## Description

Hideout is conceived around the way people truly spend time on the water, inviting effortless movement between open air, quiet retreat, and shared moments. Every level is composed with intention so spaces flow naturally rather than feeling divided by function, creating a yacht that feels relaxed, confident, and intuitive from the instant you step aboard. Life on deck is defined by flexibility: outdoor areas adapt gracefully throughout the day, from unhurried mornings at anchor to spirited afternoon passages and convivial evenings with guests. Seating, sun exposure, and sightlines are balanced so the yacht reads as open without ever feeling exposed, while multiple zones allow privacy and connection to coexist without competing for space. Access to the sea is immediate and uncomplicated, encouraging spontaneous swims, tender runs, and moments spent right at the water's edge. Equipment and gear are discreetly integrated to keep every surface refined and uncluttered; nothing is overdesigned, and each element serves a clear purpose within a clean, modern aesthetic. Inside, the mood shifts to calm and understated as natural light softens the interior and sustains an ongoing dialogue with the surroundings. The layout favors openness with the option to separate when needed, giving owners precise control over how the yacht is used at any moment, while practical storage is placed exactly where everyday life demands it to keep time aboard comfortable, orderly, and serene. Guest accommodations are conceived for longevity rather than mere overnight stays: cabins feel substantial, hushed, and private—true retreats rather than simple places to sleep. The owner's suite is distinguished by scale and comfort, offering a personal haven that feels removed from the yacht's activity while remaining fully resolved within its overall design. Eschewing trends and excess

ornament, Hideout prioritizes proportion, balance, and usability; materials, finishes, and layout choices are selected to age gracefully and to support real ownership—extended cruising, generous hosting, and time aboard without compromise. Confident without being loud and refined without feeling formal, Hideout suits an owner who values design that performs as beautifully in practice as it does in presentation.
