OVERVIEW

This beautifully upgraded Azimut Grande 27M marries expansive onboard volume with signature Italian lines and a highly functional, thoughtfully arranged layout. Having served in the charter market under meticulous stewardship, she has recently undergone an extensive mechanical renewal, the focal point being a pair of factory-new MAN V12 engines installed in June 2025. Constructed to US specification and fitted with a converter, she arrives as a turnkey superyacht ideal for buyers seeking a luxury flybridge motor yacht with distinguished pedigree, modern systems, and substantial recent enhancements.

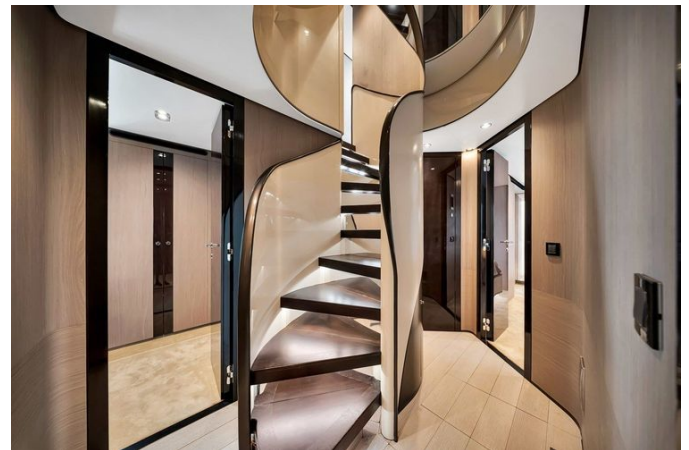
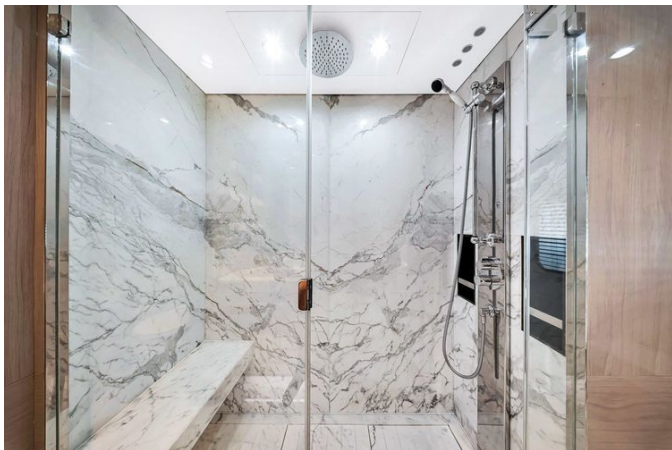




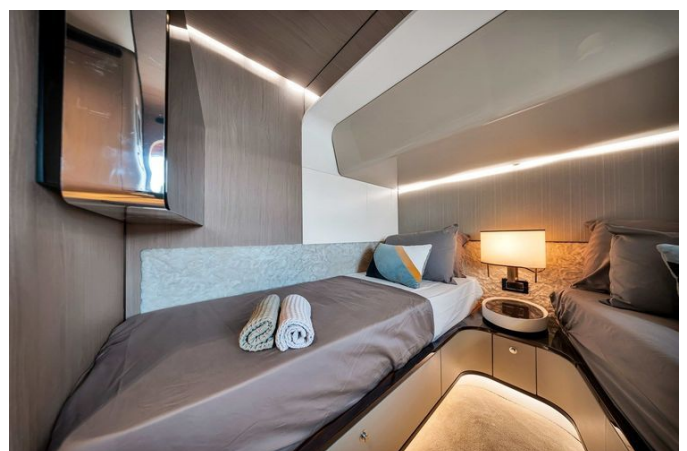














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Introduction

This exceptional Azimut Grande 27M marries sumptuous comfort with assured performance and expansive volume, presenting a refined platform for private ownership or continued charter operation. Maintained under professional charter management since delivery, she offers an attractive proposition for a purchaser seeking a yacht with an impeccable service record and significant recent investment. In June 2025 she received brand new MAN V12 engines, fitted and commissioned with full warranty coverage, currently recording only 200 hours and supported by a two year warranty valid through June 2027, an assurance that reinforces her mechanical integrity.

At 27.4 m / 88 ft overall with a beam of 6.4 m / 21 ft 7 in and a draft of 1.93 m / 6 ft 4 in, she delivers generous internal volume and gracious deck layouts while maintaining a comfortable cruising speed of approximately 19 kn. Constructed in GRP and powered by diesel propulsion, her engineering package is complemented by substantial tankage — 9,500 L / 2,510 gal of fuel and 2,000 L / 528 gal of fresh water — providing extended range and onboard comfort for longer passages.

The onboard arrangement is tailored for effortless entertaining and privacy, accommodating up to thirteen guests across five cabins with six heads, all planned to maximize space and seclusion. The electrical install is to US specifications with a converter fitted, and shore power management is handled by an ASEA converter that provides seamless transfer to maintain uninterrupted systems. Navigation and communication are comprehensive, centred on a Simrad package with AIS, augmented by Starlink broadband and a KVH TracVision UHD7 for dependable connectivity and onboard entertainment, while security is bolstered by a GOST monitoring system.

Manoeuvrability is simplified with a bow thruster and joystick docking control for precise handling in tight quarters.

Outdoor living spaces are designed for indulgence and versatility, with a flybridge that features a Jacuzzi, wet bar, alfresco dining and a retractable hardtop that converts between sun and shade at the touch of a button. A dedicated tender garage with an integrated launch system preserves deck space and streamlines water access and storage. Freshly refitted in 2025 and delivered turnkey, this Grande 27M—charter managed since new—is ready to meet the highest expectations from the moment you step aboard.

Interiors

The yacht's interior has been conceived to balance refined elegance with everyday practicality, offering accommodation for up to ten guests across five cabins with six heads. Entering the main salon, one is struck by an airy, contemporary ambience; full-height windows flood the space with daylight while warm wood tones, abundant lounge seating and an open-plan living and dining arrangement form an inviting social heart. Casual gatherings are catered for at a six-place table within the salon, while a separate dedicated dining setup seats eight for more formal entertaining.

Sleeping accommodation culminates in a full-beam on-deck master suite, appointed with expansive windows, a mirrored walk-in closet and a generous ensuite finished with his-and-hers basins. Below decks, the guest complement comprises two comfortable double cabins and two well-proportioned twin cabins, each with its own ensuite, ample natural light and high-quality finishes that continue the yacht's understated luxury.

The full-service galley is equipped to support serious culinary ambitions, featuring a wine cooler, dishwasher, induction hob and oven, while the wheelhouse benefits from upgraded navigation equipment to support confident passagemaking. Climate control is comprehensive, with

air-conditioning throughout and an air-conditioned engine room. Recent enhancements — including new carpets, interior paint touch-ups, refinished flooring details and refreshed finishes throughout — leave the interior feeling renewed and meticulously maintained.

Exteriors

Designed for gracious entertaining and unhurried open-air living, the exterior areas flow naturally from the flybridge to the cockpit, across the forward deck and down to the swim platform, forming a succession of refined social spaces that accommodate both lively gatherings and quiet repose. The flybridge is the crowning feature, fitted with a retractable hardtop and appointed with a Jacuzzi, a full wet bar, an alfresco dining setting, a built-in grill/BBQ and an icemaker to ensure gracious service without interruption. Generous lounging zones afford panoramic vistas while aft flybridge furnishings and an electric awning allow instant adjustment between sun and shade. Warm teak underfoot stretches throughout the exterior, leading to a welcoming cockpit with comfortable lounge seating and a dining table designed for leisurely meals, all illuminated by dimmable exterior lighting and protected when desired by an electric shade. Practical conveniences have been integrated into every moment on deck: a swim platform with shower and effortless water access, a tender garage equipped with a dedicated launch and recovery system, and underwater lights that lend a dramatic glow once night falls. Forward on the main deck a generous sunbathing area with a coffee table provides the perfect setting for daytime lounging and casual refreshments.

Engines & technical highlights

The vessel benefits from a meticulous programme of mechanical and electronic enhancements carried out in recent seasons. A major 2025 refit

installed two MAN V12 engines, fitted with new mounts, hoses and engine risers, and supplied with a full two-year warranty running through June 2027; a three-year extended warranty is available for purchase. That same refit introduced an upgraded GOST security system, a comprehensive suite of Simrad navigation electronics and premium connectivity with newly fitted Starlink and KVH tracking equipment, ensuring modern, reliable onboard systems. Earlier works completed in 2024 further refined performance and systems integration, adding a new bow thruster, a Naviop vessel monitoring system, a new black water pump, a Vulkan coupling on the port engine, and an ANG shore power converter (model SPCT-M5), along with a new electric BBQ grill, a FLIR night vision camera, additional underwater lighting, renewed caulking and new batteries. Complementary maintenance and servicing carried out across the refits included generator servicing, a rebuilt watermaker pump, a fully serviced air-conditioning system, fresh under hull paint with PropSpeed protection and fully serviced hydraulics, all executed to preserve reliability and high operational standards.

Crew & galley equipment

Situated on the main deck, the galley has been appointed to professional standards and delivers a refined culinary workspace for service at sea, boasting an induction range with four hobs, a 35-inch wine cooler, microwave, oven, dishwasher and a double commercial refrigerator. Every element has been selected to support gourmet provisioning and efficient meal preparation while preserving the sophisticated ambience of the yacht's interior.

The crew quarters are thoughtfully arranged to enable smooth, unobtrusive operation in keeping with the vessel's charter pedigree, featuring a dedicated crew area, a functional layout optimized for onboard tasks, distinct working zones, direct access to service areas, and an overall configuration expressly conceived for professional charter use.

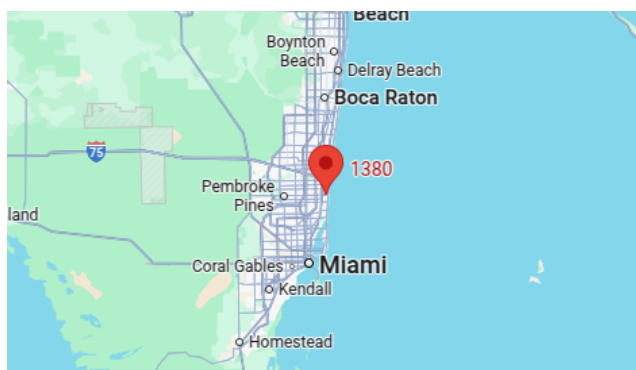
