OVERVIEW

Launched in 2024, the Riva 90' Argo 4SEAS has remained in single private ownership since delivery and benefits from remarkably low engine hours, reflecting careful use and stewardship. Finished in Metallic Shark Grey, her lines convey the confident, sculpted profile of the Argo range, while a contemporary, refined specification confirms her unmistakable Riva pedigree—an Italian flybridge motor yacht that exudes poise and presence.

Accommodation for ten across five cabins includes a full-beam owner's suite positioned forward on the main deck, a highly desirable layout for those who value privacy, generous proportions and a clear distinction between the owner's domain and the guest accommodation located on the lower deck. The interior palette is warmed by high-gloss rosewood cabinetry, where richly hued timber and abundant natural light combine with Riva's meticulous detailing to create an atmosphere of sophisticated comfort that never feels overly formal.

The spacious flybridge functions as an elegant open-air living area for long days at sea, anchored by an expansive U-shaped lounge that provides a natural focal point for relaxing, dining and enjoying the panorama while underway or at anchor. Privately owned since new, 4SEAS presents in excellent condition and bears the hallmarks of consistent, thorough maintenance.

Delivering the presence and interior volume associated with a 90-foot superyacht, she offers a five-stateroom arrangement centred on a main-deck master, broad exterior decks and the distinctive design identity for which Riva is renowned. For buyers seeking a recent example in this class, 4SEAS represents the opportunity to secure a near-new luxury motor yacht without the lead time of a new build.

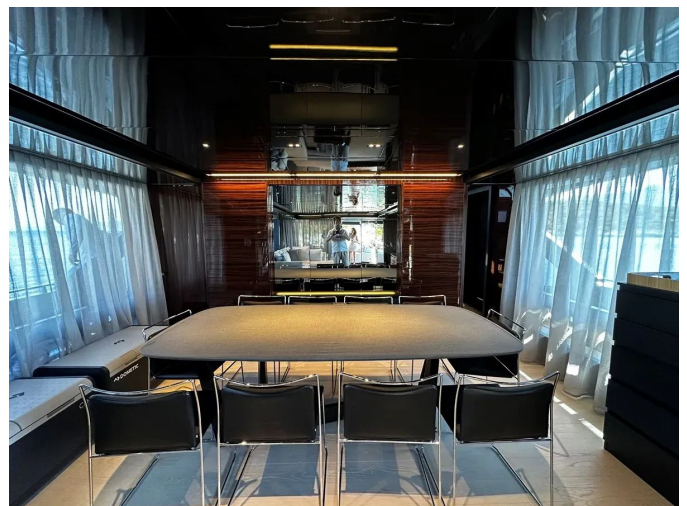
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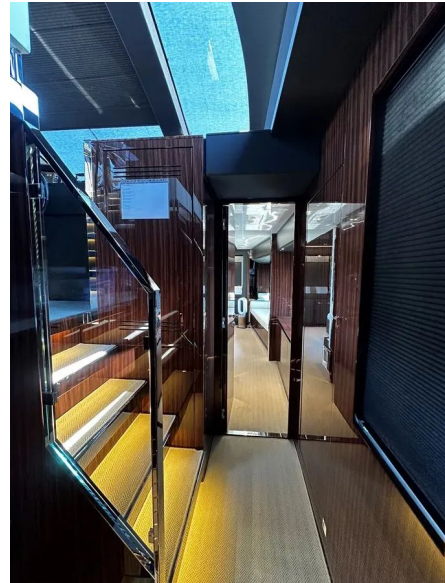
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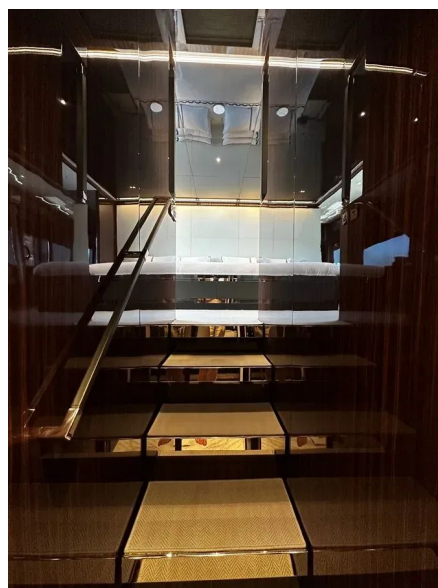

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Generators

Twin Onan generators, each rated at 27 kW, deliver consistently reliable, whisper-quiet electrical power with the capacity to run every vessel system and hotel-grade load, ensuring uninterrupted comfort and complete autonomy both at anchor and while underway.

Technical

Finished in a striking Shark Grey metallic lacquer, the yacht pairs a high-gloss rosewood interior with side-opening bulwarks and an electric sliding salon door that creates a seamless flow between cockpit and lounge. Climate and atmosphere are precisely managed by Super Tropical air conditioning, while adjustable dimmers for both interior and exterior lighting, underwater lights that transform the yacht at dusk, and electric curtains throughout underscore an attention to mood and comfort; shade is provided fore and aft by a flybridge aft and foredeck sun awning supported on carbon poles.

Confident handling and exceptional stability are delivered by a suite of systems including a Sleipner hydraulic bow thruster and stern thruster, Sleipner fin stabilizers with zero-speed capability and a SEAKEEPER 18 gyroscopic stabilizer, all supported at the helm by a dedicated docking station. Performance is refined with five-blade ROLLA propellers and Humphree flaps, and extended autonomy is provided by an onboard watermaker. Ground tackle is substantial and ready for any anchorage with two electric LOFRANS windlasses, two anchors with anchor chain and two electric LOFRANS capstans, while practical conveniences such as a gangway and a lift platform for the tender complete a specification engineered for effortless, luxurious cruising.

Navigation and electronics

A Simrad nineteen-inch display forms the command hub at the helm, integrating a full suite of Simrad systems—radar, autopilot, AIS, VHF radio and sounder—augmented by a traditional compass for analogue course-keeping and a Naviopp monitoring system that continuously oversees critical onboard systems. Connectivity and onboard entertainment are configured to exacting standards, with KVH satellite TV and Starlink providing uninterrupted access to information and programming, while a Fusion exterior sound system works in concert with a purpose-built interior audio installation. Visual entertainment is equally lavish: the salon is equipped with a fifty-inch HiLo television for effortless viewing, the master cabin features a fifty-inch screen, and the guest cabins each benefit from forty-three-inch displays.

Appliances

Every convenience aboard has been selected for effortless living and refined entertaining: a full-size refrigerator paired with a dedicated freezer, a built-in oven accompanied by an elegant cooktop, and a discreet dishwasher to simplify post-meal service. A climate-controlled wine cooler with capacity for twenty-three bottles preserves your vintages at optimal temperatures, while an icemaker on the fly bridge ensures chilled refreshment is always at hand. For alfresco dining the fly bridge also hosts a grill that brings galley comforts outdoors, and the onboard washer/dryer makes extended cruising both practical and comfortable.

Toys, safety and exclusions

A Williams SportJet tender is poised to carry you ashore or to enhance your time on the water with energetic performance, while sturdy life rafts remain on

standby as reliable protection, expressing a firm dedication to safety that in no way diminishes the excitement of the voyage.

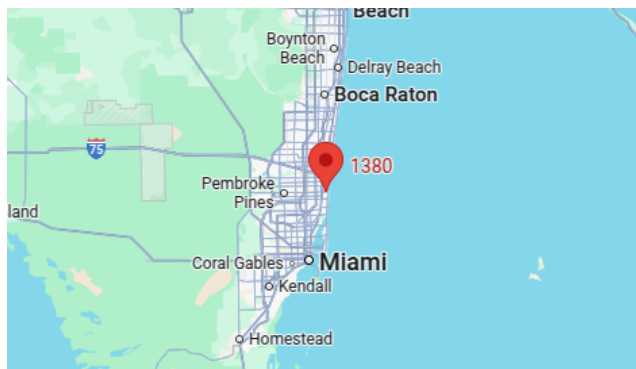
