose furniture, ideal for arranging beanbags, loungers or modular pieces to suit each occasion. Further enhancing her appeal, she holds a Hong Kong charter licence, making her immediately suitable as a charter-ready superyacht when not in private use. A standout example of the sought-after Sunseeker 86, available immediately. Luxury yacht. Charter yacht. Crewed yacht. Flybridge superyacht.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Details

Step aboard to an interior conceived for effortless cruising and gracious entertaining, where the Main Deck saloon welcomes you with oak furniture and a cream leather sofa served by a high low TV system that disappears at the touch of a button, while an adjacent dining area presents a dining table for eight complemented by a small side coffee table for four, ideal for relaxed conversation before or after meals. Practicality meets poise with an indoor helm station for climate controlled navigation, a convenient day head, and curtains across all window areas to ensure privacy and comfort, and movement around the yacht is intuitive thanks to access at both port and starboard to the side companionway. On the Lower Deck the night spaces are thoughtfully arranged to welcome family and guests, with one master bedroom featuring an ensuite and a double bed, one VIP bedroom with an ensuite and a double bed, and two guest bedrooms each furnished with two single beds; the crew enjoys dedicated quarters in two crew cabins, each with two berths, providing a total of four crew berths to ensure impeccable service while maintaining guest privacy. The galley is comprehensively equipped for extended stays at sea, including one SAMSUNG full height fridge with freezer, BOSCH electric stoves with oven, and a WHIRLPOOL extractor fan, allowing the chef to work with confidence and efficiency. Outside, a navy blue hull paired with a white superstructure sets a timeless tone, the Main Deck cockpit finished with a teak wood deck and an inviting teak outdoor dining table with sofa for al fresco meals at anchor or underway, while forward the Main Deck bow area provides a welcoming sofa and a sunbed area with cushion for unhurried afternoons in the sun. Above, the flybridge combines leisure and control with an upper deck helm station, an outdoor flybridge bar equipped

with a BBQ grill, fridge, ice maker and sink, a retractable roof top with fabric for shade on demand, and loose furniture arranged with a coffee table to create a flexible lounge in the breeze. Underway and at anchor, robust systems work quietly in the background: propulsion is delivered by two MTU engines with around 3,300 hours on the clock (as of Q4 2023), supported by two 28 kW (28EFOZD) KOHLER generators for reliable onboard power, precision maneuvering comes courtesy of AMERICAN BOW THRUSTER bow and stern thrusters while a TRAC fin stabilizer enhances comfort underway, and systems such as an electric windlass with anchor, air conditioning in saloon and cabins, a hydraulic swimming platform and a VICTRON ENERGY inverter underpin easy handling and versatile power management. For confident navigation the yacht is fitted with RAYMARINE navigation instruments, including a plotter, depth sensor, speed sensor and water temperature sensor, complemented by a search light for enhanced safety after dusk and a VHF station at the lower helm station to keep communication clear when it matters most.

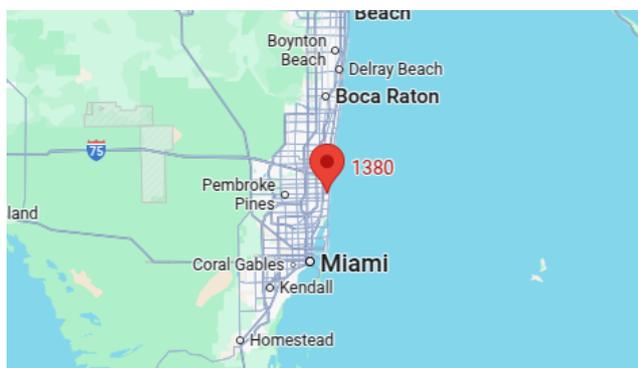
