OVERVIEW

Built in GRP by the distinguished Italian shipyard Arno and launched in 2007, MAZAG is a graceful example of Andrea Bacigalupo's refined exterior and interior design language, belonging to the celebrated Leopard 27 series. The yacht's interior is bright and generously proportioned, finished with contemporary styling and premium materials that create an atmosphere of understated luxury. Arranged across three well-appointed cabins—a sumptuous master suite, a comfortable double and a twin—the accommodation is laid out for serene privacy, each cabin fitted with entertainment systems, televisions and en suite bathroom facilities; the standard layout comfortably sleeps six guests, with the twin cabin offering a pullman berth to increase capacity to seven. Outside, the generous open aft deck invites alfresco dining and lounging on a large sunbed, with effortless access to the swim platform for water sports, while the forepeak is furnished with cushioned seating beneath a small Bimini for secluded sunbathing. The upper saloon's expansive windows and electric retractable roof bathe the interior in light and frame sweeping views, creating a relaxed social hub with plush seating, a full entertainment centre and a dedicated dining area; below decks, an additional lounge with an LCD television further enhances onboard living. Propulsion comes from twin MTU 16V2000M92 engines, each rated at 2,180 hp, driving Arneson surface drives to deliver a notable cruising speed of 34 knots.

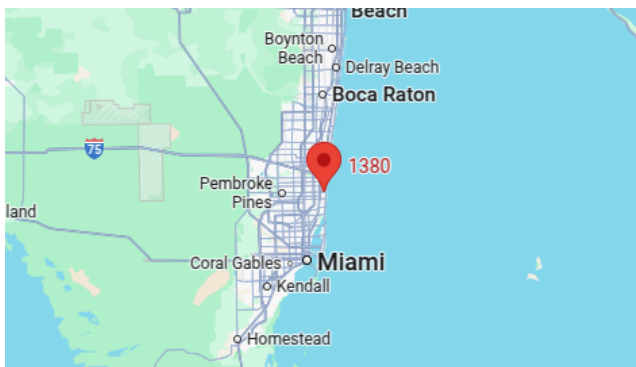
