OVERVIEW

Bold in its proportions and impeccable in its finish, this 2013-model, built-in-2012, 88-foot motor yacht marries sleek silhouette with purposeful capability. Lying in the United States, she presents an elegant fusion of refined taste and confident seakeeping, her 21-foot beam creating a generous, airy platform for seamless indoor–outdoor living. Constructed of sturdy fiberglass/composite with matching fiberglass decks, the hull and superstructure prioritize longevity, stiffness, and a hushed ride through open water.

Power comes from twin Caterpillar inboard diesel engines, which settle the yacht into a comfortable 18-knot cruise and allow spirited passages approaching approximately 23 knots when desired. With 2,700 gallons of fuel and 500 gallons of freshwater aboard, she is equipped for extended coastal runs or leisurely multi-day escapes, while an approximate 18.6-foot draft speaks to serious offshore capability. Broad walkways, well-placed handholds and the elevated exterior living—typical of a flybridge yacht—turn every voyage into a cinematic experience, whether slipping into a hidden cove or making time to the next horizon.

Inside, the main salon welcomes guests with expansive glazing and a contemporary, refined palette; generous lounge seating and an elegant dining area flow directly to the aft deck for effortless alfresco service. The galley is arranged to support both gourmet preparation and casual, convivial dining, encouraging lingering meals and easy hospitality. Below decks, accommodations are calm and private, with multiple staterooms served by an impressive total of six finely appointed heads—an unusually high level of amenity for a vessel of this size. Rich textures, premium finishes, abundant storage and considered lighting create restful retreats for owners and guests alike.

Underway or at anchor, this planing motor yacht balances poise and propulsion with understated luxury. She is equally at home slipping silently into sheltered bays or making a prompt, comfortable passage—an ideal platform for owners who seek comfort without compromise, performance without fuss, and style without ostentation.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Main description

A major \$1M refit in 2021 elevated this yacht into a serene, design-forward sanctuary and a thoroughly modern cruising platform, where every interior surface and system was reconsidered for comfort, aesthetic coherence, and reliability. The interior was fully refreshed in collaboration with Christian Liagre Design, introducing new hardwood floors across every interior deck and electric privacy and blackout blinds on all levels, while the salon was appointed with Christian Liagre fine Belgian linen sofas and ottomans and the forward dinette wrapped in pristine white linen. The galley received a comprehensive renewal with stainless steel countertops, a DAX commercial sink, all-new appliances and the addition of two SubZero refrigeration drawers for effortless provisioning. On deck, all exterior Sunbrella cushions and covers were replaced and the teak aft deck table is paired with Christian Liagre Design director's chairs for refined al fresco dining, while below every wall and door panel on the lower deck was reimagined in white fine Belgian linen and all staterooms were fitted with new bedding. The skylounge sofa and helm chairs are upholstered in black cowhide leather, forward and aft sail shades set on carbon fiber posts temper the sun, and illumination has been fully modernized with LED lighting throughout the interior and across the exterior, including the navigation lights, while exterior decks were refreshed in a light grey nonskid. Technically, the yacht is equally current: new KVH HD7 electronics with VSat, a new Control 4 system, all-new Garmin electronics at the helm, and the complete removal and replacement of all chillers underscore a fastidious program of renewal. The 2020 upgrade cycle layered on thoughtful enhancements for comfort and reliability, with replaced outside cushions and chaise lounge seating with cup holders, added forward and upper aft deck sun

fly shades, a new aft deck sun screen and lower deck cover for improved privacy, and two wine coolers holding sixteen bottles each to serve the main deck social spaces. Chilled water lines, insulation and ductwork were renewed, a backup raw-water cooling pump was added, the galley dinette TV was upgraded, and an Electrosea/Clearline raw water cleaning system was installed to protect critical performance systems.

Aft deck

The aft deck is conceived for generous, sunlit entertaining with a teak table and seating for ten, tailored in fresh Sunbrella cushions and protective covers, presenting an inviting expanse for lunches, cocktails and long evening conversations. Four cushioned, wicker-style outdoor chairs complement the sweeping aft curved settee while a 32" Sunbrite TV on a discreet drop-down mount transforms the space into an open-air media lounge, and full JL Audio flush-mounted speakers extend rich sound across the aft deck and sidewalks. An Eskimo ice chopper chest stands ready for effortless service, and twin Euro-curved stairways on either side lead gracefully down to the swim platform, ensuring fluid movement between deck levels and a seamless connection to the water.

Salon and dining

The main salon and dining area is proportioned for effortless gatherings, with dining for eight and parallel salon couches anchoring a confident, contemporary layout over rich South American walnut floors that lend warmth and presence. Entertaining is elevated by two wine coolers, sixteen bottles each, and a discreetly positioned dayhead for guest convenience, while a 46-inch Samsung HDTV with DirecTV pairs to a Bose Lifestyle surround-sound home theater and a Samsung Blu-ray player for immersive viewing. A

completely new A/V architecture built around Control 4, a custom AV rack, and a high-performance speaker system delivers intuitive, whole-boat entertainment at the touch of a button, ensuring every social moment aboard feels intentional and effortless.

Galley

The professionally appointed galley centers on stainless steel countertops and a DAX commercial galley sink, supported by an oversized SubZero refrigerator with locking pins and two SubZero freezer drawers that simplify extended provisioning and service. A WOLF four-burner black-glass electric cooktop pairs with a matching high-performance ventilation hood and a full-size Wolf oven, while a GE Profile front dishwasher and a Sharp stainless microwave streamline meal service. A Nutone central vacuum system with outlets by the galley, on the flybridge, and on the stateroom level keeps every space pristine. Opposite the primary work zone, the inviting country kitchen settee features a sliding fore-and-aft table, capacious storage beneath the seating, and two swiveling bar stools—an ideal arrangement for casual breakfasts, chef's-table moments, and convivial galley service at sea.

Master stateroom

The full-beam master exudes quiet authority with a king berth and expansive port and starboard windows framed by large portholes, all managed by electric shades for instant ambience control and privacy. Entertainment is tailored with 32-inch Samsung HDTVs and a Samsung Blu-ray player, complemented by a Bose Lifestyle sound system and a Fusion stereo, while a port settee invites a private retreat and a starboard vanity with lighting ensures an elegant routine. Practicality is abundant with an aft starboard walk-in closet and a port forward walk-in closet plus an escape hatch with ladder for peace of mind. The ensuite

is thoughtfully arranged with a portside aft entry to a dedicated water closet with storage and a porthole, dual sinks with mirrored medicine cabinets, and a rainfall shower with wand and a three-way valve for spa-caliber refreshment.

Port stateroom

The port guest stateroom is ensuite and intelligently flexible, with twin berths that slide together as needed to convert into a larger sleeping surface, while natural light filters through three portholes with stainless covers—two in the cabin and one in the head. Entertainment is provided via DirecTV to a new 27-inch Samsung TV and a new Fusion stereo, ensuring guests enjoy modern comforts and adaptable accommodations.

Vip stateroom

The forward VIP stateroom offers ensuite privacy, two cedar-lined hanging lockers and under-berth luggage storage with convenient bilge access, creating a refined and practical guest retreat. Four portholes with stainless covers and manual privacy shades modulate light, while a 32-inch Samsung HDTV, Samsung Blu-Ray player, a Bose Lifestyle sound system and a Fusion stereo complete a premium guest experience.

Crew quarters

Thoughtfully separated yet easily accessed from both the salon and the beach club, the crew area comprises two staterooms, a full head, and a compact crew galley/dinette designed for efficient service and comfortable watchstanding. A 26-inch Samsung LED TV serves the dinette/galley, while a new Fusion stereo system with two flush-mount speakers delivers crisp audio. Cold storage is abundant with two Isotherm freezer drawers and a Beverage Air stainless steel

refrigerator, and daily service is simplified by a microwave, a Kenyon two-burner stove top, and a GE over/under washer/dryer unit. Storage is notably generous, with two large spaces aft and a large centerline bilge access and stowage. For operational redundancy, a new Garmin MFD above the crew TV runs parallel to the redundant Garmin network with a redundant transducer, and a new black water transfer pump has been installed in the lazarette.

Pilothouse navigation

The pilothouse integrates new CAT digital engine monitors and Glendinning engine controls into a helm beautifully executed on a carbon-fiber backboard with a two-tone leatherette console, dashboard and windshield mullions that balance style with tactile ergonomics. Radar capability has been renewed with one Garmin 48" and one Garmin 72" open array, guided by a Garmin Smart Pilot autopilot and a Garmin depth sounder module with Airmar transducer. Redundancy is exemplary: a second independent Garmin GPS and depth sounder in the hull, separate from the main network, offers remote access and a screen in the crew quarters, as well as iPad and iPhone connectivity. Forward and aft PA horns, an ABT Trac digital stabilizer control head for zero-speed fin stabilizers, and ABT hydraulic bow and stern thruster controls underscore precise maneuvering, while two remote control spotlights forward and aft, a magnetic Ritchie PowerDamp compass, a KVH HD7 Sat TV antenna with DirecTV receivers, a VSat communications system and Wave WiFi high-performance access heighten situational awareness. Engine room climate is managed via a Delta T digital control panel, and two Onan generator remote control panels with GPH flow meters tie into the new Octoplex System and Maretron System. For watchstanding assurance, a Vesper monitoring system with remotes in the captain's cabin, pilothouse and master stateroom links with generator fuel flow meters monitored through Octoplex. Performance

refinement arrives via new Humphree Interceptors, and the display suite features three seventeen-inch Garmin MFDs and one sixteen-inch Garmin MFD supported by two STIDD Black helm chairs. Situational awareness is further elevated by a new, full Illumivue camera system with recording—twelve cameras delivering exceptionally high-quality streaming—plus four four-inch Garmin MFDs dedicated to rudder angle, wind, autopilot and speed. Communications are handled by two new ICOM M510 VHF radios, and Control 4 unifies NAV and AV while Gost sensors throughout—monitoring temperature, heat, smoke and freezer interiors, with satellite and GPS tracking—provide comprehensive security.

Skylounge

Elevated above the horizon, the skylounge transforms from a sanctuary of quiet views to a cinematic escape at the touch of a button, with a new hidden forty-inch Samsung HDTV rising on a pop-up electric lift and a Samsung Blu-ray player paired to a Bose Lifestyle home theater system. Bose speakers flush-mounted in the overhead outside bathe the bar area in sound, and luxurious black leather cowhide upholstery defines the sofa for an elegant, tactile environment. Electric blinds with backup battery and chargers allow precise control of light, all windows carry 3M UV protection with clear forward panes for uncompromised visibility, and a dayhead ensures convenience. The custom AV rack integrates DirecTV, an automatic music streamer, Control 4, and a Triad audio matrix on an Araknis network with WattBox IP power management, while Altonomic three-source music streaming completes a lounge designed for any mood and every moment underway.

Boat deck

The boat deck is a study in purposeful customization, beginning with a custom

BBQ grill and a pair of custom-made deep freezers joined by a custom lounge recliner with integrated storage, offering both utility and comfort. Early 2024 enhancements added a custom freezer box with slide-out access and a custom propane Blaze five-burner grill with dedicated storage and a soft-close drawer beneath. Beneath the boat deck sunpad lies a large deep freezer and generous stowage, and a custom removable flybridge formal dining table with covers for both allows the space to pivot from relaxation to reception. A 2500lb Steelhead davit handles tender operations with ease, while a custom-designed swinging safety door secures the boat deck stairs. LED courtesy lights illuminate the interior and exterior of the large cabinet, two 110V outlets (four total plug-ins) support service, and two JL Signature speakers in the hardtop—part of a JL Signature speaker and amplifier suite throughout the yacht—carry entertainment skyward.

Swim platform and water gear

A newly laid teak surface spans the swim platform and stairways up to the deck, while a hydraulic platform with five removable stainless steel border railings adapts to any water day and supports boarding and water sports with ease. A fold-out swim ladder deploys from a hatch in the fixed platform, and a diesel supply point for the dinghy or tender sits conveniently at the waterline, accompanied by two removable railings with new teak and a removable dinghy shock for versatile tender stowage. For serious diving support, a Brownie high-pressure electric compressor (L & W compressor) with a quick-connect hose fitting at the swim platform shows just 2.1 hours of use; the vessel includes a Brownie quick-connect dual-tank filler hose. Control is handled by a Teco Westinghouse controller, Model IP66 Nemax, and the package is complemented by Brownie's 100' hookah with two Scuba Pro R095 regulators and a Y connection, making the yacht exceptionally prepared for extended diving operations.

Engine room and equipment

Power comes from twin 2012 Caterpillar C32A engines at 1700 hp each, currently showing 2064 hours, now riding on new engine mounts and mated to ZF transmissions with hydraulic take-offs from both gears. New aftercoolers have been installed on both engines and generators, along with new ELC reservoirs, and fuel flow meters have been fitted to both gens. The HVAC plant has been renewed with new chillers and handlers, including a new chiller number 2 and custom valves for easy connection to a cooling tower. Electrical resilience is supported by engine and hose batteries replaced in 2023, and hydraulic oil, filters and coolers were replaced the same year with a new pressure gauge added. Control at the fingertips includes Glendinning electric controls with a wired remote and multi plug points and a Hynautic power steering system. Onboard autonomy is bolstered by two Aquamatic watermakers, Reverso fuel polishing with a new FPS210 controller, and a Reverso oil change pump system. Filtration and sanitation are robust with dual Racor primary filters for the main engines, single Racors for the gensets, Techma fresh-water heads throughout and a Hamann AG Super Mini Plus sewage treatment system with alarm and a transfer switch at the helm, plus a new raw-water pump. A Delta T engine room ventilation system maintains airflow, while 2700 gallons of fuel in aluminum tanks with sight and electric gauges, a 500 gallon fiberglass freshwater tank, a 200 gallon holding tank, and a 100 gallon grey water sump tank support extended range. Dry, dependable bilges are ensured by an added Arid bilge system. Additional new items and spares include three VFD'd chiller units; a spare rebuilt chilled-water loop pump and a new chilled-water loop pump; a spare cooling pump for the Eskimo ice chipper; two raw-water chiller pumps valved-in with Octoplex control (portside is pump number 2); two spare 1861 hydraulic filters; two spare Rule bilge pumps; spare engine hoses; a spare AC raw-water pump; a spare rebuilt Gianneschi macerator pump; and spare shaft zincs in various

sizes.

Electrical system

Electrical generation is assured by two 32 kW Onan generators in sound shields, showing 8451 and 8633 hours as of April/2025, each fitted with fuel flow meters to monitor consumption precisely. Shore power arrives via a 100 amp single phase system with two 100 amp ISO Boost transformers and two 100 amp feeds, supported aft by Glendinning shore power cord winders and two 100 amp inlet plugs forward inside the gull-wing storage compartments, with the flexibility to switch the boosters to either end. Power distribution is streamlined through the Octoplex switch panel system, with panels at the helm, in the lower stateroom foyer, and in the aft stairway cabinet. Task lighting is comprehensive, with 12V DC under-engine lights, 24V DC engine room lights and 110V AC engine room lights to support service and maintenance operations.

Deck and hull

The yacht's underwater and structural pedigree has been meticulously maintained, with a complete ten-year hull service accomplished as part of annual haul-out routines that preserve integrity and finish. ABT Trac zero-speed fin stabilizers pair with ABT hydraulic bow and stern thrusters rated at 45 hp for unwavering poise, while shaft, strut and propeller alignment has been laser-verified and the propulsion suite benefits from new six-blade high-performance stainless steel propellers with a spare set included in the sale. A new interceptor stabilizing system sharpens attitude control, and new rudder dry seals and new shaft dry seals underscore mechanical integrity. The one-piece hull lamination and longitudinal stringers, built via the SCRIMP process, deliver proven strength, finished in white gelcoat and recently

polished with a ceramic treatment across hull and deckhouse. Nighttime drama is provided by six LED underwater lights, while forward Navy anchors on the bow are set with strike plates and a cutwater and handled by two Maxwell 4000 windlasses with chain rode, brakes and locks and two AA580 chain counter display panels at the helm. Speich windshield wipers and washers with interval remote controls and mesh windscreen masks for both the upper and lower windshields optimize clarity in all conditions.

Fire and safety

Safety systems are comprehensive and connected, beginning with an alarm system offering remote access and monitoring for peace of mind while away from the vessel. A SeaFire automatic fire suppression system with an alarm panel at the helm stands vigilant, and the safety inventory is completed by a full set of flares with expiry EP 11/2025 and a fire blanket for immediate response.

Guest companionway

Service spaces along the guest companionway are engineered for quiet reliability, including a Gianceschi grey water pump with a spare, two Headhunter Mach 5 pumps with a selector valve, and a dedicated black water transfer pump to keep systems flowing smoothly and minimize guest disturbance.

Starboard stateroom

The starboard guest stateroom is ensuite and cleverly arranged with an over/under bunk to maximize space, completed by a cedar-lined hanging locker that brings a refined, aromatic finish to storage and enhances the sense

of hospitality.

Hard top

The hardtop has been freshly caulked around all accessories and presents a renewed profile with a replaced six-foot Garmin radar cover and a FLIR 364c, while connectivity is future-proofed with brand new Starlink unlinked to any account. Searchlight capability includes ACR fixed search light bars—two forward and one aft facing—and ACR rotational search lights—one forward and one aft—while recently upgraded navigation lights now shine in LED for improved efficiency and visibility.

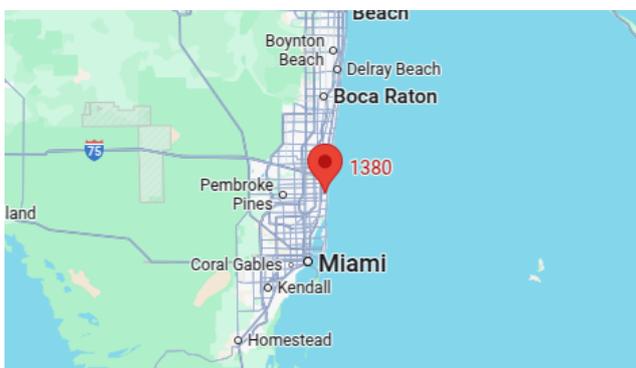
